



Administration focuses on providing better public healthcare facility to Islanders

Construction of 155 bedded District Hospital at Garacharma progressing well; expected to be completed by March 2022

Port Blair, July 13

The A&N Administration is putting forth a persistent effort to provide the Islanders with access to better health care facilities. To meet the growing demand in the health care sector, the Administration has upgraded the present PHC Garacharma to a District Hospital with the objective to provide array of health related services to the citizens.

It is to mention that the construction work of this 155 bedded District Hospital at Garacharma with an estimated cost of Rs. 17.70 Crores is progressing quite well, despite the ongoing pandemic and as on



date, about 55 % work has been completed. Going by the pace of progress of work, the District Hospital is expected to be completed by March 2022. It may be recalled that the Hon'ble Prime Minister laid the foundation stone of Garacharma District Hospital on 31.12.2018.

This Hospital will cater to 1.68 lakh population of South Andaman and reduce burden on GB Pant Hospital for Primary and Secondary health care.

The upcoming District Hospital is a triple storied (Ground +3) building having facilities such as Emergency Operation

Theatre, Accident & Trauma Ward, Critical Care Ward, Antenatal & Postnatal Wards, Labour Room & Ward (as per LaQshya guideline of GOI), Male, Female & Children Wards, Surgical Wards, Laboratory, Blood Bank, Pharmacy, Ultra Sonography facilities, Specialists Services and

AYUSH unit.

Apart from this, a 10 bedded Geriatric Ward with the vision to provide accessible, affordable and high quality, long term, comprehensive and dedicated care services to the elderly population are also in the proposed District Hospital, Garacharma.

At present, no District Hospital is available in South Andaman District since the lone referral District Hospital i.e. G.B. Pant Hospital at Port Blair has been upgraded to Teaching Hospital for Andaman Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Science (ANIIMS). Garacharma

Schools in A&N Islands to remain closed for one month with effect from July 14

Schools of all managements (Govt. Aided/Private/Local Bodies/KV/JNV) across A&N Islands shall remain closed as a precautionary measure for a period of one month with effect from July 14, 2021, an order to this effect issued by Director of Education said.

The order further states that during the period of closure of schools, Head of Institutions shall ensure continuity of teaching and learning activities through alternate platforms such as Google Meet, Local cable TV network, Doordarshan, All India Radio, WhatsApp, Youtube channel "AN Education Dept Andaman" & other teaching apps.

District Administration conducting random tests in rural areas through RAT

112 persons tested at Brichgunj found negative

Port Blair, July 13

The District Administration conducted mobile RAT screening at Brichgunj area today to detect corona cases in rural areas. The test was randomly conducted on 112 persons and it is encouraging to note that all the samples turned out to be negative.

It may be recalled that the District Administration, South Andaman has initiated this facility in rural areas so as to keep check on the spread of the virus. This step has taken the test facility to remotest areas of the District, thereby making testing easier, faster and accessible to every section of the society.



The District Administration has set a target to conduct more than 100 random RAT tests in rural areas on a daily basis, a press release from DC (SA) said.

Shops selling essential & non-essential items to be open from 6 am to 6 pm by observing COVID appropriate behaviour. Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted to open from 6 am to 6 pm

Port Blair, July 13

In order to ensure measures of isolation and social distancing in the South Andaman District with continuous focus on the fivefold strategy for effective management of COVID-19 i.e. Test-Track-Treat-Vaccination and adherence to COVID appropriate behavior to control any surge of the cases of COVID-19 again and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility and taking into consideration the

request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 144 of Cr.P.C., has ordered that lockdown/restricted movement shall continue to be in force in the entire District of South Andaman from July 14 to 20, 2021.

The order further states that shops selling essential and non-essential items shall be allowed to open between 6 am

to 6 pm by observing COVID appropriate behavior. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and shall be held responsible for any violation and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall be liable for action under DM Act. No movement of men and material

without valid movement pass/permit shall be allowed other than the time fixed for opening of shops between 6 am to 6 pm. Movement shall be allowed for emergency cases, medical emergencies, pregnant women and patients availing medical services. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo after 6 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement permit issued by the

Nowadays, it is drawing more attention as value addition has made it reach to its lovers in the



form of pickles. Pickle making & selling has been a means of self employment and many home makers are involved in this business. One such story is of Smt.Laxmi



Prasad working as Community Resource Person (CRP) under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) scheme being implemented by

the Rural Development Department.

