Ministry of Ayush creates New Guinness World Record for Largest Viewership of a YouTube Live Yoga Stream

Global Online Yoga Event draws 435,831 verified viewers ahead of International Day of Yoga 2026

New Delhi, June 14 (PIB)

In a landmark achievement ahead of the International Day of Yoga (IDY) 2026, the Ministry of Ayush today created a new Guinness World Record for the Most Viewers for a YouTube Live Yoga Stream, with 4,35,831 viewers joining a special global online Yoga session streamed live through the official Ministry of Ayush YouTube channel.

The record attempt was organized as part of the Ministry's outreach activities for IDY 2026 and witnessed enthusiastic participation from Yoga practitioners, students, institutions, professionals, and wellness enthusiasts across India and around the world. The event featured the Common Yoga Protocol (CYP) and reinforced the Ministry's vision of promoting Yoga as a daily practice through the Yoga 365 movement.



The Ministry of Ayush recorded 4,35,831 verified viewers, surpassing the previous Guinness World Record of 2,46,252 viewers set in 2024. The new record exceeded the previous benchmark by 1,89,579 viewers, establishing a new global record for the largest viewership of a YouTube live Yoga stream.

Addressing participants, Shri Prataprao Jadhav, Union Minister of State (IC) for Ayush and Minister of State for

Health & Family Welfare, while congratulating the citizens across the world for contributing to the historic achievement said, "Today's achievement demonstrates the extraordinary power of Yoga to connect people across regions, cultures, and nations through a shared commitment to health and well-being. This new Guinness World Record reflects the growing global acceptance of Yoga as a way of life and reinforces our collective

resolve to make Yoga an integral part of daily living. As we move towards International Day of Yoga 2026, I urge everyone to embrace the spirit of 'Yoga 365' and contribute towards building a healthier, stronger, and more resilient society."

The event was organized by the Ministry of Ayush in collaboration with the Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga (MDNIY) and other partner organizations. Participants from across

Great Nicobar project designed with tsunami, earthquake safeguards: Centre

Mumbai, June 14 (UNI)

The Centre has acknowledged that the Andaman and Nicobar Islands fall in India's highest seismic risk zone but said comprehensive mitigation and disaster-management measures have been incorporated into the proposed Great Nicobar Integrated Development Project.

The assurance came in response to a representation. Responding to the concerns, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) said issues

relating to seismicity, tsunami vulnerability and disaster preparedness had been examined during the environmental appraisal process.

The ministry stated that the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) included detailed disaster-risk assessments, emergency response plans and mitigation measures covering earthquakes and tsunamis.

According to the ministry, all infrastructure under the project will be designed

in accordance with earthquake-resistant standards prescribed by the Bureau of Indian Standards and the National Building Code.

The ministry added that the project falls under the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Disaster Management Plan, 2016, and would benefit from existing tsunami early-warning systems, evacuation protocols and co-ordinated emergency-response mechanisms involving civil and military authorities.

Among the

safeguards cited were tsunami shelters, emergency-response infrastructure and disaster-relief support systems.

The MoEFCC further said the project had been examined by the Expert Appraisal Committee and reviewed by expert and judicial bodies, including the National Green Tribunal, and is being implemented subject to statutory environmental conditions and safeguards. (Source: <https://www.uniindia.com/>)

Healthcare Facilities urged to ensure strict adherence to Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 14

It is brought to the knowledge of all concerned that, under the provisions of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, every biomedical waste generator is required to obtain authorization for the generation, handling, treatment, processing and disposal of biomedical waste. Further, under the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, all such facilities are mandated to obtain

Consent to Establish (CTE), Consent to Operate (CTO) and renewal thereof, from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC). However, it has been observed that several Healthcare Facilities (HCFs) operating in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands are required to strengthen compliance



with the above statutory provisions.

Therefore, all Healthcare Facilities both Government and Private are hereby urged to ensure strict adherence to the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 (as amended), particularly with respect to the following:

1. All HCFs shall obtain valid Consent to Establish (CTE)/ Consent to Operate (CTO) under the Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981, along with authorization under BMW Rules, 2016 from the Andaman & Nicobar Pollution

Control Committee (ANPCC) through the OCMMS portal (<https://anocmms.nic.in>).



2. As per the revised classification issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), industries are categorized into Red, Orange, Green, and White categories based on their pollution potential. Healthcare

Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar; Last date for nomination is July 31

The Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar (PMRBP) is a prestigious national award conferred by the Government of India to recognize exceptional achievements of children in various fields. This award has been started with the aim of honouring talented children. The award is given under six categories: Bravery,

Social Service, Environment, Sports, Art & Culture, and Science & Technology. Children below the age of 18 years (as of 31st July, 2026) who have demonstrated excellence and outstanding contributions in these fields are eligible to be nominated.

