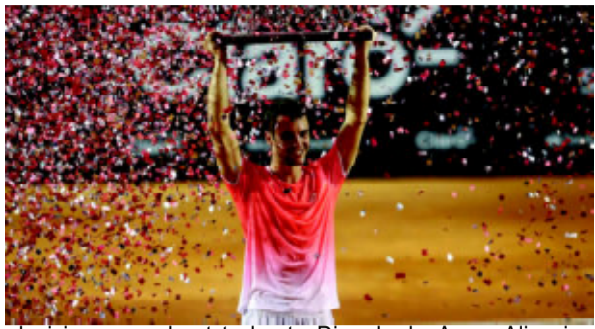

Emotional Laslo Djere wins Rio Open for first ATP title

Brazil, Feb 25
Laslo Djere won his first ATP title at the Rio Open on Monday and then captured the hearts of the Brazilian crowd with a victory speech dedicated to his parents, both of whom died from cancer. The unseeded Serbian beat Canadian teenager Felix Auger-Aliassime 6-3, 7-5 in the final to cap the best week of his career before choking back the tears as he dedicated the trophy to his parents. "I lost my mom seven years ago so I want to dedicate this one to her," he said to wild applause from the crowd. "And also to my dad, I lost him two months ago. My parents had the biggest impact on me and, because of them, I am who I am today. I hope they are watching me now." The 23-year-old, ranked number 90 in the world coming into this tournament, broke twice in the



decisive second set to beat Auger-Aliassime, who was the youngest man to reach an ATP 500 final. The plucky 18-year-old Canadian saved four match points before succumbing to the unseeded right-hander, who had not won a match on clay all season and had never beaten a top 10 rival until he arrived in Rio. He hammered world number eight Dominic Thiem in the first round, however, and did not lose a set on his way to clinching the title in impressive style.

Djere broke Auger-Aliassime six times in the two-hour final and was commanding with both his powerful forehands and two-handed backhands. "It's been the week of my dreams," Djere added. "So many things have been achieved here. I'm really happy, excited and emotional now." Auger-Aliassime became just the fourth teenager to reach the final of an ATP 500 event - the 13 tournaments which rank just below the Masters series - since the level was created in 2009.

Suresh Raina becomes first Indian to score 8000 runs in T20 cricket

New Delhi, Feb 25
Batsman Suresh Raina on Monday became the first Indian to accumulate 8,000 runs in T20 cricket when he scored 11 runs against Puducherry in the Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy. Raina had accumulated 7989 runs in the shortest format of the game and needed 11 runs to cross 8,000 runs before the clash. The 32-year-old cricketer has now scored 8001 runs in 300 matches at an average of 33.47,

with four centuries and 48 half-centuries to his credit. Indian skipper Virat Kohli trails Raina by 178 runs having scored 7833 runs in 251 matches. Veteran cricketer MS Dhoni is the only other Indian to have played 300 matches in the shortest format of the game. Raina is also now the sixth highest run-scorer in T20s. Windies batsman Chris Gayle leads the run charts with 12298 runs while former New Zealand cricketer Brendon McCullum is

the second highest run-getter with 9922 runs. Kieron Pollard, Shoaib Malik and David Warner further round off the top five list with 8838, 8603, 8111 runs respectively. Not only this, Raina recently became the second Indian after Rohit Sharma to smash 300 T20 sixes. The cricketer will next feature in the 2019 edition of the Indian Premier League (IPL) after being retained by the Chennai Super Kings.

2nd Women's ODI: India crush England by 7 wickets; seal series

Mumbai, Feb 25
Opener Smriti Mandhana's stylish 63 was complemented by skipper Mithali Raj's unbeaten 47 as Indian women cruised to a comfortable seven-wicket victory against England to take an unassailable 2-0 lead in the three-match series, here Monday.



Chasing an easy target of 162, the hosts cantered to the target in 41.1 overs, primarily due to two significant partnerships. The 73-run stand between Mandhana and Poonam Raut (32 off 65 balls) for the second wicket set the foundation and the 66 runs for the third wicket clinched the issue in favour of 'Women In Blue'. This was after pacers Shikha Pandey (4/18 in 10 overs) and

Jhulan Goswami (4/30 in 8.3 overs) wreaked havoc with their fiery spells to bundle out the opposition for a paltry 161 in 43.3 overs. The second win on the trot also helped the hosts grab two crucial points to go up the ladder in the ICC Women's ODI championship table. India won the first game by 66 runs and the third and final

game will be played at the same venue on February 28.

"The first half is very important even if you choose to bat. Later on, the wicket eases out because the pitches here are well rolled. I was a bit disappointed with the 10th wicket partnership England got, but I guess, 150-odd, I knew we were always there," skipper Mithali said after the match.

We need to have more partnerships: Mithali Raj

Mumbai, Feb 25
Indian captain Mithali Raj on Sunday urged his team-mates to "work on partnerships" as they looked to claim an unassailable lead in the three-match ODI series against England.

"We have to work on partnerships. We had just 2, between the openers and mine with Taniya (Bhatia). We need to work on playing the middle overs," said Mithali on the eve of the second one-dayer in Mumbai. Openers Jemimah Rodrigues, who top scored with 48, and Smriti Mandhana added 69



runs for the first wicket and after a mini collapse, the innings was resurrected by a 54-run stand between Mithali (44) and wicket keeper Tania (25) for the sixth wicket. India, who made 202, defended the modest score with some crafty spin bowling by left-

arm Ekta Bisht (4 for 25) to emerge victorious by 66 runs and take a 1-0 lead. "When we can go and score 200 with just 2 partnerships, if another couple of batters can score runs, that would be a good score on this wicket," Mithali pointed out.

Dustin Johnson clinches 20th title with runaway win at WGC-Mexico Championship

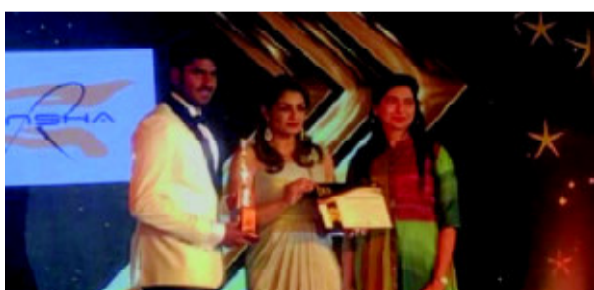
Mexico, Feb 25
Dustin Johnson collected his 20th PGA Tour victory in some style on Sunday when he ran away with the WGC-Mexico Championship by five strokes to move up to number two in the world. Johnson carded a closing five-under-par 66 at Club de Golf Chapultepec in Mexico City to claim the World Golf Championships event for the second time in three years. The lanky American finished at 21-under 263, while Northern



Irishman Rory McIlroy shot 67 for second place on 16-under. Johnson has won at least once every year since he

joined the PGA Tour in 2008. Only Tiger Woods (80) and Phil Mickelson (44) have won more often among players currently aged under 50.

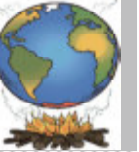