Prior to joining DAY-NRLM, Smt. Laxmi Prasad toiled hard as a helper in a shop for the survival of her family. After joining the DAY-NRLM family through formation of Self Help Group (SHG) major turnover came in her life. She obtained livelihood activity based training on pickle making and started business on sale of

Measures to prevent spread of COVID-19 in North and Middle Andaman District

Mayabunder, July 13

In order to put in place measures of isolation and social distancing in North and Middle Andaman District and to prevent any disturbances to the peace and tranquility while simultaneously preventing spread of COVID-19 virus, Dr. Angel Bhati Chauhan, District Magistrate, North & Middle Andaman, in exercise of the powers vested u/s 144 of Cr.P.C has ordered that all

shops and establishments are permitted to open from 6 am to 6 pm. They shall strictly follow norms of social distancing by maintaining a distance of atleast one meter from a person and not allowing more than 3 persons at a time inside the premises. Any overcrowding on violation of social distancing will be responsibility of the shopkeepers and will invite fine of Rs.4000/- for violation of social distancing norms and Rs.

10000/- for overcrowding in shops/establishments, along with sealing of shop for 14 days. No movement of public beyond these timings will be allowed except for: Hospitals, medical labs, medicines and medical equipment, ambulance and hearse vehicle services, medical and its allied activities, all medical emergency cases shall be permitted. Persons engaged for essential activities

for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Goods transport, vehicles carrying agricultural produce of farmers, agriculture & its allied activities shall be permitted.

Media briefed on COVID-19

COVID Appropriate Behaviour & Vaccination are important tools to keep virus at bay: Secretary (Health)

Port Blair, July 13

The Secretary (Health), Shri Ram Niwas Sharma while addressing a COVID-19 media briefing held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that 22,200 doses of COVISHIELD vaccine allotted by Central Government free of cost to A&N Islands for 18-44 beneficiaries have been received. The vaccine doses were also dispatched to North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar Districts today. Mentioning that vaccination is an important tool to keep the virus at bay, he urged the beneficiaries who are due for their second dose to get vaccinated.

Informing about the status of COVID -19 in Isles, he said during the RTPCR test conducted on 150 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one corona positive case has been detected. Today, 2 flights with 350 passengers arrived at Port Blair and their RTPCR reports are awaited. During the test conducted at Ferrargunj on 253 persons bound for Middle & North Andaman, no corona positive case was detected. Similarly, 4 passengers were tested at Helipad and 26 at Mohanpura Bus Stand and all were found negative.

The Secretary informed that presently,

2 corona positive patients are undergoing treatment at G. B Pant Hospital, out of which, one patient is on oxygen support. There are 9 corona active cases in South Andaman District as on 12.07.21 while there are no cases in North & Middle Andaman District as well as Nicobar District, he added. He once again urged the people to follow COVID Appropriate Behavior/protocols for their safety. We should not be complacent and not let our guard down with the decrease in number of COVID cases.

About vaccination, he said 41.23 % population have been vaccinated

with first dose of COVISHIELD till yesterday, out of the total population of 4, 00, 000, 2,29,925 doses of vaccine have been administered in Isles against the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603. He said, the first dose has been given to 1,64, 932 beneficiaries, the percentage of which

homemade pickle with the financial support from her SHG. During the interview with Smt. Laxmi Prasad, CRP under DAY-NRLM of Gram Panchayat Sabari of C.D. Block, Rangat, she said, "All started back in the year 2016 after joining the NRLM Pragati SHG. Being part of NRLM SHG, I got opportunity to have 7 days training on pickle making where me and my group members learned pickle making and its preservation techniques. Later, I availed loan of Rs.50,000/- from my SHG and purchased necessary utensils, spices and oil and made 50 bottles of prawn pickle which was purchased by the local populace of the area. On knowing the popularity of my pickle, I gradually started making and selling my sea food homemade pickles in the local market, tourist places and SHG melas with the help of ANIRLM Coordination and support. Now my "Andaman Special Sea Food Pickles" has a very good demand in the local market and am earning around Rs.5000 to Rs.10000 per month from sale of pickles. I am planning to purchase bottle sealing machine and better packing material for sale of pickles in the other markets of the Islands. I have also applied for FSSAI License through my SHG have got the same for making homemade pickles of prawn and fishes. I have started making pickles of different kinds of fruits and vegetables also. I am planning to take loan from the Village Organization Uday and expand my business. I am really grateful to my NRLM group and their staff for supporting me in times of need."

