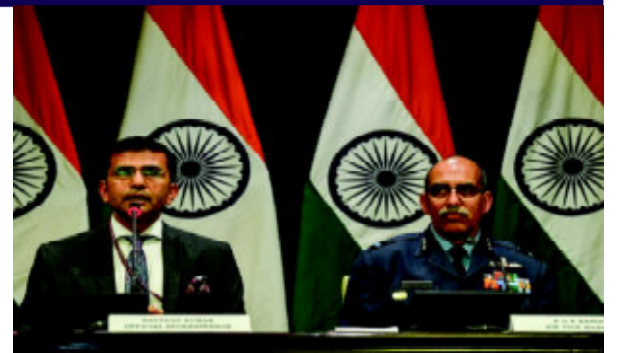

Development/reclamation of submerged land Committee submits report: Principal Secretary (Rev) approves all recommendations

Port Blair, Feb 27

In view of various requests for development/reclamation of submerged land for general public, the Principal Secretary (Rev) has constituted a committee consisting of Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman as Chairman and Chief Engineer, APWD, Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Divisional Forest Officer, Wimberlygunj, Sub Divisional Officer, South Andaman and Assistant Commissioner (Settlement) as members.

The Committee was mandated to go into various aspects of reclamation/development of submerged land.

After detailed deliberation with all the stake holders, the Committee submitted its recommendations to the Principal Secretary (Rev) for grant of permission for

development/reclamation of submerged land. The Principal Secretary (Rev) has approved all the recommendations of the committee. Therefore, henceforth in all the cases of development/reclamation of submerged land, following guidelines have to be followed scrupulously.

1. For all revenue matters, the list of submerged land submitted by the survey team constituted for survey of submerged land during the year 2010, shall

be final and considered, irrespective of current status of the land.

2. The restrictions/conditions as approved and published in The Daily Telegrams on 17/03/2018 for development of land, shall be applicable to all such applications.

3. To ensure that the development is done in a legally valid manner:
(a) The applicant should enclose the photo of the land and the demarcation report to which the land development is required

after conducting a proper demarcation and having fenced the land.

(b) The concerned Tehsildar should verify and report the status of land as applied above.

(c) The concerned Tehsildar shall also certify that the land to which development is sought is well connected by a recorded path/road as per the revenue records, a circular to this effect issued by the Deputy Commissioner, (SA) said.

Mumbai, Feb 27
The series already in the bag, a confident India will look to complete a whitewash when they take on a beleaguered England in the third and final women's One-day International here Thursday. The Mithali Raj-led outfit had thrashed the reigning World Champions by 66 runs in the opening ODI and then followed it up with a dominating seven-wicket win in the second game to seal the three-match series with a 2-0 unassailable lead. More importantly, India grabbed four crucial points in the ICC Women's championship as the race for securing direct qualification spots for the 2021 World Cup heats up. With two more points up for grabs, the hosts would not like to experiment by making any changes to the line-up. India seem to have found the winning momentum under new coach WV Raman as they ticked most boxes in the last two games. Prolific opener Smriti Mandhana, who is the current ICC cricketer of the year, has



been in splendid form. Her classy 63 in the last game helped the hosts to clinch the match and the series. Veteran Mithali Raj, who is the leading run-getter in ODIs, has scores of 44 and 47 in the last two games. Both Mandhana and her skipper would like to continue from where they left. 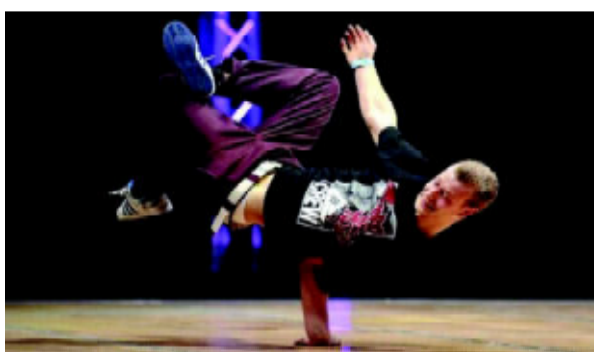
Cricket coaching camp from March 1

Paris Olympics organisers propose breakdancing among four sports for 2024 Games

Paris, Feb 27
Breakdancing will become an Olympic sport in 2024 if the International Olympic Committee backs the inclusion of four sports proposed by the Paris Olympics organisers. The Paris 2024 organising committee said on Thursday the four sports - including surfing, skateboarding and sport climbing - would reflect the French capital's identity and help take the Games out of stadiums and into the streets. The organisers said they wanted to deliver a Games that were "in keeping with the times and inspire new audiences



and attract young people... and which can be played anywhere and anytime in urban and other environments." Skateboarding, surfing and sport climbing will all be making their debuts in the 2020 Tokyo

Games. Under new IOC rules first introduced for the Tokyo Games, Olympic host cities can hand-pick sports and propose them for inclusion in those Games if they are popular in that country and add to the Games' appeal.

