## Cabinet approves MSP hike for Kharif crops for 2026-27 season

New Delhi, May 13  
 The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved an increase in Minimum Support Prices (MSP) for 14 Kharif Crops for Marketing Season 2026-27. Addressing the media after the Union Cabinet meeting, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw said the Government has increased the MSP of Kharif Crops to ensure remunerative prices to the growers for their produce. He said, for the Kharif season, the estimated payout to the farmers will be two lakh 60 thousand crore rupees. He said an estimated over 824 lakh metric tonnes of crops will be procured in the season. Shri Vaishnaw said the highest increase of 622 rupees per quintal in MSP has been recommended for Sunflower Seed, followed by 557 per quintal for Cotton and 500 rupees per quintal for Sesamum. He said, for Grade A Paddy, the MSP will be 2 thousand 461 rupees per quintal, for Jowar Hybrid it will be 4 thousand and 23 rupees per quintal, for Bajra the MSP will be 2 thousand 900 rupees and for Tur, it will be 8 thousand 450 rupees per quintal. ## CBSE declares All India Senior Secondary Class 12<sup>th</sup> results

New Delhi, May 13  
 The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) today announced the Class 12 board examination results. Students can check their result on the official website, DigiLocker and UMANG App by mentioning Roll number. This year, the CBSE Class 12 exams were conducted between February 17 and April 10, 2026 across Science, Commerce, and Humanities streams. In a statement, CBSE informed that over 17 lakh 68 thousand students appeared in the exams, and over 15 lakh 7 thousand students passed. The overall pass percentage this year is 85.20 percent. The pass percentage for girls is 88.86 percent, while for boys it is 82.13 percent. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

## SVPMC conducts eviction drive; warns against encroachment in Non-Vending Zone

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 13  
 As part of its ongoing efforts to maintain public order, ensure smooth pedestrian movement, and regulate the use of public spaces, Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council (SVPMC) conducted a targeted anti-encroachment drive in the city. During the drive, unauthorized shops operating near the Government Girls' Senior Secondary School were removed by the enforcement team. The shops were found to have been established in a restricted area in violation of municipal norms governing the use of public spaces and non-vending zones. The SVPMC has reiterated its strict stance against unauthorized commercial activities in prohibited areas and issued a strong appeal to all vendors and shop owners to adhere to municipal regulations. The Council specifically emphasized that the stretch from Rama Krishna Mission to Flag Point has been designated as a Non-Vending Zone, and no commercial activity will be permitted in this area. The Council further stated that it follows a zero-tolerance policy towards encroachments on footpaths, roadsides, and other notified non-vending areas. Any unauthorized structures or stalls erected in such locations are liable to be removed without further notice. Vendors and shopkeepers have been advised to operate only within designated vending zones and ensure possession of valid municipal permissions and licenses.
