India, in December 2003. Prime Minister Shri Modi had laid the foundation stone of the memorial on

Five more ships join A&N Coast Guard fleet Induction of these ships will strengthen Coast Guard's capabilities: CS

Port Blair, April 13

Two Fast Patrol Vessels of the Coast Guard, ICGS Rajdhvaj and ICGS Rajtarang and three Interceptor Boats ICGS C 422, ICGS C 415 and ICGS C 423 have been inducted into the fleet of Coast Guard Region, A & N Islands. At an induction ceremony held at Coast Guard Jetty here today, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar, chief guest of the function, unveiled a plaque and inducted the ships into the fleet, in the presence of Commander Coast Guard, A & N Region, IG K R Suresh.

The chief guest lauded the activities of Coast Guard in the Islands and said that the induction of the ships in the Coast Guard fleet will strengthen the Coast Guard's capability to carry out its operation in a more efficient manner in the Islands. The presence of the Coast Guard in the Islands has been felt by the



Islanders, as it has been instrumental in saving many lives, particularly the Islands fishermen, besides in medical evacuation of critical patients and search and rescue operation, he said.

Referring to the considerable reduction in the number of poachers, the Chief Secretary said that

Observance of Fire Service Week from today

Port Blair, April 13

Together with the rest of the country, the A&N Police Fire Service will be observing the Fire Service Week from April 14 to 20. The Theme for this year's observance is 'Fire loss is National Loss - Let us adopt Fire Safety Measures'.

The week long programme will start with a Commemoration Day Parade on 14th April, followed by publicity & educational campaigns through banners, educational pamphlets, short video screening, Lectures and Demonstrations at various

Institutions including Village Community Centers, Schools etc. The programme also includes inspection of industrial premises, hospitals, hotels and resorts, in order to make them aware of fire safety issues & requirements.

The main function on the Fire Service Day will be held at 7 am at Fire Service HQ Port Blair tomorrow. Two minutes silence will be observed to pay homage to those Fire Service personnel who laid down their lives for ensuring fire safety of our countrymen all over the

nation. Soon after the parade, Fleet March of Fire Vehicles shall be taken out in and around Port Blair town. Similar programme are also being organised in Fire Stations located in far flung Islands.

The Fire Service Week is organized every year in memory of a major fire incident that occurred on 14th April 1944, at 'Victoria Harbour' in Mumbai, in which 336 persons died and 1040 were injured. Out of 336 who died, 68 were Officers and Jawans of Mumbai Fire Brigade. The tragedy occurred when a

Anish Bhanwala, Bajrang, Punia, Tejaswini Sawant storms to gold, silver for Pooja Dhanda & Anjum Moudgil

Gold Coast, April 13

India's gold rush at the 2018 Commonwealth Games has continued with Bajrang Punia delivering a 17th yellow metal in the men's freestyle 65kg while Pooja Dhanda has won silver in the women's 57kg freestyle on day nine of competition at Gold Coast, Australia.

Teenaged wrestler Divya Kakran, who claimed medals at the Asian and Commonwealth Wrestling Championships last year, has marked her first appearance at the Commonwealth Games by winning bronze in the women's 68kg freestyle event. India's last wrestling medal contest of the day ended up in a silver medal finish after Mausam Khatri lost 2-12 to Martin Erasmus of South Africa in a one-sided contest.

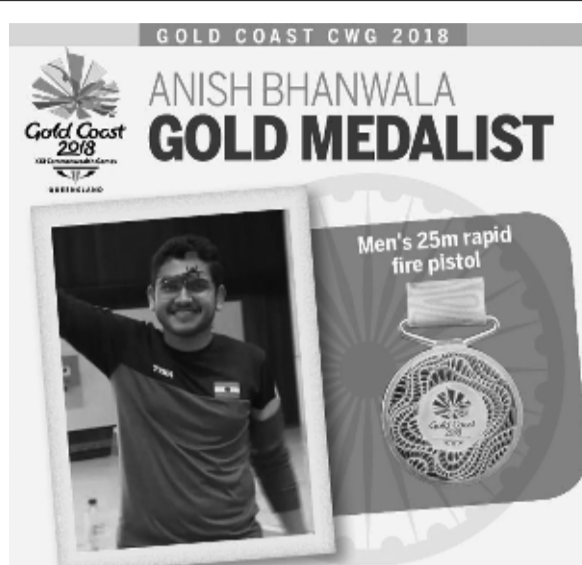
Bajrang, who won a 61kg silver four years ago at the Glasgow Games, turned in an utterly dominating performance against Kane Charig of Wales, whom he defeated 10-0 in just over two minutes.

