The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration, dedicated a newly constructed 5 MT Ice Plant to the fishermen community of Govind Nagar, Swaraj Dweep, in a ceremony held today. The facility was dedicated by Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, in the presence of senior officers, Pradhan, Govind Nagar, Shri Ajit Kumar Roy and Pradhan, Shyam Nagar, Shri Alok Mridha, members of the local fishing community and others.

Constructed to strengthen the post-harvest fisheries infrastructure in Swaraj Dweep, the Ice Plant has the capacity to produce

120 ice blocks of 55 kg each per day. The facility is expected to directly benefit around 250 fishermen and more than 80 fishing boats operating from the area by ensuring the timely availability of quality ice for fish preservation. The project will help reduce post-harvest losses, maintain the freshness and quality of fish, and enhance the fish handling and

preservation capacity of Swaraj Dweep, thereby improving the availability of fresh seafood for both residents and tourists visiting the Islands.

In his inaugural address, Chief Secretary emphasized the Administration's commitment to the sustainable development of the fisheries sector. He

Renovated HDPE Floating Jetty at Elephant Beach, Swaraj Dweep inaugurated



HDPE Floating Jetty at Elephant Beach

Swaraj Dweep, July 13

In a boost to tourism infrastructure, the Tourism Department has completed the repair, re-installation and extension of the HDPE floating jetty system at Elephant Beach, Swaraj Dweep. The project has restored a key tourism facility that had suffered extensive damage over the years due to harsh tidal action and repeated cyclones. The floating jetty was inaugurated today by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, in the presence of senior officers of A&N Administration.

The upgraded floating jetty significantly enhances safety and convenience for tourists visiting the popular beach destination. As part of the restoration work, the existing floating structure was repaired, damaged HDPE cubicles were replaced, and sturdy stainless-steel handrails were installed. The project also included the extension of the main first and second HDPE floating jetty sections beyond their earlier lengths of 86 metres and 56.50 metres respectively. The upgraded facility is

The Chief Secretary emphasized on planting of spices and fruit bearing trees in Shaheed Dweep owing to its fertile soils and hardwork of the farmers. Here requested the farmers of Shaheed Dweep to avail the benefits from Agriculture Department in growing the Spices and Fruit bearing trees in their farms which can also support their families in long run. South Andaman Police intensifies excise
enforcement across district

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 13

In a concerted effort to curb the illegal possession, sale of liquor, South Andaman Police carried out a series of successful excise enforcement operations across the district during the past week. Acting on intelligence inputs, routine patrolling, and targeted drives, multiple police stations registered cases under the relevant provisions of the Excise Regulation.

The most significant operation was conducted by PS Pahargaon, where police seized 93 bottles of IMFL from a room near the Vegetable Market. The operation was led by Insp. Sahil Shamsuddin, SHO PS Pahargaon. In another operation, the same police station recovered 08 bottles of illicit IMFL near NK Crusher, Kamaraj Nagar, from a habitual excise

offender with multiple previous involvements. These operations underscore the proactive enforcement efforts of PS Pahargaon against illegal liquor trade.

A team from PS Ograbraj conducted a jungle search at Ram Nagar and detected 50 litres of lehan (fermented wash) stored in plastic containers for illicit liquor preparation. The entire quantity was destroyed on the spot after photography and videography as per prescribed procedure, thereby preventing the manufacture of illegal liquor.

During patrolling at Ongi Tikrey, Little Andaman, PS Hut Bay recovered 18 kg of illicit handia (14 kg in a plastic bucket and 4 kg in an aluminium container) concealed behind a residence. A sample was collected for chemical

analysis and a case was registered under Section 32 of Regulation III of 1876.

Additional operations by PS Aberdeen, PS Humfrygunj, and PS Hut Bay resulted in the seizure of multiple bottles of IMFL from Ratna Market, Wandoor, and V.K. Pur, Little Andaman. All cases have been registered under the relevant provisions of the Excise Regulation, and further investigations are in progress.

The public have been requested to support the ongoing enforcement drive by sharing information regarding illegal liquor, narcotics, or any other unlawful activities with the nearest police station or through Police Emergency Helpline 112. The identity of informants will be kept strictly confidential, a press release from SP (SA) said.

at Police Marine Force Headquarters

A coordination meeting under the Chairmanship of Ms. Shweta K. Sugathan, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Police Marine Force (PMF), was held recently at the PMF Headquarters, to review and strengthen coastal security measures across the Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

The meeting was attended by officers of the Police Marine Force, District Police, Fisheries Department and Sagar Mitras through both physical and virtual modes. The discussions focused on enhancing inter-departmental coordination for securing Ports, Fish Landing Centres, Fish Landing Points, and other vulnerable coastal areas.

During the meeting, emphasis was laid on strengthening intelligence gathering through active participation of the fishing community,

promoting regular interaction between Police and Sagar Mitras, improving information sharing, and encouraging prompt reporting of suspicious activities at sea. Directions were also issued for the formation of dedicated communication groups, regular awareness programmes, and enhanced coordination among all stakeholders.

Several operational issues raised by the Fisheries Department and field officers including illegal fishing, unregistered boats, installation of CCTV cameras at Fish Landing Centres, registration of fishing boats, and the operational readiness of Distress Alert Transmitters (DATs), were discussed in detail.

Appropriate action points were assigned to the concerned departments for timely compliance, a press release from SP (PMF) said.

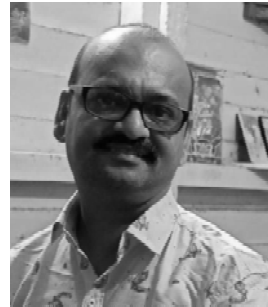
