

75th Independence Day to be celebrated in A&N Islands by complying with COVID-19 protocol

Lt Governor, A&N Islands to hoist the National Flag on August 15 at Netaji Stadium

- Victory Flame commemorating 50 years of victory in 1971 Indo Pak war will be placed on dais at Netaji Stadium
- In view of COVID-19 situation, no public or school children will take part in the ceremony

Port Blair, Aug. 13

Every year on 15th August, the Nation celebrates its Independence Day with grandeur, gaiety, fervour and enthusiasm. This year being the 75th year of our independence, the Day will be celebrated in a manner befitting the occasion, however with some extra precaution and measures in view of the COVID-19 situation. The Govt. of India has issued guidelines for the conduct of the Independence Day celebrations as per the COVID-19 protocols by ensuring social distancing, wearing of masks, proper sanitization, avoiding large gatherings, protecting vulnerable persons etc.

In the A&N Islands, as per the tradition, the National Flag would be hoisted at all Govt. Offices/Institutions including Schools, Dispensaries, Post Offices etc. The National Flag will also be hoisted

at Gram Panchayat level.

The Hon'ble Lt Governor, A&N Islands Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will grace the UT level function at Netaji Stadium, Port Blair and hoist the National Flag at 9.14 am after laying wreath at the 'Martyrs' Column' at the National Memorial Cellular Jail. The parade and guard of honour will comprise of the armed contingents of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard and the A&N Police alongwith their bands. In view of the COVID-19 situation, no public or school children will take part in the ceremony.

In a tribute to the Corona Warriors, the ceremony will also be attended by one representative each of COVID-19 warriors namely Doctors, Health Workers, Sanitary Workers and one COVID-19 cured person.

Further, the Victory Flame to commemorate the 50 years of victory in 1971 Indo Pak war which is being carried throughout the islands shall also be placed on the dais.

The pre-Independence Day-2021 address of the Hon'ble Lt Governor to the residents of A&N Islands will be broadcasted/telecasted on AIR/Doordarshan as per the below mentioned programme.

Autorickshaw drivers cautioned against not switching on fare meters & charging exorbitant fares from commuters

Misbehaviour with passengers shall be viewed seriously; register complaints on Helpline No. 03192-240059/230259

Port Blair, Aug. 13

It has come to the notice of State Transport Authority (STA) that autorickshaw drivers are not switching on the fare meters and charging exorbitant fares from the passengers and even refuses to ply causing inconvenience and difficulty to

commuters, especially senior citizen. In this regard, the STA has stated that Section 74 (2) (viii) & Section 96 (xx) of the MV Act 1988 mandates that in the case of autorickshaw/taxi, a taximeter shall be fitted and maintained in proper working condition. This is a

general condition laid down in the permit.

The STA has revised the autorickshaw fares of A & N Islands vide Notification dated 27.11.2019 and the autorickshaw drivers have been provided with fare charts showing the revised fare corresponding to old

fare. Refusal to ply the autorickshaw without reasonable excuse is an offence as per Section 11 (u) of ANIMV Act & Section 178 (3) of MV Act 1988 and hence, no autorickshaw driver can refuse to ply the vehicle.

antibodies from the mother.

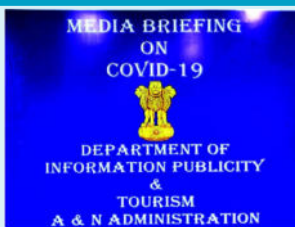
A week long programme was conducted which included pledge by all health workers in all health institutions alongwith Antenatal mothers on the early initiation of

No positive case has been detected from the tests conducted on incoming flight passengers, inter-island bound passengers by ship and road, said the Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. RAT test was conducted on 309 passengers bound for North & Middle



Andaman at Ferrargunj and here too, no positive case was found. Similarly, RAT was conducted on 80 passengers coming from Swaraj Dweep to Port Blair and all were found negative. All test conducted on 78 passengers proceeding to Swaraj Dweep also turned out to be negative. 83 passengers proceeding to Shaheed Dweep by MV Choudhari were tested and all of

Interacting with participants at various iconic locations across the country, the Sports Minister said that as India celebrates 75 years of Independence, the Fit India Freedom Run 2.0

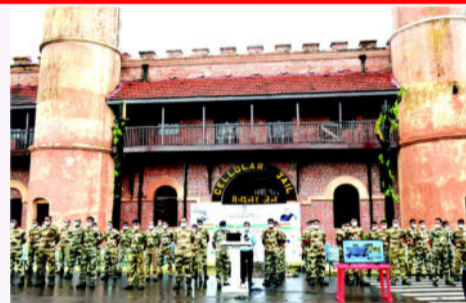

have once again been directed to display the fare chart issued by the STA in their autorickshaw and should charge the fare strictly as per the fare meter. Exorbitant or overcharging of auto fares, refusal to ply as per the request of the passenger and misbehaviour with passengers shall be viewed seriously.

Enforcement drives would be conducted and actions would be initiated against those autorickshaw owners found not exhibiting the fare chart or driving with defective/ faulty & non calibrated & unstamped fare meters.

Meanwhile, the general public have been advised to send their complaints regarding refusal to ply autorickshaw, refusal to put on the faremeter before commencement of the trip and excessive charging etc. to the Secretary (STA), Directorate of Transport, Port Blair mentioning the registration number of the autorickshaw with details of complaint or register their complaints in Helpline No. 03192-240059/230259, Traffic Section 243182 for taking suitable penal action against the violators, a press release from Secretary (STA) said.

Similarly, 1810 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which 1618 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44.62 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which 32 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. institutional credit, social security and skills to the urban street vendors for accessing emerging market opportunities.

Smti Nallahmal is one such satisfied beneficiary of Self Employment Loan who runs a small ration/ FMCG store at Nariyal Bagecha, Mazar Pahad for past few years. She supports a family of five with four daughters and a husband who runs a petty tea shop at South Point. With no steady income from her small ration shop and with no other alternative source of earning, life has been very difficult for Nallahmal bearing the responsibility of bringing up her four daughters along with the challenge of providing them with good education and making them self-reliant to face the world. She says that it has

always been her dream of expanding the business so that she can provide a better livelihood for her family but funds have been a major hindrance. Adding to her misery, was the onset of pandemic for Nallahmal when her only source of livelihood was shut down. She says that the family struggled hard to make ends meet when all her savings got exhausted and they were forced to survive on borrowings from friends and family.

A ray of hope finally emerged for Nallahmal in the form of Self Employment Loan under DAY-NULM which she had applied for through the Municipal Office Facilitation Centre. She received an individual loan of Rs 1,85,000/- in her Canara bank account accompanied

with the interest subvention of additional 3% for females under Self Employment Scheme of DAY-NULM. This loan came in the form of blessing for Nallahmal in her most distressed times which not only helped her to regain and expand her ration shop.

Nallahmal says that with the loan amount, she first renovated her shop thus attracting more customers and thereby paving the way for a better livelihood for her family. She is now a satisfied beneficiary of Self Employment Loan under DAY-NULM and expressed her gratitude to Administration and PBMC for effective implementation of the scheme and for all the assistance given on time, a press release from Secretary, PBMC said.
