PM addresses Sri Aurobindo's 150th birth anniversary; releases commemorative coin and postal stamp

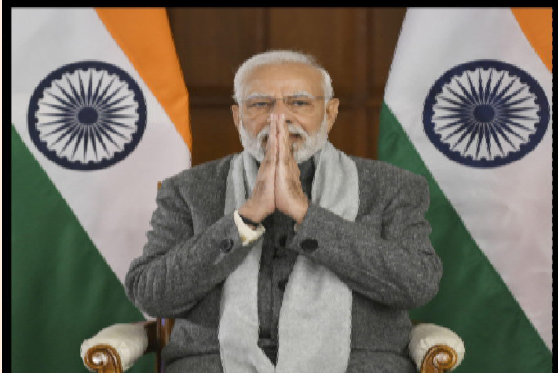

Life of Sri Aurobindo is a reflection of 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat'

New Delhi, Dec. 13 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed a programme celebrating Sri Aurobindo's 150th birth anniversary via video conferencing today in Kamban Kalai Sangam, Puducherry under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The Prime Minister also released a commemorative coin and postal stamp in honour of Sri Aurobindo.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister underlined the importance of the occasion of Sri



Aurobindo's 150th birth anniversary which is being celebrated with great fervour throughout the year. The Prime Minister highlighted that the nation is paying tributes to Sri Aurobindo by releasing a commemorative coin and postal stamp. The Prime Minister

expressed the belief that such efforts by the nation will give new energy and strength to India's resolutions. The Prime Minister said that when a number of great events take place simultaneously, often there is 'Yoga-Shakti' i.e. a collective and uniting

power behind them. The Prime Minister recalled many great personalities who not only contributed to the freedom struggle but also gave fresh life to the soul of the nation. Among them, three personalities, Sri Aurobindo, Swami Vivekananda and

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has launched the Pradhan Mantri TB Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan on September 9, 2022 which was envisioned to bring together all community stakeholders (Ni-kshay Mitra/Donor) to support those on TB treatment, help to accelerate the country's progress towards TB elimination and to make this campaign a mass movement.

There is an inferiority complex associated with this disease, and the disease is viewed as

a stigma, which also has to be eradicated. Everyone should be made aware that TB germs are often present in everyone's body and when the immunity of a person, due to some reason, decreases, then this disease spreads in that person. With treatment, one can definitely get rid of this disease. The type of additional assistance that may be provided by the Ni-kshay Mitra to on-treatment TB patients who have given consent for support shall include Nutritional support, A d d i t i o n a l

investigations for the diagnosed TB patients, vocational support, additional nutritional supplements & minimum period of commitment for providing additional support to the TB patient shall be 6 months. Ni-kshay Mitra (Donor) for this programme includes co-operative societies, corporates, elected representatives, individuals, institutions, non-governmental organizations, political parties and partners who can support by adopting the health facilities (for individual

donor), blocks/urban wards/districts/States for accelerating the response against TB to complement the Government efforts, as per the district-specific requirements in coordination with the District Administration. Shri Suneel Anchipakka, Deputy Commissioner/Chairman, District Health Society (SA) has appealed the NGOs, Civil Societies, Religious groups & individuals to come forward to provide nutritional support to

India aims to mobilize one billion people to take action against climate change: NITI Aayog CEO

Mumbai, Dec. 13

NITI Aayog's CEO, Shri Parameeswar Iyer today said that Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment) is a dedicated, mission mode and India lead global movement that aims to bring individual and community behaviour at centre of climate action. He was virtually delivering a presentation on Mission LiFE at 1st Development Working Group meeting in a side event on 'Infusing new LiFE into Green Development' held in Mumbai. He said, India aims to mobilize one billion people to take

individual and collective action against climate change through 2022-28. Shri Iyer said, India is nudging individuals, communities, and institutions to practice simple climate-friendly actions in their daily life. These 75 actions are categorized under Energy saved, Water saved, Single-use plastic reduced, sustainable food system adopted, waste reduced, healthy lifestyle adopted and E-waste reduced, he added. He said that these actions are easy to practice by individuals and likely to promote economic activity. The CEO informed that