The Department of Rural Development with the implementation of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) shall keep supporting the poor rural women to strengthen and enable them to overcome the various limitations and establish their own venture as per their caliber, a press release from Secretary (RD) said.

Office of District Magistrate. Travel of persons who intend to proceed to their destinations at mainland after 6 pm shall be allowed on production of valid travel documents. However, the person (one person) who intend to pick/drop after 6 pm, should apply for e-pass well in advance with supporting documents and the same shall be issued by the Office of District Magistrate on case to case basis.

Movement of officers/officials involved in providing essential services such as District Administration, Police, CISF, Health Services, ICMR, PBMC, Electricity, Home Guards, Civil Defence, Fire and emergency services, Defence personnel on duty after 6 pm shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Cards issued by their concerned Departments.

Movement of Officers/Officials, involved in providing services such as Pay & Accounts, Shipping Services, Forest, Banking, Water Supply & Sanitation in Rural Areas, Disaster Management, Port services and related services, Telecommunication shall be allowed after 6 pm on production of movement passes already issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing Broadcasting, all print and electronic media persons after 6 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of personnel involved in Private Security Services, Cable Services, Internet Service Providers, POL Outlets, LPG Stores/Godown, ATMs, e-Commerce activities, Cold Storages, Godowns and Warehouses shall be allowed after 6 pm on production of e-passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/in-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/- and shall also be liable for action under DM Act. All POL outlets shall be opened from 6 am to 6 pm. Movement of private medical personnel such as Doctors, nursing staff, paramedics etc. attached with diagnostic centres and clinics, veterinary clinics shall be allowed after 6 pm on production of e-passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case to case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate.

Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and non-essential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 6 pm only. e-Passes for operation of cargo movement after 6 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Construction activities shall be permitted from 6 am to 6 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 6 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and e-Passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate. Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess to be certified by the firm/organization for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 9 pm on production of e-passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 6 pm only, subject to 50% of the seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/in-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with maximum 90% seating capacity including Autos, Taxis and Jeeps in partial modification to this Office Order No.566 dt.23rd April 2021. Transportation of cargo shall also be permitted. SOPs in this regard issued by the Transport department should be strictly adhered to.

The e-passes issued by the Office of the District Magistrate to individuals for movement after 6 pm involved in various activities/services shall be revalidated on case to case basis.

Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 6 pm. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, C1, B1, B2, B3 and B4 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise), South Andaman should be strictly adhered to.

Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted to open from 6 am to 6 pm subject to strict adherence of COVID Appropriate Behaviours. Any person/organisation violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/- . Last rites/funerals shall be permitted with a maximum of 20 persons with strict adherence to COVID appropriate behaviours.


No tribal passes will be issued for southern group of islands till further orders except for official purposes. All religious places/places of worship are allowed to open between 6 am to 6 pm with only priest and two management staff to perform day to day rituals. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizers will be mandatory. No devotees shall be allowed to enter the religious place. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.10,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up.

e-pass for emergency movement during restricted timings may be submitted online on <https://epass.andaman.gov.in>. The applicants/organizations submitting applications for e-pass should invariably submit valid and clear supporting documents, failing which the application will be summarily rejected.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time, the order to this effect issued by DM (SA) added.

involved in providing essential services such as District Administration, Police, CISF, Health Services, Home Guards, Electricity, Fire and emergency services, Defence personnel on duty shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Cards issued by their concerned Departments.

Movement of bare minimum number of Officers/officials, certified by the Head of Department, involved in providing essential and emergency services such as Pay & Accounts, Shipping Services, Forest, Banking, Disaster Management, Port services and related services, Telecommunication, Courts as per orders of High Court and E-commerce activities shall be permitted on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Persons going for booking of first dose and administration of second dose of COVID vaccine shall be permitted on showing valid booking ID or appointment slips.

Movement of bare minimum personnel involved in providing Broadcasting and Cable services, Internet service providers, all print and electronic media persons, private security services, POL Outlets, LPG Stores/Godown, ATMs, Cold Storages and warehouses shall be allowed for which valid passes shall be issued by the Office of District Magistrate based on the certification from the concerned organisation. All POL outlets shall be opened from 6 am to 6 pm.

