New Delhi, Mar 14
 The Lok Sabha today gave its seal of approval to the Union Budget 2018-19 with the passage of the Finance Bill, 2018 and Appropriation Bills by a voice vote.

SBI slashes minimum balance charges by up to 75%

New Delhi, Mar 14
 State Bank of India, SBI has cut down the charges for non-maintenance of average minimum balance in its savings accounts by up to 75 per cent. The new charges, which will benefit about 25 crore bank customers, comes into effect from 1st of next month. The bank said in a release that customers in metro and urban centres will now have to pay Rs 15 per month plus GST. Earlier the charges were Rs 50 per month plus GST. For semi-urban centres, the charges have been reduced from Rs 40 to Rs 12 per month plus GST.

Intensity of depression in Arabian Sea reduces

The Port Blair Municipal Council has asked the Real Estate Developer to ensure that the building plans are approved by the PBMC and a completion certificate is obtained by them. Similarly, the flat purchasers have also been advised to remain cautious while buying flats.

The advisory has been released in view of the fact that some Real Estate Developers have constructed Apartment Complexes in gross violation of Building Bye-Laws ignoring stay orders and demolitions orders issued by the Port Blair Municipal Council. Further some of the flats in the un-authorisedly constructed complexes have been stated to be already sold. Port Blair being in seismic zone-5 such un-authorized constructions may lead to serious public safety issues. In a press release received here today, the Secretary, PBMC, Shri Yashpal Garg has said that the violations of Building- Bye Laws are not only ruining the City but have also become safety hazards for the life of construction workers and general public. The un-authorized constructions by Real Estate Developers are clear examples of playing with the life of people for the sheer greed of earning extra money. (Contd. on last page)

Ace striker Rani Rampal will captain an 18-strong Indian women's team, while experienced goalkeeper Savita will shoulder the duties of vice-captain at next month's Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, Hockey India said today. The Indian team has been grouped in Pool A along with Malaysia, Wales, England and South Africa at the multi-sport event scheduled to begin on April 4. India will begin their campaign on April 5 against Wales. 27-year-old Savita, who is making a return to the team after having been rested for the recently concluded tour of South Korea, will be accompanied by Rajani Etimaru in goal. The defence unit is packed with experience and grit as Deepika, Sunita Lakra, Deep Grace Ekka, Gurjit Kaur and Sushila Chanu Pukhrambam will look to keep



out the opposition's attacks. Monika, Namita Toppo, Nikki Pradhan, Neha Goyal and Lilima Minz will form the midfield while Rani, Vandana Katariya, Lalremsiami, Navjot Kaur, Navneet Kaur and Poonam Rani, who returned to the squad during South Korea tour, will form India's attack. The Indian team is currently ranked No. 10 in the world and will face stiff competition from higher ranked teams such as World No. 2 England, World No. 4 New Zealand and World

World Para Athletics Grand Prix: Deepa Malik seals Asian top spot in discus throw

New Delhi, Mar 14

Inspirational Indian para-athlete Deepa Malik has sealed the top spot in the discus Asia Ranking 53 category and second place in the Asian Games combined category event 51/52/53 with a career-best throw of 8.01 meters on day two of the World Para Athletics Grand Prix 2018 in Dubai. With this superb effort, Deepa has qualified for the 2018 Asian Para Games to be held in Jakarta, Indonesia from October 8-16. Deepa, famously, won silver in the shot put F-53 event at the 2016 Rio Paralympics with a best throw of 4.61m sealing her prize. Being confined to a wheelchair has clearly not been a deterrent for Deepa, one of the country's most decorated athletes. A cursory glance at her achievements underscores that truisms: the 47-year-old is an



accomplished swimmer, adventure sports junkie, biker and entrepreneur and has had her name entered into the Limca Book of Record not once, but four times, and in 2016 became the first Indian woman to win a medal at the Paralympics. Suffering a spinal tumour in 1999, which required three surgeries and 183 stitches between her shoulder blades and left her paralysed from

the waist down, did not stop Deepa from chasing and achieving her dreams. A recipient of the Arjuna Award in 2012 for her achievements as a swimmer, she has swum across the Yamuna River against the current, covered a distance of over 3,000kms from Chennai to Delhi on a customised motorbike and scaled nine high altitude motorable passes in Ladakh in nine days.

Recently a case of un-authorized constructions by a Real Estate Developer has come into notice where more than two dozen residential flats have been constructed in violation of Building Bye-Laws. The Developer continued with the un-authorized constructions despite stay order and demolition orders issued by the PBMC. Some of the residential flats have been stated to be sold prior to getting completion certificate from the PBMC and completing required formalities under Real Estate Regulation Act (RERA) etc.

The Supreme Court in the case Friends Colony Development Committee Vs. State of Orissa has observed that builders violate with impunity the sanctioned building plans and indulge in deviations much to the prejudice of the planned development of the city and at the peril of the occupants of the premises constructed or of the inhabitants of the city at large. Serious threat is posed to ecology and environment and, at the same time, the infrastructure consisting of water supply, sewerage and traffic movement facilities suffers unbearable burden and is often thrown out of gear. Unwary purchasers in search of roof over their heads and purchasing flats/apartments from builders find themselves having fallen prey and become victims to the designs of unscrupulous builders. The builder conveniently walks away having pocketed the money leaving behind the unfortunate occupants to face the music in the event of un-authorized constructions being detected or exposed and threatened with demolition.

