Port Blair, July 12

The A&N Islands has achieved 100% Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) coverage in rural area under Jal Jeevan Mission scheme during the Financial Year 20-21 by covering 62037 households with individual FHTC. Sustainability and service delivery is one of the most important aspect of 'Jal Jeevan Mission'. Hence, provision for establishment of a modern and rapid grievance redressal mechanism for rural water supply is one of the prime objective of post 'Har Ghar Jal' (HGJ) activities under JJM scheme.

In view of this, the Andaman Nicobar State Water and Sanitation Mission (ANSWSM) has planned to setup a round the clock Toll Free Help

Line Number, an Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system as well as an online grievance redressal portal for rural water supply under support fund activities.

As a first step to this, a Toll Free Help Line Number 1800001666 has been setup for receiving public grievance on rural water supply in A&N Islands. Initially, this helpline number shall be functioning during office hours from 8.30 am to 5.50 pm each day, on trial basis. Subsequently, its services shall be extended round the clock. General public from anywhere in rural areas of A&N Islands can dial on this number for any grievance or complaint on quality and quantity of drinking water supply in household or any functionality issue like problem in distribution, short duration supply

Secretary (PWD) inspects water supply related projects in South Andaman

Directs Engineers of APWD to expedite work of Treatment Plant at Garacharma & preliminary study on Koila Nallah Water Supply Scheme at Mannarghat

Port Blair, July 12

The Secretary (PWD), Shri Kishore Kshirsagar Lakshman inspected various water supplies related projects being carried out in South Andaman viz. the site for construction of additional 10 MLD Water Treatment and two nos. of Clear Water Reservoirs having 37.50 lakh liters capacity and another having 10 Lakh liters capacity at Garacharma inside the existing Garacharma Water Treatment Plant. During the visit to the site at Garacharma yesterday, the Secretary



directed the Engineers of APWD to expedite the work of Treatment Plant at Garacharma by September, 2021 and also the construction of Clear Water Reservoirs. These additional storages and treatment

facilities shall allow uninterrupted and enhanced water supply in Garacharma and adjoining areas.

In addition to this, a water supply scheme on Koila Nallah, Mannarghat village is

also on the pipeline to cater and improve the water supply distribution in Ferrargunj Tehsil. The scheme envisages for construction of dam across the Koila Nallah

400 fruit bearing saplings planted in a week across rural areas & in campus of office buildings

Port Blair, July 12

The Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs under the leadership of Secretary (RD) has taken the initiative of planting fruit bearing saplings in the building campus of all CD Blocks and Gram Panchayats of this UT. Under the initiative, over 400 fruit bearing saplings of Mangoes, Guavas, Oranges, Lemon, Jack Fruit, Tamarind, Sweet Apple, Coconut, Cashew Nut etc. were planted in a week across rural areas as well as in the building campus of different offices working under the Department of RD, PRIs & ULBs.

As part of the initiative, the Department is also working towards the beautification of the Solid Waste Management Clusters situated across the Islands. Towards this



endeavour, fruit and flower saplings are planted in the SWM Clusters also.

More such initiatives are being planned to be carried out in the coming days across the offices under the Department, a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

Media briefed on COVID-19

Drop in positive cases should not be construed as fight against COVID-19 is over: Secretary (Health)

Port Blair, July 12

The Secretary (Health), Shri Ram Niwas Sharma today urged the people not to be complacent and show lackadaisical attitude in following COVID Appropriate Behaviour and avoid unnecessary movement. Addressing the COVID-19 media briefing held in the conference hall of IP&T today, he said increase in the number of cases will ultimately lead to

more restrictions and to avoid such a situation, we should not let our guard down. Drop in positive cases should not be construed as fight against COVID-19 is over, he remarked.

