PM launches campaign to eradicate TB from India by 2025

New Delhi, Mar 13
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today launched a campaign to eradicate Tuberculosis, TB from India by 2025, five years ahead of a globally-set deadline.

After inaugurating the Delhi 'End-TB' Summit in New Delhi, the Prime Minister launched the TB-free India Campaign to take the activities under the National Strategic Plan for TB Elimination forward in a mission mode for ending the epidemic.

The Prime Minister said, a target has been set to end TB globally by 2030 and Government of India has set aim to eradicate it from



India five years ahead by 2025.

Shri Modi said, TB was declared emergency by WHO 25 years ago and India has come a long way in the fight against Tuberculosis. He said it is

important to get rid of Tuberculosis within the stipulated time period. Shri Modi said, new initiatives have been taken to eliminate the disease and budget allocation has been increased. He said,

nutritional support is being given through Direct Benefit Transfer. He added that government is engaging private sector in the schemes for better implementation.

Ministry of Power accords approval for setting up LNG Terminal & 50 MW Power Plant at Hope Town

Port Blair, Mar 13

The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray has taken up the issue of power situation in the Islands with the Ministry of Power, Govt of India. In pursuant to that, the Ministry of Power has accorded in-principle approval for setting up of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) terminal and 50 MW power plant at Shore Point, South Andaman District. It may be recalled that a meeting for reviewing the status was conveyed under the

Chairmanship of Minister of Power on 10-01-2018, wherein, it has been decided that M/s Petronet LNG Ltd may install FSRU and 50 MW Power Plant may be set up by NTPC. It was further deliberated that A & N Administration may issue a letter of award to M/s PLL for procurement of the plant. Accordingly, The MP, Shri Ray has requested the Administration for taking expeditious action to issue award of concession / license to

6 more Water Tenders to join A&N Fire Unit soon

The Fire Service Headquarter, a crucial unit of A&N Police which plays a vital role in Disaster Management and firefighting has responded to total 388 fire calls and 324 special calls (related to other emergencies such as uprooting of trees) during

the year 2017. Displaying tremendous courage and professionalism, the A&N Police Fire Service personnel while attending fire calls were able to save property valued at Rs. 13,69,44,000/ during the year 2017.

The Fire Service Unit is having a total strength of 638 personnel in 24 Fire



Stations spread across the Islands while it maintains a fleet of 39 Fire vehicles which include 29 Water Tenders, 5 water Bowzers, one each of Rescue Tender, Foam tender, Dry Chemical Powder (DCP) Tender and two Ambulances for immediate evacuation of the persons in emergent

situations. The A&N Fire Unit will be acquiring 6 new Water Tenders, the orders for which have been placed in 2017 and it is expected that the water tenders will be joining the fleet in April 2018.

Apart from this, two new fire station buildings were constructed, one each at Car

India's formidable duo of PV Sindhu and Kidambi Srikanth will have no dearth of motivation as they aim to win the coveted All England Championships starting on Wednesday — something their mentor P Gopichand won 17 summers back. The All England Championship is considered to be the ultimate glory for any shuttler worth his salt and in India only Prakash Padukone (1980) and Gopichand (2001) earned their rights to stand on the victory podium. Sindhu and Srikanth are expected to have easy first round outings against relatively unheralded opponents but the road is tricky for former finalist Saina Nehwal, who will face none other than world no 1 and defending champion Tai Tzu Ying of Chinese Taipei in the lung opener. Tai Tzu has proved to be her

nemesis with an overall 9-5 record against her. The Indian has lost the last seven outings, the most recent being at the Indonesia Masters final early in the year. Fourth seed Sindhu, on the other hand, would open her campaign against a relatively unknown Thai shuttler Pompaewee Chochuwong in

the opening round but could face her India Open conqueror Beiweng Zhang in the next. Srikanth, meanwhile, seems to have an easy opening round against Frenchman Brice Leverdez. The Indian badminton is going through a golden period with a clutch of world class performers in its ranks, courtesy Gopichand.

PR Sreejesh returns but Sardar dropped from India's CWG hockey squad

New Delhi, Mar 13
Seasoned goalkeeper PR Sreejesh made a comeback while former skipper Sardar Singh was dropped from the 18-member Indian hockey squad led by Manpreet Singh for the upcoming 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast. The Indian team are in Pool B along with Pakistan, Malaysia, Wales, England and will begin their campaign on April 7 against Pakistan. While Manpreet dons the captain's armband, the responsibilities of his deputy will be shouldered by Chinglensana Singh Kangujam.

