Bahrain GP: Ferrari rookie Leclerc claims maiden pole with lap record

Bahrain, Mar 31
Ferrari new boy Charles Leclerc secured his first pole position on Saturday when he set a new track record by topping a dramatic qualifying session for Sunday's Bahrain Grand Prix.
The 21-year-old Formula One rookie became the first Monegasque driver ever to take pole for a world championship race.
Leclerc lapped the Bahrain International Circuit in one minute and 27.866 seconds, beating the mark set by his team-mate and four-time champion Sebastian Vettel last year.
Vettel qualified second to clinch a Ferrari lockout of the front row and was quick to congratulate his new team-mate who shone in only his second race weekend with the team.



"He deserved it," said Vettel. "Yes, come on!" said Leclerc, who is 10 years younger than his team-mate.
"Tomorrow is the race and it's where we score points, but it's a good beginning... It seems like we did a good job so I am extremely happy." Leclerc became the second youngest pole-sitter in F1 history behind Vettel, who qualified threenths behind him.
"In the end, I think Charles did a very good job and he deserved it. I was a bit shy in

the second sector," said Vettel. Five-time world champion Lewis Hamilton was less than a tenth of a second behind Vettel in third ahead of Mercedes team-mate Valtteri Bottas.
"The Ferraris have been incredibly quick here," said Hamilton.
"But that is not all there is to it and we have to sit down and work out a way to try and beat them." Dutchman Max Verstappen of Red Bull came in fifth ahead of Dane Kevin Magnussen of Haas.

Shoot-out woes continue as India lose to Korea in Azlan Shah Cup final

Ipoh, Mar 31
Lower-ranked Korea stunned India 4-2 in the penalty shoot-out to lift the Azlan Shah Cup hockey title after the five-time champions conceded an equaliser in the final quarter to end at 1-1 after regulation time in the summit clash in Ipoh on Saturday. Going into the title clash, world no. 5 India were clear favourites to lift their sixth Azlan Shah title against the 17th ranked Koreans. And the Indians started in the right earnest, taking the lead early through Simranjeet Singh's field strike in the ninth minute. The Koreans produced a resolute defence to keep the Indian forward line under tight vigil, while also pressing hard in search of the equaliser. Korea's efforts finally paid dividend in the 47th minute when they were awarded a



penalty stroke. The Indians went for the video referral but the penalty decision stayed and Jang Jong Hyun made no mistake in drawing parity for his side. Two minutes from the hooter, India earned a penalty corner but to no avail as the match went into shoot-out. In the shoot-out, the Indians missed their first, fourth and fifth attempts and converted just two, while the Koreans just missed their third strike to win the thrilling contest 4-2 and lift the crown for the third time in the history

of the invitational tournament. For India, Mandeep Singh, Sumit Kumar Junior and Sumit missed from the one-on-one penalty shoot-out situation, while experienced Birendra Lakra and Varun Kumar, converted their chances. Defending the goal in the shoot-out for India was young Kishan B Pathak in place of experienced P R Sreejesh.
In the shoot-out, Jii Woo Cheon, Lee Jungjun, Jung Manjae and Lee Namyong scored for Korea.

India Open 2019: PV Sindhu lose to He Bingjiao, crashes out in semis

New Delhi, Mar 31
Former champion Kidambi Srikanth reached title round after a 17-month drought but P V Sindhu bowed out after losing a close semifinal contest at the USD 350,000 India Open here Saturday.
Olympic silver medalist Sindhu, who had won the event in 2017, blew four game points in the opening game to go down fighting 21-23 18-21 to China's He Bingjiao.
The third seed will face two-time champion Ratchanok Intanon of Thailand in the

finals Sunday.
"I think I need to be more patient, I should have taken the first set, it was crucial for me but after losing it, I became a bit nervous. I made crucial mistakes in the second game," Sindhu said.
"I did change strategies. She also got lucky with net cords in the first game. I came back and could have maintained the lead but I couldn't. She played well." Srikanth had entered the finals of Commonwealth Games last year but he failed to reach the summit clash in any BWF