In this regard, the nominations/recommendations for

PMRBP will be received only online through the Rashtriya Puraskar Portal (<https://awards.gov.in>) designed for this purpose. The Pradhan Mantri Rashtriya Bal Puraskar is given by the Hon'ble President of India in Darbar Hall, Rashtrapati Bhavan one week preceding Republic Day every year. The Awardees of Bal Shakti Puraskar also take part

in the parade of Republic Day on 26th of January at Rajpath, New Delhi.

The portal for online nominations for PMRBP is now open and last date for nomination is 31st July, 2026. Application forms submitted through any other mode will not be considered for the award, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee holds Training on Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 14

The Department of Science and Technology, Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC) conducted a hybrid online training programme yesterday for officials of the Department of Rural Development & Panchayats and Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council. About 55 officials attended. The session aimed to support effective implementation of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, and to provide guidance on identification, mapping, geo tagging and registration of Bulk Waste Generators (BWGs) on the CPCB portal.



Management (SWM) Rules, 2026. As per Rule 6(a), every Bulk Waste Generator (BWG) must register with the concerned local body through a centralized portal. The definition of a BWG, as outlined in Rule 3(i), includes entities with a floor area of 20,000 square meters or more, or those with a water consumption of 40,000 litres per day, or generating over 100 kg of waste per day. An entity qualifies as a BWG if it meets any one of these thresholds.

Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) are mandated to identify BWGs through detailed surveys, geo-tag these identified generators, and update the portal annually by April 1. Local bodies are also required to map BWGs, including hotels, roadside eateries, commercial establishments, and institutional premises that generate organic and bulk waste.

The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has developed a registration module to assist BWGs while the

fully operational centralized portal is under development. All Bulk Waste Generators (BWGs) have been directed to register on the Central Pollution Control Board's centralized Solid Waste Management portal (<https://swm.cpcb.gov.in>). BWGs must create a login ID and submit the requisite details for registration through the portal at the earliest to ensure compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, a press release from ANPCC said.

SVPMC conducts anti-encroachment drive near Air Force Station, Prothrapur

The Revenue Section of the Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council (SVPMC) yesterday conducted a comprehensive Anti-Encroachment drive in the vicinity of the Air Force Station, Prothrapur.

As part of the council's ongoing efforts to ensure public safety, streamline traffic flow, and maintain the security integrity of the defense zone, all



unauthorized street vendors operating near the Prothrapur Air Force Station area were completely removed. The seized materials, structures, and articles

from the unauthorized vending sites have been confiscated and transported to the SVPMC Yard located at Brookshabad for safe disposal and dumping.

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council has once again appealed all street vendors and commercial establishments to refrain from encroaching upon public roads, footpaths, and highly sensitive defense zones. PM-KISAN beneficiaries urged to complete annual biometric e-KYC by June 30

Sri Vijaya Puram, June 14
The Department of Agriculture has urged that all beneficiaries under the Central Sector Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) must complete their Annual Biometric e-KYC for the financial year 2026-27 to continue receiving benefits. The Government of India has mandated the completion of Annual e-KYC for all PM-KISAN beneficiaries. The beneficiaries who have already completed e-

KYC earlier are also required to complete the annual e-KYC process afresh for 2026-27. Under PM-KISAN, eligible farmer families receive financial assistance of Rs. 6,000 per year, disbursed in three equal installments of Rs. 2,000 every four months. Till date, the Government of India has successfully released 22 installments to farmers across the country. The deadline for completion of e-KYC

process is June 30, 2026, failing which beneficiaries may not receive the forthcoming installment for the period from April-July 2026. Farmers can complete the process at their nearest Common Service Centres (CSCs) or Agriculture Office. For any assistance, beneficiaries are advised to contact the respective offices promptly, a press release from Department of Agriculture said.

Facilities (HCFs) falling under the Red category are required to have adequate wastewater management systems and scientific waste disposal mechanisms. HCFs with 501 to more than 1000 beds are classified under the Red category, those with 201 to 500 beds under the Orange category, and HCFs with up to 200 beds under the Green category. Further, all HCFs having more than 10 beds required to install appropriate Effluent Treatment Plants (ETPs) for treatment of effluents prior to discharge. 3. HCFs having captive incineration facilities shall have installation of Online Continuous Emission Monitoring Systems (OCEMS) with real-time data transmission to CPCB servers. The HCFs in isolated/far flung areas can practice deep burial method for biomedical waste management (Yellow category), however shall be duly authorized and designed in accordance with standards prescribed under Schedule II of BMW Rules, 2016. 4. HCFs (bedded) not connected to sewerage systems or without terminal treatment facilities shall comply with standards specified under Schedule II of BMW Rules, 2016.

HCFs connected to public sewers with terminal treatment facilities shall comply with general discharge standards notified under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. HCFs with less than 10 beds shall comply with discharge standards under Schedule II (S. No. 8). Non-bedded occupiers shall treat infectious liquid waste through disinfection prior to disposal, as per prescribed guidelines. For more information, follow the guidelines.

In view of the provisions, all the Healthcare Facilities in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands are hereby advised to ensure strict compliance with the above provisions, a press release received from Member Secretary, A&N Pollution Control Committee said.