It was under Manpreet's leadership the Indian team lifted the coveted Asia Cup 2017 followed by a bronze medal feat at the Men's Hockey World League Final in Bhubaneswar, last year. Veteran custodian Sreejesh is back after having suffered a medial collateral

ligament (MCL) injury during the Azlan Shah tournament in 2017. His brilliant show during the New Zealand tour saw him get his rightful place back. He will be backed by the 22-year-old talent Suraj Karkera who played a crucial part in the team's good show in Bhubaneswar last year in his senior counterpart's absence. Sardar's exclusion was on expected lines as he performed below-par at this year's Azlan Shah tournament. However a few eyebrows were raised with Ramandeep Singh being dropped despite his decent show in the same tournament. Youngsters Dilpreet Singh and Vivek Sagar Prasad, who made their international debut during the New Zealand tour have been rewarded with this opportunity for their good show. Both the players scored in important games. Freeman and drag-flick expert Rupinder Pal Singh will form

India's wall of defence along with Harmanpreet Singh, Varun Kumar, Kothajit Singh, Gurinder Singh and Amit Rohidas. India's midfield will see skipper Manpreet Singh in the lead role, ably supported by the experience of Chinglensana along with young blood in Sumit and Vivek.

KL Rahul becomes first Indian to get out hit-wicket in T20is

New Delhi, Mar 13
KL Rahul made a dubious distinction during the fourth game of the Nidahas T20I tri-series in Colombo on Monday as he became the first Indian to get out hit-wicket in the shortest format of the game. Rahul (18) played back to a Jeeven Mendis delivery in the 10th over looking for a single on the legside when his back foot disrupted the stumps. Rahul and Manish Pandey had added 23 runs for the fourth wicket when this uncommon incident happened. Only nine players before had got out in that fashion in T20is. Incidentally, Rahul had returned to India's playing XI replacing the out-of-form Rishabh Pant and desperately needed a solid innings to stake a claim for a regular berth in India's T20I team. Alas, his quest ended in one of the most unfortunate manners. Earlier in the day after rain reduced the match to 19 overs per side and Rohit Sharma

electd to bowl, medium pacer Shardul Thakur picked up a career-best 4/27, including back-to-back wickets in the last over, to help India restrict the hosts to 152/9. The Lankans were at one time on course for a big score at 96/2 in 10.3 overs when Vijay Shankar removed Upul Tharanga for 22. The complexion of the Sri Lankan innings changed in the blink of an eye thereafter. The 62-run third-wicket stand between Kusal Mendis (55 off 38 balls) and Tharanga had given the hosts a lot of hope but with the departure of Tharanga the Indian bowlers got back in charge of the proceedings. Sri Lanka, who were playing in this match without their regular captain Dinesh Chandimal, suspended on account of a slow over-rate offence against Bangladesh in Match 3, had Dasun Shanaka's 19 off 16 balls plenty to thank for taking them past the 150-run mark.

TB is responsible for 1.7 million deaths in 2016, despite most cases being curable while over 10 million people contract TB every year. The summit will set the stage for United Nations High-Level Meeting on TB in September this year, where for the first time, TB will be discussed in the UN General Assembly at the Heads of State level.

No. F. No. F.I (Legal)/6/317 In pursuance of Sub-Rule (2) of Rule 5 of the Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017 made under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Lt. Governor, A & N Islands in exercise of the powers conferred on him vide notification No. S.O.667(E) dated 10.09.1992 issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India, hereby constitutes the Union Territory Wetland Authority consisting of the following members:

- Chief Secretary, A & N Administration - Chairperson;
- Principal Secretary, Department of Environment & Forests - Vice Chairperson;
- Chief Wildlife Warden - Member ex-officio;
- Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests of the Regional Office of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change-Member ex-officio;
- Principal Secretary, Department of Revenue - Member ex-officio;
- Principal Secretary, Department of Urban Development - Member ex-officio;
- Principal Secretary, Department of RD, PRIs and ULBs - Member ex-officio;
- Secretary, Department of Fisheries - Member ex-officio;
- Secretary, Department of Tourism - Member ex-officio;
- Member Secretary, Union Territory Pollution Control Committee - Member ex-officio;
- Dr. B. Gangaiah, HoD, NRM, ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Garacharama, Port Blair - Expert Member (Wetland ecology);
- Dr. R. Kirubasankar, Scientist, ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Garacharama, Port Blair - Expert Member (Fisheries);
- Dr. N. V. Vinithkumar, Scientist - E & Officer-In-Charge, ANCOST - NIOT, Industrial Estate Road, Near Minnie Bay, Dollygunj, Port Blair -Expert Member (Hydrology);
- Shri. M. Balamurugan, Town & Country Planner, Town & Country Planning Unit, APWD, Port Blair - Expert Member (Landscape Planning)
- Shri. Amlanjyoti Kar, Regional Director (In-charge), CGWB ER, Kolkata - Expert Member;
- Chief Conservator of Forests (Research & Working Plan), Department of Environment & Forests - Member Secretary.

