CEO A & N Islands holds meeting with political parties Stresses for ensuring ethical voting, free, fair & transparent election

Port Blair, Mar. 13

The Chief Electoral Officer, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Shri K R Meena, held a meeting with political parties in view of General Election - 2019 in the conference hall of Secretariat here today. He explained to political parties the legal provisions for election expenditure and said that Political parties/Candidates may incur expenditure in election but under the prescribed permissible limit by the Commission. He however advised, that offering money, liquor, kinds etc. should be strictly avoided as these are illegal and punishable under Indian Penal Code (IPC) and The Representation of the People Act, 1951.

The CEO emphasized that the political parties/candidates are required to keep a separate and correct account of election



expenditure under Section 77 (1) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and submit the same to District Election Officer within 30 days from the date of declaration of result. All candidates should keep their expenditure details ready and submit to Returning Officer at least three times before the date of poll. The candidates should keep detail of other expenses they incurred in

meeting, rallies, pamphlets, posters, banners, vehicles etc. and submit the same to the Returning Officer/Expenditure Observer. He informed that non-submission of accounts of election expenses are

subject to action against the Candidates, which may also disqualify them as a Candidate.

The CEO further advised the political parties, to explain their Candidates/Election Agent

clearly about the provision of IPC and The Peoples of Representation Act 1951, Conduct of Election Rules 1961 and the Compendium of Instructions on Election Expenditure Monitoring, of which a copy has been provided to the political parties to avoid any irregularity during maintenance of election expenditure account. He urged all political parties to ensure ethical voting and avoid resorting illegal means to influence voters which is a punishable offence under the law. He also sought greater cooperation from the Political Parties to keep this election free, fair and transparent.

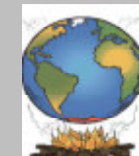
