PM expresses happiness over Guinness world record of PAHAL scheme

New Delhi, Aug 13
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has expressed happiness over the PAHAL scheme that has set Guinness world record for the largest cash transfer programme. PAHAL scheme, which covers more than 9.75 crore LPG consumers, is one of the world's largest cash transfer program.



Under the scheme, LPG cylinders are sold at market rates and entitled consumers get the subsidy directly into their bank accounts. It is done either through an Aadhaar linkage or a bank account linkage. The scheme aims at reducing diversion and eliminating duplicate or bogus LPG connections.

The success of the scheme is a result of an intensive Information Education Campaign comprising advertising through various means, direct reaching out to consumers, and dealer level campaigns. The Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has undertaken several innovative measures such as guardian officers for each district, deployment of technology by use of SMS, and a single window portal www.mylpg.in to enable consumers to join the scheme.

The Union Territory Level Bankers' Committee (UTLBC) meeting was held in the conference hall of Megapode Resort here today. The Chief Secretary, Shri Anand Prakash was the chief guest while the Deputy General Manager, SBI LHO Kolkata, Shri Suresh Manikoth presided over the meeting. The meeting reviewed performances of banks during the quarter ending June, 2015.



Addressing the meeting, the Chief Secretary stressed for bringing improvement in the investment loan, so as to boost economic growth in the Islands. Financing of viable

activities will not only lead to economic growth, but will also improve the credit deposit (C:D) ratio, which is well below the national benchmark, he said.

taken up various steps in enrolling people under these schemes, further efforts need to be made to achieve total financial inclusion in the Islands, he said adding that UTLBC is a platform for interaction on various banking issues which need to be addressed.

Hawkers to sell goods at ITF Ground, Anarkali, Lalta Singh Ground, & Bathubasti parking area on Aug 15

Port Blair, Aug 13
It had been a practice for some shopkeepers/hawkers to display their old stocks of everyday items such as clothes, utensils, shoes, plastic buckets etc. on the roadside at Aberdeen Bazaar for sale on the days of National importance such as Independence Day and Republic Day. Since these old stocks are being sold at very cheap rates, a massive crowd is attracted for purchase of the

goods. The situation from the point of law and order and public safety is very dangerous as any sort of rumour, quarrel, mischief or even an animal could cause a stampede, resulting in drastic consequences in Aberdeen Bazaar. It is also apprehended that if any fire incident takes place at the time it is impossible for the fire tenders to reach the spot and the situation then would be

disastrous. Local residents around the area also complained of inconvenience and inability to approach or leave their residences. To regulate law and order and also to facilitate the general public, decongest, pedestrianize the main Aberdeen Bazaar and keeping in mind the safety & security of the shoppers, shopkeepers, market place and residents of the area, a hawking scheme was devised during the

Independence Day-2011 and a new venue at ITF Ground was opened only for the hawkers. The hawking scheme devised and active at ITF ground during National Functions have also started attracting huge crowd causing congestion to traffic and it is imperative that more such places may be identified for the hawkers to display and sell their goods during the occasional bazaar. 

London Olympics bronze-medallist Saina, on the other hand, overcame the 14th-seeded Sayaka Takahashi of Japan 21-18 21-14 in 47 minutes. If Saina and Sindhu are able to win their respective quarterfinal matches, they would both be

assured of at least a bronze medal each. Sindhu will next take on eighth seeded Sung Ji-hyun of South Korea and Saina would be up against the winner of the match between Wang Yihan and Bae Yeon Ju.

He urged all the bankers to spread the messages of the benefit of these schemes so that more people can enroll themselves. He informed that C:D ratio is a matter of concern and said that all banks should take initiatives to improve it. He also stressed on the need for organizing more financial literacy camps at different parts of the Islands and to make people aware of the benefit of banking.

Shri Gopal Krishna Mohan, DGM, FIDD RBI Kolkata appealed to the UTLBC meeting to focus on the issues which come in the way of performing well as also for making banking services adequately available to the people.

Shri Hemant Songadkar, GM NABARD called for synergy among the implementing agencies in improving Islands' economy. He also stressed the need to consider SHGs, JLGs and NGOs for providing financial assistance as also for quality lending, which will lead to improvement in the C:D ration and will automatically convert Non Profitable Assets (NPA) into New Profitable Avenues (NPA).
