Involvement of computers, internet, projectors and interactive panels in a systematic blending way also related to blended learning. The



concept of this education is effectively utilized in all areas or any discipline from primary to higher education. With this truism to enhance the teaching and learning process and to attain the requisite learning

outcome of school going children, despite facing many challenges due to the pandemic COVID-19 situation, the Samagra Shiksha UT Mission authority under the Department of Education, A & N Administration has successfully completed

As part of COVID-19 vaccination, general public who are above 45 years of age have been requested to get their names registered for COVID vaccination in COWIN portal i.e. www.selfregistration.cowin.gov.in/Arogyasetu App. The vaccination of persons in the age group of 45 years and above will commence tomorrow (April 1) at New Building of JNRM College, Port Blair, CHC Bambooflat, CHC Diglipur, Dr RP Hospital, Mayabunder,

PHC Billiground, CHC Rangat, PHC Baratang, PHC Hutbay, CHC Nancowry, BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar, PHC Campbell Bay, PHC Katchal and PHC Teressa.

Vaccination will be conducted on all working days excluding Wednesday. No vaccination will be administered on Public Holidays and Sundays. However, beneficiaries have been requested to contact the nearest centre for any change of days and dates especially in the outer

Islands. They have been requested to bring Aadhaar card while coming for vaccination along with a valid mobile number. The second dose will be administered between 6-8 weeks after the first dose. The Andaman and Nicobar Administration is committed to attain 100% vaccination and contain the spread of COVID-19 cases and once again bring back the number of cases down to zero in this UT, a press release from DHS said.

In pursuance of powers vested u/s 51(b) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and in order to enforce strict compliance of the National Directives on COVID-19 and to contain the spread of COVID-19 in South Andaman District, the District Magistrate, South Andaman District, Shri Suneel

Anchipaka has issued various guidelines for effective control of COVID-19, to be effective from April 1, 2021 and shall remain in force upto April 30, 2021.

The coordinated effort of Central and State/UT agencies has resulted in a sustained decline in the number of active COVID-19 cases in the country,

continuously for about 5 months. A fresh surge in COVID-19 cases, in some parts of the country, however, is a cause of concern. At this juncture, the substantial gains achieved against the spread of COVID-19 need to be consolidated, and the chain of transmission of the pandemic effectively broken, with a view to expeditiously restore

complete normalcy.

With the latest guidelines issued by Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) on 27.1.2021, all economic and other activities have been opened up in a phased manner, with the stipulation that the prescribed Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) be scrupulously followed. In order to

The Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs has made it conceivable by providing tap water connection in the remote areas of North and Middle Andamans. Considering the difficulties of inadequate water supplies as well as acute water shortage that exist in North Andaman, Jal Jeevan Mission helps Smti. Parboti Bairagi, a resident under Gram Panchayat Pashimsagar, Diglipur gets an individual tap water connection at her house.

Smti. Parboti articulates that before installation of the tap



water connection under Jal Jeevan Mission, it was quite a difficult situation for her to maintain water supplies at her house all the time. She reiterates that during the day of

routine water supply in her area, she walked half-a-kilometre to a public tap connection at late night hours and during midnight, waiting for her turn in long queues for hours, to receive water supply. She further adds that it took her two long hours and several rounds of her house and the public tap connection to finally get sufficient water supply for her daily household chores.

Despite the physical strains of lifting heavy pots of water accompanied by her husband

Annual fitness test of vehicles; Owners urged to avail services provided at Central Workshop of Transport Department

Port Blair, March 31
The owners of commercial vehicles have been informed that as per Section 56 of M.V.Act 1988, it is mandatory for the transport class of vehicles to undergo fitness test annually/biennially as applicable, failing which the respective commercial vehicles will cease to be validly registered. The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways had relaxed the validity of documents related to Driving Licenses and Registration of vehicles wherever it is not possible to renew these documents. Transport Department had started all activities related to licensing and registration of motor vehicles. Upon resuming the functioning of Motor Vehicle Section, the annual fitness of 15 years old vehicles are being done on every Friday and for rest of the vehicles, the annual fitness test are being done from Monday to Thursday. Now, considering the increase in number of 15 years old vehicles reporting for annual fitness, it has been decided to conduct the fitness test for these vehicles on every Wednesday & Friday at the Central Workshop, Transport Department, Port Blair from 3 pm onwards. The annual fitness of all other Commercial vehicles, RCR of non-commercial vehicles, SLD verification shall be done on Monday, Tuesday & Thursday at the same venue and time. The owners of motor vehicles (Commercial and non-commercial) have been requested to avail the services, a press release from Directorate of Transport said.

ensure that the resumption of activities is successful, it is imperative to strictly enforce the Test-Track-Treat protocol in all parts of the country; ensure that COVID appropriate behaviour is scrupulously observed by everyone; and, the ongoing vaccination drive - the largest in the world - is scaled up rapidly, to cover all the target groups.