The Secretary said, during the RTPCR test conducted on 533 flight passengers who arrived here yesterday and also during the test conducted on 170 persons bound for Middle & North

Andaman at Ferrargunj, no corona positive case was detected. Similarly, 12 passengers were tested at Helipad and no positive case was found. Apart from this, 92 outgoing boat passengers from Phoenix Bay Jetty and 98 boat passengers on their return journey were also tested and there too, no positive cases were detected. The mobile testing team visited Mithakari area during

which 61 persons were tested and no corona positive case was detected, said the Secretary adding that today, 1 flight with 150 passengers arrived at Port Blair and their RTPCR reports are awaited.

2,29,925 doses of vaccine administered to beneficiaries in A&N Islands so far

Port Blair, July 12

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 2,29,925 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 4116 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 3696 beneficiaries were



vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 550 were in the age group of 18-44 years. In Nicobar District, 420 beneficiaries were vaccinated. A total of 59,102 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

as well as wastage and intentional misuse/theft of drinking water from public distribution system.

Such grievances and complaints shall immediately be transferred to concerned Executive Engineer's looking after water supply in the area to ensure instant resolution. It has been planned to attend all such calls on priority basis and a time frame for resolution shall be informed within one hour to the call. Callers shall have option to declare their identity, address and share contact numbers for future response or they can call back themselves to get information on their response.

Each call shall have a Unique Call Identification (UCI) number for each day, which shall be used as reference for updated status on that particular grievance. This Toll Free Help Line on rural water supply is aimed at improving service efficiency in rural area. It shall provide one point solution to all water supply related grievance. Callers are also encouraged and invited for suggestion and feedback for better service delivery in the field of rural water supply, a press release from Director, ANSWSM said.

month shall lapse and food grains for the same will not be carried forward in the next month.

Further, all those AAY & PHH ration card holders who have not been able to receive their quota of sugar (12 kg) due to COVID-19 movement restrictions or any other reasons till the month of June, 2021 may now lift their quota of sugar till 31st July, 2021. Since this is one time opportunity, all such leftout AAY & PHH ration card holders have been requested to collect their quota of sugar before 31st July, 2021 after which no further extension shall be provided.

However, since portability has been implemented in the entire UT, ration card holders are free to collect their entitlement of food grains/sugar from any FPS of their choice. Further, the migrants of other States living in this UT and are covered under NFSA in their respective States/UTs can also receive food grains from any FPS of this UT under the One Nation One Ration Card Scheme.

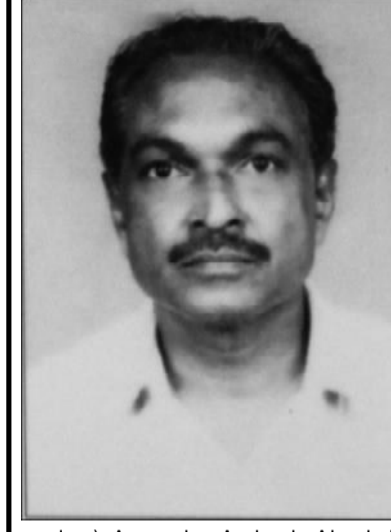

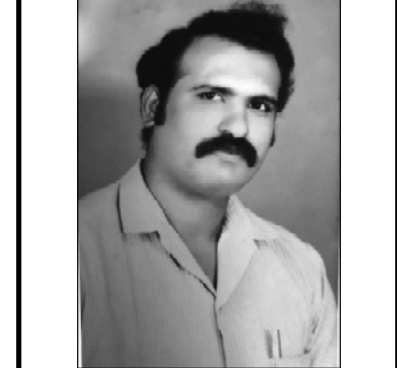

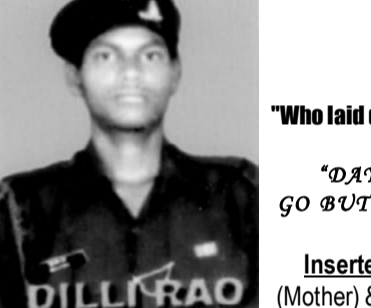