Superseries or BWF World Tour tournament since his French Open win in October, 2017.
The 26-year-old from Guntur on Saturday eked out a 14-21 21-16 21-19 triumph over China's Huang Yuxiang in an engrossing semi-final encounter.
He will face second seed Viktor Axelsen, who beat India's Parupalli Kashyap 21-11 21-17, in the final. "It's been really long since I reached a final. I'm just happy to be here, playing the final again," Srikanth said.

that India has always been a proponent of peace and believed in the philosophy of "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" which treats entire world as one family. He said that India, being a votary of peace and non-violence from time immemorial, always wishes to have cordial relations with all countries and peoples around the world.
Referring to the Honorary Doctorate conferred upon him, the Vice President said the honour was not for an individual but a reflection of the global acknowledgement and recognition of the age-old values of peace and harmony embedded in Indian philosophy.
Observing that he felt doubly honored to have received the Honorary Doctorate at a time when the world is commemorating the 150th birth anniversary of Gandhi ji, who had demonstrated to the world the power of non-violence, he emphasized that peace was the prerequisite for progress of any nation. Any kind of conflict or strife would prevent developmental prospects of the region.
Saying that India has been a victim of the menace of cross-border terrorism, the Vice President said that Terrorism could never be treated with kid gloves. He asked the world community to come together to 'fight out and root out' terror.
Shri Naidu said that the United Nations must conclude at the earliest the deliberations on the Comprehensive Convention on International Terrorism proposed by India and take action against those promoting terror. Ashleigh Barty defeats Karolina Pliskova to capture WTA Miami Open title

Miami, Mar 31
Ashleigh Barty's transformation is complete after the Australian defeated Czech fifth seed Karolina Pliskova 7-6 (7/1) 6-3 Saturday to win the biggest singles title of her career at the WTA Miami Open.
The 22-year-old Aussie quit tennis five years ago after finding the mental grind of the tour too much to bear, turning to professional cricket in a bid to find sporting happiness.
Barty, however, knew she had the tennis skills to compete at the very top and after returning in February 2016, has taken her career to an elite level, culminating in her first-ever WTA Premier Mandatory title to



follow on from the US Open doubles crown she won last September.
Barty, a junior Wimbledon winner at age 15, will rise from 11th to number nine in the world rankings and become the first Australian woman since Sam Stosur in June 2013 to crack the top 10.
"It has been a phenomenal two

weeks both in singles and doubles," said Barty, who lost a women's doubles semi-final alongside Victoria Azarenka. Barty hit 15 aces and 41 winners compared to 22 from an out-of-sorts Pliskova.
"I had to keep it physical, make as many balls as possible and keep my running shoes on," Barty said.

India could soon get a taste of French football

New Delhi, Mar 31
India could soon get a taste of French football with the organisers and title sponsor of Coupe de la Ligue "assessing options" to hold events related to the tournament. This was revealed by Arvind Poddar, chairman and managing director of Indian tyre manufacturing company BKT, which is the title sponsor of Coupe de la Ligue.
"At this moment I can't go into the specifics. All I can say is that the French leagues' governing body (LFP) is looking to bring Coupe de la Ligue to India," Arvind told a group of Indian journalists here. "We are looking at various options and if they come to India, we'll assess," he added.
Arvind said that LFP may also be looking at a tie-up with an Indian league in the near future. "It's not very clear whether they will be tying up



with the Indian Super League (ISL). I know that they have had some meetings when their officials came to India in January.
The agreement between LFP and BKT was reached in September last year. The association is for six years. The Mumbai-based company is also involved with Serie B in Italy and Australia's Big Bash cricket league.
Arvind was hopeful that India would gradually catch up with the rest of the world in international football. "I think there is not much difference

between Indian football and French football. Football has always been very popular here. Football will catch up very fast in India. People in India are also getting crazy about football. It won't be long until India catches up with world sports," Arvind said.
Meanwhile Strasbourg won their first major trophy since 2005 by edging out Guingamp on penalties in Saturday's French League Cup (Coupe de la Ligue) final after a drab goalless draw here. Strasbourg emerged victorious 4-1 in the penalty shootout.