Central Crime Station seizes illicit liquor & IMFL

Port Blair, Feb 27
Continuing its drive against bootlegging and contraband substances, the Central Crime Station Police, after gathering intelligence regarding sale and storage of illicit liquor in Port Mout area had conducted raid yesterday (Feb. 25, 19). Based on tip-off, a Police raiding team comprising of SI, S. Siva Kumar, Police Constable, S. Baroi, H.K. Yadav, P.K. Mondal, Bhaskar Rao, Lady HG Seema Kujur, headed by Insp. Mahesh Yadav, Station House Officer, PS CCS searched the entire stretch of Port Mout Jungle and found two tins containing lahan (fermented wash) kept under a tree. The team had destroyed two tins there itself and on further search, found one person hiding something in the bushes, who was later intercepted and arrested and

accordingly, one plastic jerrycan containing 10 litres of illicit liquor hidden in the bush from Ganesh Chander Nath R/o Port Mout was seized. Earlier on 24th and 25th of February, five more cases have been registered against T Muttaiah. R/o Prem Nagar near Kali Mandir, Ranjan R/o School Line, Om Kumar Thapa R/o Fisherish Jetty, V Selvam R/o Sisty Nagar and P. Kumar R/o Dignabad under Excise Regulation. The team comprised of Head Constables K. A Anandan, Sanjay Kujur, Police Constables Sameresh Mistry, S. Baroi, Chandran of PS CCS.

The raid conducted by the staff of PS CCS was supervised by Shri George Lalu, Dy. SP (CID) and under the overall supervision of Shri Jatin Narwal, SSP (CID).

ISSF World Cup: Manu Bhaker and Saurabh Chaudhary win gold in 10m air pistol mixed team event

New Delhi, Feb 27
The trailblazing teenaged duo of Saurabh Chaudhary and Manu Bhaker comfortably claimed the gold medal in the 10m air pistol mixed team event of the ISSF World Cup in New Delhi on Wednesday. The Indian pair shot a total of 483.5 to finish on top of the podium to finish the tournament with a flourish after a few results that did not go their way over the last three days. The Chinese duo of Ranxin Jiang and Bowen Zhang won silver with 477.7, while the bronze went to the Korean pair of Minjung Kim and Daehun Park (418.8) at the Dr Karni Singh Shooting Range. Such was the Indian duo's dominance through the final that the difference between gold and silver medalist at the end

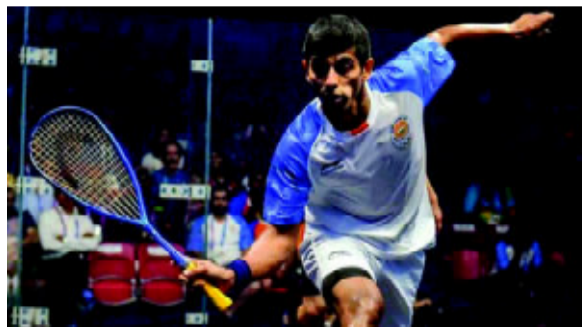


was a hopping at the end was 5.8. Having entered the final after equalling the qualification world record, Saurabh and Manu continued in the same vein and once they moved to the top spot, there was no looking back as they consistently shot high and mid 10. The other Indian team in the fray, Heena Sidhu and Abhishek Verma, could not clear the qualification hurdle.

The Indian shooters in 10m air rifle mixed team event - Ravi Kumar and Anjum Moudgil and Apurvi Chandel and Deepak Kumar finished seventh and 25th respectively. India jointly topped the standings with Hungary with three gold medals, but managed to secure only one Olympic quota. The tournament offered 14 quota places for the 2020 Tokyo Games.

World Squash Championship: Saurav Ghosal enters quarter-finals

Chicago, Feb 27
India's Saurav Ghosal made his way into the quarterfinal with a hard fought win over Wales player Joel Makin in the PSA World squash championship here. The 32-year-old Indian, seeded 11th, won 11-13, 11-7, 11-7, 13-11 but the success did not come easily, thanks to the way his unseeded opponent fought for every point. Makin, who previously faced and lost to Saurav in the CCI International in Mumbai in 2017, presented himself as a much better player. Saurav knew his hands were



full when Makin snatched the first game. The Indian was able to tighten his game to take the next two. In the fourth game, however, Saurav was down 5-8 and Makin looked set to clinch the game but experience helped

the Indian as he clawed back and earned three match balls before ensuring a win. This is the second time that Saurav has reached the last eight, the last being in 2013. Saurav next faces the third seed German Simon Rosner.

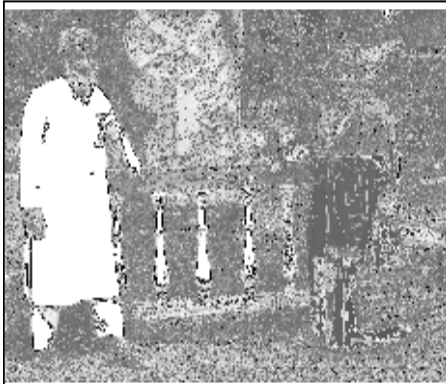
