LG visits Bambooflat

Reiterates commitment of Govt. towards welfare of every section of society



Port Blair, Sept 13
The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi visited Bambooflat and held interactions with the PRI members and general public of Stewartgunj and its adjacent areas in the community Hall, Stewartgunj this evening. During the interaction, the Lt. Governor outlined the goals of the Administration and stated that by 2018, the entire A&N Islands will be converted into green energy efficient Islands by utilizing solar generated power and other eco friendly power generating sources.



The Lt. Governor highlighted the commitment of the Govt. of India to establish renewable sources of energy, including solar, wind, tidal waves and hydraulic energy, to meet the power requirements of the Islands. He said that the work for 20MW solar plant has already been initiated in these Isles. The Lt. Governor informed that experts will also be invited to explore the feasibility for establishing wind as well as tidal wave energy in the Islands.

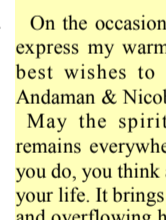

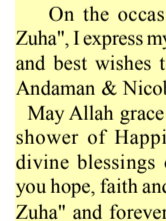

New Delhi, Sept. 13
India's Deepa Malik has created history by becoming the first woman from India to win a medal at the Paralympics as she bagged a silver in the shotput event at Rio De Janeiro.



Deepa's best throw of 4.61 metres from her six attempts was enough to clinch the silver medal.
India now have secured three medals from the Rio Paralympics. Deepa will receive a cash award of Rs 4 crore under Haryana Sports Scheme for her feat.
Bahrain's Fatema Nedham won the gold medal with a best throw of 4.76 metres, while Dimitra Korokida of Greece bagged the bronze medal with a throw of 4.28 metres.

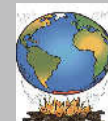