Effective enforcement of the Test-Track-Treat protocol

Test:
> With sustained effort, the capacity of total daily tests that can be conducted across the country has gone up substantially. There is need to ensure that the tests being conducted are uniformly distributed across the district, with adequate testing to be done in areas reporting higher number of cases. On best effort basis, to 70% or more. Area where the proportion of RT-PCR tests is less, should rapidly increase testing through this protocol, to reach the prescribed level.

Track
> New positive cases detected, if any, as a result of intensive testing need to be isolated/ quarantined at the earliest; and, their contacts have to be traced at the earliest, and simultaneously isolated/ quarantined. Containment Zones, accordingly may be demarcated and prescribed containment measures implemented within such Zones.

> Effective demarcation of Containment Zones, in vulnerable and high incidence areas, is the key to breaking the chain of transmission and controlling the spread of the virus. Containment Zones should be carefully demarcated at the micro level, taking into consideration the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in this regard. The list of Containment Zones should be notified on the websites.

> Within the demarcated Containment Zones, containment measures, as prescribed by MoHFW, shall be scrupulously followed, as under:
♦ Only essential activities shall be allowed in the Containment Zones.
♦ There shall be strict perimeter control to ensure that there is no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services.
♦ There shall be intensive house-to-house surveillance by surveillance teams formed for the purpose.

♦ Testing shall be carried out as per prescribed protocol.
♦ Listing of contacts shall be carried out in respect of all persons found positive, along with their tracking, identification, quarantine and follow up of contacts for 14 days (80% of contacts to be traced in 72 hours).
♦ Surveillance for ILI/ SARI cases shall be carried out in health facilities or outreach mobile units or through fever clinics in buffer zones.
♦ **The SOPs on the prescribed Containment measures should be strictly followed by the authorities concerned and should ensure accountability of the officers concerned in this regard.**

Treat
> Quick isolation of COVID-19 patients shall be ensured in treatment facilities/ home (subject to fulfilling the home isolation guidelines).
> Clinical interventions, as prescribed, shall be administered. Capacity building of health workers and professionals shall be an ongoing exercise, to be conducted at all levels, with a view to ensure that the prescribed clinical management protocol is understood clearly and administered accordingly.

> The Health Department shall ensure adequate availability of COVID dedicated, health and logistics (including ambulatory) infrastructure, based on their assessment of the case trajectory.
> Effective infection prevention and control practices shall be followed in treatment facilities and by health care workers and professionals.

Strict enforcement of the guidelines:
> For the enforcement of social distancing, the District Administration, as far as possible, shall use the provisions of Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code (Cr. P.C.) of 1973 depending upon the circumstances.
> Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 88 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.

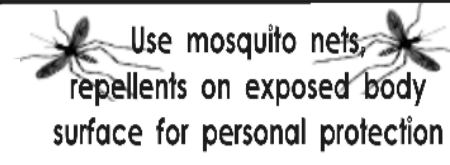

It had built in feature of online verification by DDOs, Medical Department (for medical cases) and H&E Section for further verification. The Application has been launched on 25.03.2021 by the Chief Secretary and an online allotment was made with one click of mouse button of valid applications for change of same type of Govt. Accommodation.

Now, the Housing & Estate Section, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Secretariat **invites Online Applications** for allotment of Government Accommodation under General Pool from Government employees of various Departments under A&N Administration for the **period upto 30.04.2021** for the session 2021-2022. Due to pandemic COVID-19 crisis in these Islands and design & development of new version AAGA software, the online applications for allotment of Government Accommodation could not be invited for the session 2020-2021.

The Government Servants whose name enlisted in the existing seniority list under general category and out of turn on medical ground for the session 2019-2020 and not allotted Government Accommodation till date are requested to apply fresh for the session 2021-2022.

As per Rule-5 of Allotment of Accommodation of Andaman and Nicobar Administrative Residences (General Pool) Rules, 1991, allotment to such regular Government Servants of the Administration will be made on the basis of seniority as determined from the date of their entry into Government Service under the A&N Administration. **Ad-hoc / Contract employees are not eligible for allotment of Government Residential Accommodation under General Pool** and as such their applications will not be entertained.

Applications from the Government Servants who are on fresh appointment / on transfer from out station / on deputation and out of turn allotment on medical ground shall be received throughout the year through online and their placement in the seniority list shall be made accordingly.

- The applicants those desire to apply for change of quarter for similar type should upload copy of quarter allotment order / occupation report alongwith the abovementioned documents in the online portal.
- The applicants those desire to apply for out of turn allotment on medical ground should upload copies of latest medical certificates in the online portal for verification of Medical Board.
- Online registrations of applications are available in the portal <https://aaga.andaman.gov.in> for the period upto **30.04.2021**.
- The applicants should register online application form very carefully as no alternation / modification option is available in the portal. On rejection of application, the applicant should again submit fresh application in the online portal.

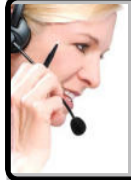
