

## Administration intensifies COVID-19 vaccination drive in A&N Islands

### Health Care Workers reaches out to people through door to door vaccination during a special drive

### Mission mode effort yields result with 3500 persons inoculated in a single day

Cumulative doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries reach 3, 87, 285 so far

Port Blair, Sept. 12

During the special vaccination drive, a total of 3500 persons were vaccinated in a single day today. The team of Directorate of Health Services in association with NGOs and Community Based Organizations organized vaccination camps at different places besides door to door vaccination was also carried out to cover maximum persons who are yet to receive their first dose. A list of left out persons has been prepared and they will be vaccinated tomorrow. To facilitate the special vaccination drive all the designated vaccination centres were made functional today wherein a good



number of eligible beneficiaries were inoculated. As per data available, a total of 3, 87, 285 doses of vaccines have been administered to the beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). 2541 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 1921 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-

44 years. Similarly, 928 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 650 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 31 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 18 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 1, 58, 617 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

The objective of the Family Planning Indemnity Scheme is to



indemnify all beneficiaries of sterilization, doctors and health facilities (public and accredited private/NGO) conducting sterilization operation in the unlikely event of death/failure/

complication following sterilization operation.

Recently, in compliance to the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India with respect to doubling of compensation under Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) and to share the burden thereof equally by the Govt. of India and the respective State Government, the UT Administration of A&N

## Media briefed on COVID-19 One positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Sept. 12

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening said that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 712 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 6 flights with 826 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 247 passengers bound for North & Middle



Andaman at Ferrargunj and two were found positive. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 167 passengers were tested and no positive case has been detected. Apart from this, 108 passengers travelling to Swaraj Dweep were tested at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. RTPCR test was

conducted on 14 crew members of MV Kamorta and the reports are awaited.

The Director said, today 354 beneficiaries were administered vaccines, out of which, 276 were in the age group of 18-44.

The Director, ANIIMS, Dr. AK Mandal said one COVID patient has been admitted in GB Pant Hospital. The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De stated that there are no COVID patients in COVID Care Centres.

**British teenager Emma Raducanu clinches Women's Singles US Open Tennis title**

New York, Sept. 12

Rising British sensation Emma Raducanu beat Leylah Fernandez of Canada to win Women's Singles title at US Open Tennis. The 18-year-old Emma Raducanu defeated her Canadian opponent in straight sets 6-4, 6-3 in the summit clash held at the Arthur Ashe Stadium in New York last night. She has become the first British woman to win the title in 53 years. Raducanu has also become the first British woman in 44 years to win a Grand Slam singles title.

village/locality, by providing knowledge tools and techniques for interacting with Government systems, banks and other institutions at all levels.

The leadership development training scheme shall be implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs through selected organizations. The selected organizations should implement the project directly through their organizational set-up in the locality/village/area. The Central Government and UT Administration training institutes including universities and institutes of higher learning can also implement the scheme. Organizations which would be eligible for applying for financial assistance under this scheme are Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860; a public Trust registered under any law for the time being in force, a private limited non-profit company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act, 1956; Universities/ Institutions of higher learning recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), Training institutes of Central and State Government/ UT Administration including Panchayati Raj Training institutes and Duly registered Cooperative Societies of Women/Self Help Groups.

The selected organization would have the responsibility to motivate, identify and select women to be trained in accordance with the criteria of the scheme from villages/urban localities having a substantial minority population. The organizations will involve Head of the Gram Panchayat/Municipal Body/Local Authority for identification/selection of women trainees.

The details of the trainees will be submitted by the organization before the start of training through the Online Application Management System (OAMS) for Nai Roshni, once the project is approved. Although there will be no annual income bar, a woman/parent or guardian of woman having annual income not exceeding Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources would be given preference in selection. They should be between the age group of 18 years to 65 years.

The proposal should be submitted in the prescribed format through Online Application Management System (OAMS). The link of OAMS is available on official website of Ministry of Minority Affairs i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. After filling up the complete proposal in the OAMS, a print of the same may be taken and submitted to the District Collector/ District Magistrate for their recommendation in the prescribed format. The detailed guidelines of the scheme are available on the website www.minorityaffairs.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

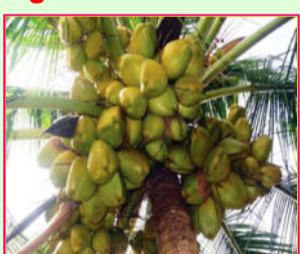

**Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub**

**Campbell Bay Tall - A promising coconut cultivar**

It is a cultivar of Car Nicobar Island having tall growth habit. Generally, the palms are morphologically similar to Andaman Ordinary Tall but with differences in nut characteristics. An accession collected and evaluated at World Coconut Germplasm Centre, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair has shown that the palms of this cultivar are robust, high yielding with higher copra content. The palms of this variety take about 5-7 years for first flowering. The kernel is thick and recorded higher milk recovery under VCO production process. The fruits are green red, husk thickness is thin (2.06cm), dehusked fruits are oblong, good tender nut water quantity (365 ml per fruit), average fruit weight over 1369.50g with average copra content of about 183g. The oil content is about 64.5%. Under the natural habitat of rainfed conditions in Car Nicobar, the palms exhibited large bole, stout stem, good fruit setting with estimated fruit yield of over 140 nuts per palm per year, regular production of bunches and dense crown. Careful mother palm selection followed by seedling selection is important to establish good plantation of Campbell Bay Tall considering the variability observed in the natural and conserved population. Benefit: There are no major pests recorded in this population. The cultivar has good tender nut water quantity (about 365ml per fruit) hence used for tender coconut purpose, copra making, processed coconut kernel products and VCO production.