2. The Union Territory Wetland Authority may co-opt any member having expertise in the subject to assist the authority in its functioning, if required.

3. The Authority shall exercise the powers and perform the functions as per Sub-Rule 4 of Rule 5 of the Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017 which are as follows:

- Prepare a list of all wetlands of the State or Union Territory within three months from the date of publication of these rules;
- Prepare a list of wetlands to be notified, within six months from the date of publication of these rules; taking into cognizance any existing list of wetlands prepared/notified under other relevant State Acts;
- Recommend identified wetlands, based on their Brief Documents, for regulation under these rules;
- Prepare a comprehensive digital inventory of all wetlands within a period of one year from the date of publication of these rules and upload the same on a dedicated web portal to be developed by the Central Government for the said purpose; the inventory to be updated every ten years;
- Develop a comprehensive list of activities to be regulated and permitted within the notified wetlands and their zone of influence;
- Recommend additions, if any, to the list of prohibited activities for specific wetlands;
- Define strategies for conservation and wise use of wetlands within their jurisdiction; wise use being a principle for managing these ecosystems which incorporates sustainable uses (such as capture fisheries at subsistence level or harvest of aquatic plants) as being compatible with conservation, if ecosystem functions (such as water storage, groundwater recharge, flood buffering) and values (such as recreation and cultural) are maintained or enhanced;
- Review integrated management plan for each of the notified wetlands (including trans-boundary wetlands in coordination with Central Government), and within these plans consider continuation and support to traditional uses of wetlands which are harmonized with ecological character;
- In cases wherein lands within boundary of notified wetlands or wetlands complex have private tenancy rights, recommend mechanisms for maintenance of ecological character through promotional activities;
- Identify mechanisms for convergence of implementation of the management plan with the existing State/Union Territory level development plans and programmes;
- Ensure enforcement of these rules and other relevant Acts, rules and regulations and on half-yearly basis (June and December of each calendar year) inform the concerned State Government or Union Territory Administration or Central Government on the status of such notified wetlands through a reporting mechanism;
- Coordinate implementation of integrated management plans based on wise use principle through various line departments and other concerned agencies;
- Function as nodal authority for all wetland specific authorities within the State or Union Territory Administration;
- Issue necessary directions for conservation and sustainable management of wetlands to the respective implementing agencies;
- Undertake measures for enhancing awareness within stakeholders and local communities on values and functions of wetlands; and
- Advise on any other matter suo-motu, or as referred by the State Government/Union Territory Administration.

4. The Authority shall constitute the technical committee and grievance committee as per Sub-Rule 6 of Rule 5 of the Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017.

5. The Chief Conservator of Forests, Research & Working Plan shall, within a period of one year from the date of publication of these rules, prepare a Brief Document for each of the wetland identified for notification, providing:

- Demarcation of wetland boundary supported by accurate digital maps with coordinates and validated by ground truthing;
- Demarcation of its zone of influence and land use and land cover thereof indicated in a digital map;
- Ecological character description;
- Account of pre-existing rights and privileges;
- List of site-specific activities to be permitted within the wetland and its zone of influence;
- List of site specific activities to be regulated within the wetland and its zone of influence; and
- Modalities for enforcement of regulation;

6. The Authority based on the Brief Document, shall make recommendations to the A & N Administration for notifying the wetlands.

7. The A & N Administration shall, after considering the objections, if any, from the concerned and affected persons, notify the wetlands in the Official Gazette, within a period not exceeding 240 days from the date of recommendation by the Authority.

8. The Authority shall meet at least thrice in a year.

9. The term of the non-official members of the Authority, if any, nominated by the Union Territory at any point of time shall be for a period not exceeding three years.

10. The Office of Chief Conservator of Forests (Research & Working Plan), Department of Environment & Forests shall provide all necessary support and act as the Nodal Department and Secretariat to the Authority.