Accordingly, all concerned have been advised to ensure that the building plans are approved by the PBMC and a completion certificate is obtained by the Real Estate Developer. Flat purchasers may also protect their interests by confirming about applicability of provisions of Real Estate Regulation Act (RERA) and its compliance by the Developer. Here it is also clarified that mere providing water connection does not mean that the building has been constructed without any violation of Building Bye-Laws. The action against un-authorized constructions will continue despite sale of flats and the un-authorized constructions are liable to be demolished, by following due process of law, the release added.

ICC Test rankings: Kagiso Rabada top-ranked bowler, Ravichandran Ashwin gains two places

Dubai, Mar 14

The International Cricket Council (ICC) has released the latest Test Player rankings. South Africa's Kagiso Rabada regained his top spot among bowlers crossing the coveted 900-point mark in ratings. Rabada is the 23rd bowler to cross 900 points and only the fourth South African player to do so after Vernon Philander, Shaun Pollock and Dale Steyn. Indian off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin climbed up two steps after Josh Hazlewood and Mitchell Starc slipped in rankings following Australia's defeat.

Ashwin is now placed fourth in the Rankings. The other Indian bowler Ravindra Jadeja remains static at third place. In the batsmen's list, there has been no change with Australian skipper Steve Smith perched at the top while Indian captain Virat Kohli in the second position. Cheteshwar Pujara maintains his sixth place in the rankings. India ensured the number one spot on the Test



Team Rankings and a prize of ten lakh dollar after their victory in the Johannesburg Test against South Africa in January this year. This means that no team can move ahead of them in the Test rankings at the 3rd April cut-off date.

Yuki Bhambri's stupendous run at the Indian Wells Masters came to an end following his defeat to American world number 21 Sam Querrey in the third round. The Indian qualifier, ranked 110, pushed his opponent before bowing out with a 7-6(4) 4-6 4-6 loss, which came after

an intense battle lasting two hours and 20 minutes. The 25-year-old Indian saved 11 of the 15 breakpoints in the gruelling match. have high level of endemism in both flora and fauna which calls for sincere preservation; adding that mainstreaming all these concerns in every Department is the need of the hour.

The Chief Secretary stressed on the need for imparting knowledge on Isles' rich biodiversity and its preservation at the school level and called upon the Departments of Tourism, Agriculture, Environment & Forest and CIARI to ensure that proper steps are taken in safeguarding the biodiversity hotspot of these Islands besides ensuring promotion of responsible eco friendly tourism in Isles. He also stressed on the need for sensitizing tourists, both local and foreign, about the endemic species of Isles which can be an added attraction. He stated that a programme of this kind should go a long way in creating a new paradigm in promotion of Isles Tourism and the trainees must utilize their acquired skills and find employment in different areas of Tourism.

The Chief Secretary also informed that the A&N Administration has allotted land for the construction of a museum which will showcase the rich marine life of the Islands especially the corals; and urged ZSI to take it up in the right earnest on a fast track mode. The chief guest also congratulated the trainees and the resource persons and the allied Departments for the successful conduct of the training programme.

The chief guest and other dignitaries also felicitated the trainees of GSDP and the resource persons from various Departments with certificates.

Delivering the felicitation address, DIG, ICG, V. N. Pillai remarked that the Indian Coast Guard is responsible for the protection of marine biodiversity of the country and it works in close association with ZSI in preserving the rich biodiversity of these Islands. This training programme will go a long way in enabling the trainees (taxonomy & para taxonomy) to play a significant role in safeguarding the environment, he added and assured the support of the Coast Guard in the conservation and protection of the flora and fauna of Isles.

In his address, Dr. Lal Ji Singh stated that resolving the biodiversity issue is a challenge in today's world and the taxonomy and para taxonomy can play a vital role in bio-conservation of the environment. He remarked that the GSDP offers a window of opportunities to young people to hone their taxonomy skill besides exploring avenues for earning their livelihood.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Francis stated that the A&N Islands are a rich biodiversity hot spot and since the last 150 years, the habitats of the endemic species of these Islands have decline alarmingly as they are being disturbed by invasive species as well as human activities which have led to disastrous consequences. He also stressed on the need for identifying such species and to carry out extensive studies on them, so as to protect the flora and fauna of these Islands.

In his welcome address, the Officer-in-Charge, ZSI, Dr. C. Sivaperuman highlighted about the various activities conducted for the trainees as part of the Green Skill Training Programme. He remarked that India faces shortage of skilled workers and hence the need for giving more thrust on skill training programmes is vital. The programme concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Scientist D- ZSI, Dr. Anil Kumar Dubey.

His life story was the subject of the 2014 film 'The Theory of Everything', starring Eddie Redmayne.

India ace Saina Nehwal crashed out of the All England Open Badminton Championships after losing to world number one and defending champion Chinese Taipei's Tzu Ying Tai in the first round. Fourth seed Nehwal was no match for her opponent and lost in straight sets 21-14 and 21-18.

Tzu Ying Tai was

overwhelming favourites heading into the match and she lived up to her billing, dismissing the Indian player without much fuss. She also improved her head-to-head record against Nehwal, winning 10 games against losing five. It was her eighth straight win against the Indian star. Nehwal's best effort in the history of the tournament came in 2015 when he lost to Carolina Marin in the final.