Mission LiFE is endorsed by 10 countries including United Kingdom, France, etc. India has also proposed UN international LiFE Day, he added. India's G20 Sherpa, Shri Amitabh Kant said that Mission LiFE has a lot to do with nudging behaviour. It is not countries that will make the change, it is individual and collective behaviour that will make the difference. He was delivering an opening speech in side event on 'Infusing new LiFE into Green Development' at 1st Development Working Group's

meeting in Mumbai today. He clarified that LiFE is not about anti-consumerism. It is a completely new model of development which involves a behavioral change to new areas of growth, he added. He said that, the challenge for India and other developing countries is to follow a growth model that is different than developed nations like America. PS Aberdeen cracks burglary case; one arrested

PS Aberdeen Police cracked a burglary case within hours, which occurred in the ANIDCO Wine shop at Junglight, during the intervening night of Dec.10 & 11, 2022 by arresting one burglar and recovering stolen IMFL bottles. The burglary case was reported at PS Aberdeen on Dec.11, 2022 at 1300 hours. As per the complaint, on Dec.10, 2022, Manager, ANIDCO Wine shop, Junglight had closed the shop at about 2120 hours and on Dec.11, 2022 at 0820 hours, when they came to open the shop, they found

that the shutter of the shop was opened and 4 carton boxes containing 180 ml bottle of IMFL worth Rs 22,080/- were stolen. Upon this, an FIR was registered and investigation was entrusted to SI R. Dhiraj Kishen of the PS. A team was constituted consisting of SI R. Dhiraj Kishen (I.O), HC Sunil Singh Yadav, PCs S.N Rao, Sandeep Lakra, Ashish Singh and Shiv Kumar under the supervision of Insp. Girish Kumar, SHO PS Aberdeen for the search of the accused and stolen property. The team swung into action and working professionally, nabbed

the accused person, a resident of Brookshabad and recovered 119 stolen IMFL bottles within 4 hours of reporting of the crime. The entire investigation took place under the supervision of Shri Sunny Gupta, IPS, Sub Divisional Police Officer, South Andaman. Sri Aurobindo returned to India and in the same year Swami Vivekananda went to America to deliver his iconic speech at the World's Parliament of Religions. Gandhi ji went to South Africa in the same year, which marked the beginning of his transformation into Mahatma Gandhi, the Prime Minister added. He noted the similar confluence of events in the present time when the country is celebrating 75 years of Independence and starting its journey of Amrit Kaal as we are witnessing the 150th anniversary of Sri Aurobindo and the 125th Anniversary of Netaji Subhas. "When motivation and action meet, even the seemingly impossible goal is inevitably accomplished. Nation's successes in the Amrit Kaal today and resolution of 'Sabka Prayas' are proof of this ", he said.

The Prime Minister said that the life of Sri Aurobindo is a reflection of 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' as he was born in Bengal and knew many languages including Gujarati, Bengali, Marathi, Hindi and Sanskrit. He spent most of his life in Gujarat and Puducherry and left a deep imprint wherever he went. Throwing light on the teachings of Sri Aurobindo, the Prime Minister remarked that when we become aware of our traditions and culture and begin to live through them, it is at that moment when our diversity becomes a natural celebration of our lives. "It is a source of great inspiration for Azadi Ka Amrit Kaal. There is no better way to explain Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat other than this", he said.

The Prime Minister pointed out that Sri Aurobindo was such a personality whose life had a modern scientific temper, political rebelliousness and a sense of the divine as well. The Prime Minister recalled his 'no compromise' slogan during the division of Bengal. His ideological clarity, cultural strength and patriotism made him a role model for the freedom fighters of that time. Shri Modi also dwelled on the sage-like aspects of Shri Aurobindo who used to hold forth on deep philosophical and spiritual issues. He added the element of social service to the Upanishads. The Prime Minister pointed out that we are embracing all views in our journey of developed India without any feeling of inferiority. We are working with the Mantra of 'India First' and placing our heritage with pride before the entire world.

"India is that immortal seed which may be suppressed a little under adverse circumstances, may wither a little, but it cannot die", the Prime Minister continued remarking on the rich cultural history and said, "India is the most refined idea of human civilization, the most natural voice of humanity." Talking about the cultural immortality of India, the Prime Minister said, "India was immortal even in the time of Maharishi Aurobindo, and it is immortal even today in the Azadi Ka Amrit Kaal." The Prime Minister concluded his address by noting the dire challenges faced by the world of today and underlined the importance of India's role in overcoming these challenges. "That's why we have to prepare ourselves by taking inspiration from Maharishi Aurobindo and create a developed India by Sabka Prayas", he concluded.




