



Self-reliance and jointness must for strategic autonomy & future-ready force: Hon'ble Raksha Mantri

New Delhi, May 14 (PIB) "A nation's strength will increasingly depend on how quickly its defence forces, laboratories, and industries think & act as one," said Hon'ble Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh as he underscored the importance of self-reliance and jointness to secure strategic autonomy & remain future-ready for emerging security challenges. He was addressing policy makers, military leadership, defence industry stakeholders, diplomats, innovators, start-ups, academia & strategic experts through a video message during Kalam & Kavach 3.0, a defence strategic dialogue organised at Manekshaw Centre, New Delhi on May 14, 2026.

Hon'ble Raksha Mantri emphasised that the battlefield of tomorrow will reward those who can shorten the time between

an idea, a prototype, and operational deployment. He added that national security cannot rest on old assumptions in the current geopolitical tensions, ongoing conflicts, cyber threats, supply-chain vulnerabilities, and new forms of hybrid warfare. "National security demands our preparedness, resilience, innovation, and strategic confidence," he said.

Shri Rajnath Singh described self-reliance as

not only an economic goal, but also a strategic necessity, asserting that a nation that depends excessively on others for critical defence capability remains vulnerable in times of crisis. "We must design, develop, produce, maintain, and upgrade key systems within our own national ecosystem. That is how we will be able to secure our strategic autonomy," he said.

Underlining the need to achieve jointness, Hon'ble

Raksha Mantri stated that modern warfare does not respect silos, and success will depend on how efficiently "we bring together our defence forces across land, sea, air, cyber, and space." It will also depend on how closely laboratories, industries, start-ups, policymakers, and military institutions work together, he said.

Overall pass percentage of A&N Islands in CBSE Class XII exam stands at 81.08%; 10 schools secured 100% results

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 14 The results of the All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISCE) Class XII 2025-26 were announced on 13.05.2026. As per the results downloaded from the CBSE website, out of 4948 students who appeared for the Class XII examination from all Management Schools in the A&N Islands, 4012 students have passed, while 524 students have been placed in the compartment category. The overall pass percentage of the A&N Islands stands at 81.08%. However, 10 schools secured 100% results.

ABIP- SSS scheme implemented by Deptt. of AH&VS emerging as a game changer for dairy farmers

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 14 The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services (AH&VS), is actively implementing the Accelerated Breed Improvement Programme - Sex Sorted Semen (ABIP-SSS) scheme across the Islands, which is proving to be a game changer for dairy farmers.

Sex Sorted Semen technology, promoted by the Government of India, enables a significantly higher probability of female calf births through Artificial Insemination. This advanced reproductive technology is helping farmers rapidly expand their dairy herds and increase milk production while reducing the cost of rearing unwanted male calves.

Under the Accelerated Breed Improvement Programme - Sex Sorted Semen scheme in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a total of 51 calves have been born so far, out of which 30 are female calves. The encouraging results



clearly demonstrate the effectiveness of this technology. At present, Sex Sorted Semen doses of improved Jersey Crossbred and Sahiwal germplasm are being made available to farmers through all Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries at a highly subsidized rate of only Rs. 250 per dose.

To ensure complete satisfaction of the farmers, the scheme also includes a refund policy in case of failure of Artificial Insemination. During the year 2025-26, as many as 26 farmers whose animals could not conceive were provided refund as per the scheme guidelines. This reflects the strong commitment of the Administration towards transparency and farmer welfare.

The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services has appealed to all livestock farmers across the Islands to come forward and actively adopt the Accelerated Breed Improvement Programme - Sex Sorted Semen scheme for the overall development of the livestock sector. Farmers interested in availing this service may contact their nearest Veterinary Hospital or Dispensary, a press release from Deptt. of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services said.

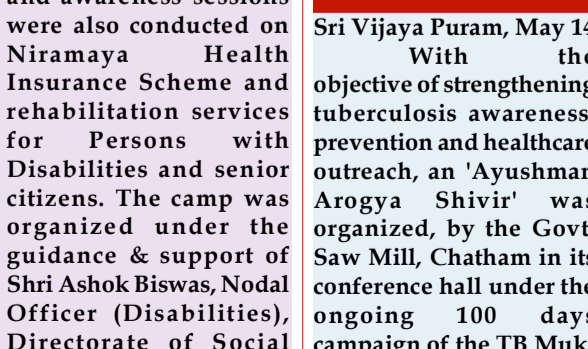

Humfrygunj Police cracks blind hit-and-run case

In a remarkable display of relentless investigation, sharp technical analysis and coordinated field work, the team of Police Station Humfrygunj cracked a blind hit-and-run case within 36 hours of the incident, leading to the identification and apprehension of the offending driver and seizure of the involved vehicle.

On 11/05/2026, an information was received from Primary

Health Center, Garacharma regarding a road accident at Sippighat near Kalapathar area. Upon this, an FIR was registered and a police team comprising SI Gaurav Banerjee, Station House Officer Police Station Humfrygunj, was constituted to trace the offender.

The police team with coordinated teamwork, rushed to the location, recovered the offending vehicle and identified the driver as Raj Kishan S/o Late Prem Kishan, 24 yrs, a private driver and resident of Pathargudda. He was apprehended and the vehicle was seized after observing all codal formalities.

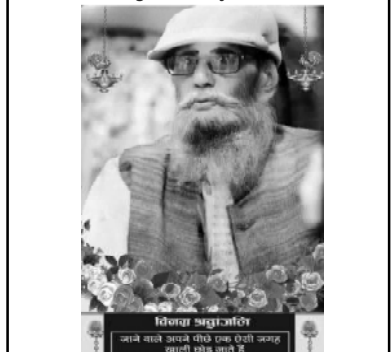

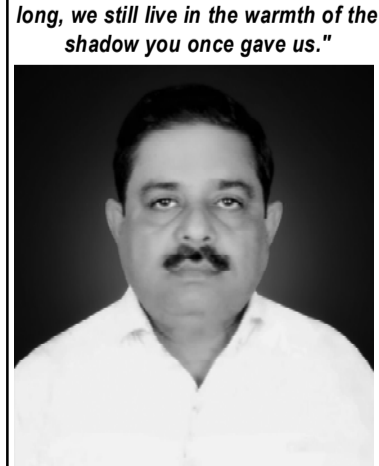
