New Delhi, Feb 26  
 The President of India, Shri Ram Nath Kovind presented the prestigious Gandhi Peace Prize for the years 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 at a function in Rashtrapati Bhawan today (26.02.2019). The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi also attended the function and felicitated the awardees. The Minister of State for Culture (Independent Charge), Dr. Mahesh Sharma and other dignitaries were present on the occasion. The Gandhi Peace Prize was presented to the Vivekananda Kendra, Kanyakumari for 2015; jointly to the Akshaya Patra Foundation and the Sulabh International for 2016; to the Ekal Abhiyan Trust for 2017; and to Shri Yohei Sasakawa (from Japan) for



2018. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that Gandhian thinking, Gandhian modes of struggle and Gandhian ideals of achieving human liberty by conciliation, by appealing to the conscience of the opponent, have influenced some of the greatest of our age. From Martin Luther

King Jr in the United States to Nelson Mandela in South Africa and Lech Walesa in Poland, a dazzling galaxy of statespersons has learnt and borrowed from Gandhiji. Pointing to the contributions made by the awardees, the President said that the Vivekananda Centre has promoted self-

## IAF conducts airstrikes at JeM's biggest terror camp in Pakistan

New Delhi, Feb 26  
 The Indian Air Force conducted airstrikes at the biggest terror camp of Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) in Balakot at Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in Pakistan in the wee hours today. Briefing media in New Delhi, Foreign Secretary Shri Vijay Gokhale said, credible information was received that JeM was attempting other suicide terror attacks in the country and terrorists were being trained for that purpose. Saying that it became inevitable to carryout a pre-emptive strike, the Foreign Secretary asserted that in this operation, a very large number of terrorists, trainers and senior



commanders of the group were eliminated. He said, the airstrikes were a non-military pre-emptive action and they were conducted in a thick forest area to avoid civilian casualties. The camp was led by Maulana Yusuf Azhar alias

Ustad Ghauri, brother in law of JeM Chief Masood Azhar. Shri Gokhale said, JeM is responsible for series of terror attacks in India. He said, information about location of training camps was provided to Pakistan but no concrete

action was taken. The Foreign Secretary said, India remains firmly committed towards taking all measures to fight terrorism. He said, India expects Pakistan to dismantle all terror camps, including those of JeM.

**Six Indians enter finals of Makran Cup boxing in Iran**

Chabahar, Feb 26  
Commonwealth Games silver-winning duo of Manish Kaushik (60kg) and Satish Kumar (+91kg), and Manjeet Singh Panghal (75kg).



In the semifinal bouts held on Monday evening, the other boxers who made the finals were Deepak Singh (49kg), P Laliitha Prasad (52kg), Sanjeet ((91kg), and Manjeet Singh Panghal (75kg).  
Kaushik, a national champion, defeated Ashkan Reizai 4-1. He will fight it out with Dania Baksh Shah in the final on Wednesday. Tuesday is the official rest day at the tournament.  
Satish, who is also a former Asian Games bronze-medallist,

got the better of Eeman Ramazan 5-0, and will face Mohammad Mlias in the summit clash.

Deepak defeated Malek Ammari 5-0 and set up a clash with Jaafer Naseri in the final. Prasad out-punched Filipino Marvin Tobamo 5-0. In the final, he will square off against Omid Safa Ahmadi.

Sanjeet, an India Open gold-medallist last year, blanked

Pourya Amiri 5-0. He will fight for gold with Ehsan Bahani Rouz.  
Debutant Manjeet defeated Sina Safdarian to enter the final, where he will be up against Ahmed Ghousoun of Syria. However, Rohit Tokas (64kg) and Duryodhan Singh Negi (69kg) lost to Bagher Faraji and Ali Moradi respectively to sign off with bronze medals in the tournament.

**India eye series-saving win over Australia**

Bengaluru, Feb 26  
The focus remains firmly on the World Cup but India would also be desperate to ensure that a home series does not slip out of their grip when they take on Australia in the second and final T20 International here on Wednesday.



India are 0-1 down after an inexplicably poor batting performance led to a three-wicket loss in the lung-opener in Visakhapatnam.

The below-par 126 with the bat on Sunday denied bowlers a decent shot at securing a win even though the Jasprit Bumrah-led attack did all it could to keep the home team in the game till the final over of the match.

India skipper Virat Kohli has already said that his squad composition for the World Cup in May-July is "more or less

sorted" but has not ruled out rewarding standout performances over the course of two T20s and five ODIs. Considering the captain's current frame of mind, both K L Rahul and Rishabh Pant are likely to feature in most of the games against Australia. India rested opener Shikhar Dhawan to give game time to Rahul, who grabbed the opportunity with both hands by smashing 50 off 36 balls in his comeback game.

He had a disastrous Test tour of Australia before he and Hardik Pandya were provisionally suspended for their loose talk on women during a TV show. The ban was later revoked though they still face an inquiry. With the series on the line, it remains to be seen if Dhawan is brought back into the side to open alongside Rohit Sharma or the team retains the opening combination which featured in Vizag.

**Ritu Phogat moves from wrestling to MMA, wrestling federation stunned**

New Delhi, Feb 26  
Ritu Phogat, daughter of Dangal fame wrestling coach Mahavir Phogat, in a shock move on Monday announced her decision to join Mixed Martial Arts (MMA), leaving a promising career in wrestling. The 24-year-old is third of the famous Phogat sisters - Geeta, Babita, Ritu and Sangita. In 2017, she had won a silver medal in the 48kg category at the World U-23 Senior Wrestling Championship in Poland.



She has joined Singapore-based Evolve Fight Team. "I am really excited to begin my new journey. The reason I picked MMA is because I want to be the first Indian to become MMA world champion," Ritu told TOI on telephone from Singapore. Her decision has

shocked the Wrestling Federation of India, which says Ritu kept them "in the dark" by claiming she was injured. "I have been following MMA for a while and I was very impressed by the sport. I have always wondered why there are no Indians in this sport," she added. When being asked what had prompted her to opt for MMA, the grappler replied, "Everyone in our family is a

wrestler. People have expectations since I'm Geeta and Babita's sister. I want to fulfill their expectations and hopes, not on the mat but inside a cage." Explaining that she was more adventurous than her sisters, Ritu said, "Wrestling is my first love. Of course, I am going to miss it, but I am different from my sisters. I just can't wait to get started."

**ATP Rankings: India's Prajnesh Gunneswaran attains career-best spot**

New Delhi, Feb 26  
Indian tennis ace Prajnesh Gunneswaran has reaped rewards for his consistent performance as he climbed three places to reach his career-best 94th position in the latest Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) rankings. Earlier this month, the 29-year-old from Chennai became only the third player from the country after Somdev Dewvarman and Yuki Bhambri to break into the men single's top-100 in the past decade. Gunneswaran, who enjoyed a terrific 2018 season, on Saturday made it to the semi-finals of the ATP Bangkok Challenger before slumping to a 6-7 (2-7), 6-3, 6-7 defeat at the hands of Australia's James Duckworth.



However, Gunneswaran's countrymen Ramkumar Ramanathan slipped by nine places to settle for 137th spot in the latest list, while Yuki Bhambri also saw a further dip in his rankings to reach 171th place. Meanwhile, Saketh Myneni and Sasi Kumar Mukund also attained their career-best rankings of 250th and 269th, respectively. In the men's doubles rankings, veteran tennis star Leander