Construction activities shall be permitted from 6 am to 6 pm and beyond 6 pm subject to special permission of the District Magistrate. Godowns and allied establishments shall be permitted to operate till 6 pm for non-business purposes and shall not cater to any customers. Only internal operations, receiving/discharging of stocks etc. shall be permitted. Establishments violating this provision shall be liable for fine of Rs.25,000/-.

Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess to be certified by the firm/organisation for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 9 pm. on production of movement pass already issued by the District Magistrate. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 6 pm subject to 50% of the seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the Owner/incharge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the movement pass or using the same for the purposes other than it is meant for, the Owner/incharge will be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.10,000/-, along with sealing of shop/establishment for 14 days and shall also be liable for action under DM Act. Public transport buses shall be allowed to ply with maximum 90% seating capacity including autos/taxis and jeeps. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises (B1, B2, B3 and C category) shall be permitted till 6 pm. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licenced establishments shall be issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise) separately.

Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted to open from 6 am to 6 pm subject to strict adherence to COVID appropriate behaviours. Any person/organization violating the above directions shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.10,000/-.

Last rites/funerals shall be permitted with a maximum of 20 persons with strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open between 6 am to 6 pm with only priest and two management staff to perform day to day rituals. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizers will be mandatory. No devotees shall be allowed to enter the religious place. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.10,000/- payable by the Committee.

Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up. The movement passes issued by the District Administration from 22nd May, 2021 onwards shall remain valid.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s). This order shall come into force with effect from 14th July, 2021 till further orders.

stands at 58.57 of the target population. The second dose has been given to 64,993 beneficiaries constituting 39.41 percent of the targeted beneficiaries, the Secretary said adding that number of second dose beneficiaries is increasing day by day as they are taking the vaccination as per their due date. The number of eligible persons who have been inoculated with first dose in the age group of 45 plus is 1,05,830 which, he said, has almost reached saturation. He said that the number of 18-44 targeted population is 1,75,000 and so far, 59,102 eligible beneficiaries of 18-44 were vaccinated with first dose. The Secretary further said that the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly and till 3 pm today, 1784 beneficiaries were vaccinated in JNRM vaccination centre, out of which, 376 persons were in the age group of 18-44 and remaining were 45 plus.

The Director ANIIMS, Dr. AK Mandal, the Deputy Director, G.B Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De were also present during the press briefing.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 2,38,578 beneficiaries have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 8653 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. A total of 61,890 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

Today, 2639 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 459 were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 5737 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 2309 were in the age group of 18-44 years. In Nicobar District, 277 beneficiaries were vaccinated out of which, 20 were in the age group of 18-44 years.

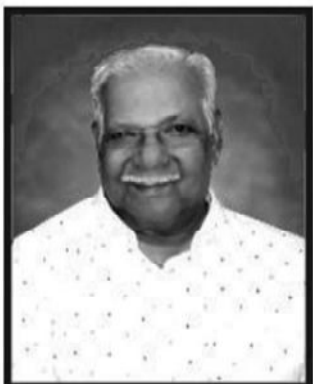

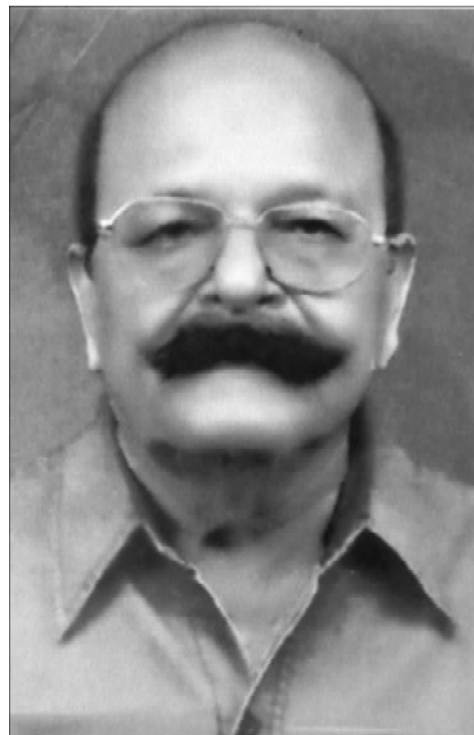