India's sporting contingent at the ongoing 2018 Commonwealth Games has surpassed the gold medal tally achieved four years ago in Glasgow, with 15-year-old Anish Bhanwala winning the country's 16th gold on Friday.

In a sensational CWG debut at the Belmont Shooting Centre, the teenage pistol sensation - who this year was awarded Emerging Player of the Year at the Times of India Sports Awards (TOISA) - entered the six-man men's 25m rapid fire pistol finals having topped the second stage of qualification with a total score of 580-22x, and then shot a Games record score of 30 to win the finals and become the youngest Indian gold medalist at the CWG.

India's medal rush at the 2018 Commonwealth Games has continued with shooter Tejaswini Sawant winning gold in the women's 50m rifle 3 position finals, followed by Anjum Moudgil with silver. With Sawant's gold, India have matched the 15 gold medals won four years ago at the Glasgow CWG.

Sawant, 37, had entered the eight-member women's 50m rifle 3 positions after finishing third in qualification with a total of 582-31x, while Moudgil had topped it with a qualifying record total of 589-32x. In the finals, the 24-year-old Moudgil stayed in contention for a medal with strong series of shots, and as the competition was whittled away her scores ensured she was in line for gold with compatriot Sawant. She finished second to Sawant with a combined score of 455.7 for her first CWG medal.

62 lives, evacuate 9 critical patients and conducted 24 search & rescue operations, he said. The induction of the ships in the fleet will enhance the Coast Guard's reach in the far flung Islands, he said.

Later, the chief guest was taken onboard the newly inducted ships and was apprised of their operational capability.

The Indian Coast Guard Region (A&N) has earned laurels for its swift and optimally calibrated response to numerous challenges in past and has continued to register all round growth whilst beholding the Isles confidence in delivering maritime challenges and imperatives obligated upon Coast Guard. This region has been able to meet the expectations of mariners at large in ensuring safety of life and property at sea, which is going to be more robust with rebasing of new assets. Accordingly, Ambedkar Jayanti will be celebrated tomorrow (April 14) during which district workshops on taking forward Dr. Ambedkar's ideas will be conducted besides camps for Caste/Income Certificate; Scholarship Enrolment, Bank Account and Adhaar linkage will be organized. Similarly, on April 18, 'Swachh Bharat Parv' will be organized wherein cleanliness drives will be carried out in every village besides solid and liquid resource management programmes.

On April 20, 'Ujjawala Diwas' will be celebrated during which issuance of new LPG connections at Panchayat level will be carried out. On April 24, 'Panchayati Raj Diwas' will be organized at both National and Gram Sabha level during which Public Information Campaigns will be held.

Meanwhile, 'Gram Shakti Abhiyan' will be held on April 28 when kiosk, stalls and counters on Saubhagya (Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana) will be set up during which sale of LED bulbs by EESL will be carried out for consumers. On April 30, 'Ayushman Bharat Abhiyan' will be celebrated wherein validation will be carried out at Gram Panchayat level for capturing additional information of eligible beneficiaries viz. phone no. ration card, family details etc. The eligible beneficiaries will be reached and explained about the process. On May 2, 'Kisan Kalyan Karyashala' will be organized at block level in which workshop on 'Doubling Farmers' Income' will be organized for the farmers at village level.

During the 'Gram Swaraj Abhiyan', awareness/enrollment programmes on seven schemes covering pro-poor initiatives viz. Pradhan Mantri Ujjawala Yojana (free LPG connection for eligible families), Saubhagya (Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana), Ujala scheme (affordable LEDs for all), Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyothi Bima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana and Mission Indradanush will be carried out at district levels as well as the Gram Panchayats across the Islands. People have been asked to come forward and get themselves enrolled for the schemes. They will be assisted by the concerned persons and forms will be available in all 70 Gram Panchayats, SDM Office, BDO Office, CDPO, DC Office (South, North & Middle and Nicobar Districts) and all banking sectors.

Explaining about Mission Indradanush, the Deputy Director (Health), Dr. Avijit Roy informed that under Mission Indradanush, immunization of 9 different vaccines (0-5 years) will be verified and missed out and drop out children residing in different pockets of the Islands will be covered through the support of Anganwadi workers and ANMs. Meanwhile, the Measles Rubella campaign got underway in different parts of the Islands yesterday.

Under Ujala scheme, the SE, Electricity, Shri U. K. Paul informed that 4 LED bulbs will be provided at subsidized cost and those who have not purchased the LED bulbs may approach the Site Offices while solar lighting facility will also be made available to eligible beneficiaries.
