Foundation stone laying ceremony of IGNOU Regional Centre today

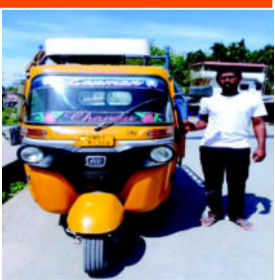

PM SVANidhi has proved to be a much needed respite for street vendors in their most dreadful days. One such beneficiary is Smti M. Laxmi who sells fish at Chakkargaon. Life has been very hard for Laxmi since the death of her husband three years ago due to liver damage. He left behind two young sons and his ageing mother to be taken care of. She is the only earning member in the family and fish vending is the sole business by which she was earning livelihood for her family. The onset of the pandemic had left her family starving for days together as regular income came to a halt and all savings got exhausted, her family was forced to sleep empty stomach every alternate day. Laxmi says that she had lost all hopes for survival. With no help or support coming from anywhere, it was amidst these miserable days that she heard about the PM SVANidhi scheme of Rs. 10,000 working capital loan from the municipal staff and applied (Contd. on last page)

Union Budget sets pace for India to become Aatmanirbhar through stimulus and reforms: FM
New Delhi, Feb. 13
Finance Minister, Smti. Nirmala Sitharaman said that the Union Budget for 2021-22 has set the pace for India to become Aatmanirbhar through reforms and stimulus. She said the Budget will provide necessary impetus to the growth of the economy affected by the COVID-19 situation. Reforms taken up by the Government will lay the path for making India one of the top economies of the world, the Minister added. While replying to the general discussion on the Union Budget in the Lok Sabha today, the Finance Minister said, the Government took the pandemic challenge as an opportunity and took bold steps for long term growth of the economy. Talking about the Budget allocation made for various sectors, she said, one lakh 15 thousand crore rupees have been transferred to more than 10 crore farmers under the PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi scheme. She said, capital expenditure to the defence sector has been increased by 18.8 per cent in comparison to previous allocation. She added that increase in capital expenditure will improve the demand for the core industries and generate the employment. She said, the Government has taken the holistic step for developing health infrastructure by making water and sanitation a key component of the health sector. She said, poor people have benefited from the various initiatives like PM Garib Kalyan Yojana, PM Swanidhi Yojana and PM Awas Yojana. She said, a total of 29.87 crore rupees have been provided under three Atma Nirbhar packages and PM-Garib Kalan Yojana. The government has proposed over 93 thousand 224 crore rupees for the Ministry of Education in the Union Budget 2021-22. Out of the total allocation, over 54 thousand 873 crore rupees have been kept for the Department of School Education and Literacy and nearly 38 thousand 350 crore rupees for the Department of Higher Education. 2nd Test: India 300/6 against England at stumps on opening day

Chennai, Feb. 13
India were 300 for six against England at stumps on the opening day of the second Test match being played at the M.A. Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai. Rishabh Pant was batting on 33 and Axar Patel on five when stumps were drawn. While Rohit Sharma scored a superb innings of 161 runs, Ajinkya Rahane also contributed 67 runs. For England, Moeen Ali and Jack Leach scalped two wickets each while Olly Stone and Joe Root took one each. Moeen Ali today became the first spinner to dismiss India skipper Virat Kohli for a duck in Test Cricket. Moeen Ali bowled a stunning delivery and it turned to rattle the stumps of Virat Kohli for a duck. This is the 11th time that Kohli has been dismissed for a duck in Tests. Earlier, India won the toss and opted to bat first. England lead the four match series 1-0.


