District Administration (SA) conducts Camp Court for disposal of long-pending land diversion cases

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 14

The District Administration, South Andaman has undertaken a focused initiative to expedite the disposal of long-pending land diversion cases pertaining to Sri Vijaya Puram Tehsil, with the objective of improving service delivery and reducing pendency.

In this regard, Revenue Camp Courts were conducted on July 11 at the Office of the Assistant Commissioner, Swaraj Dweep, and on July 13 at the Patwari Office, Shaheed Dweep, under the chairmanship of Shri Kamalshwar Rao S, IAS, Assistant Commissioner, South Andaman. The Camp Court was organized to facilitate the expeditious disposal of pending land diversion



cases at the field level, thereby ensuring timely, transparent, and accessible redressal of public grievances.

A large number of applicants attended the Camp Courts. During the proceedings, 65 land diversion cases at Swaraj Dweep and 14 land diversion cases at Shaheed Dweep, pending up to June 2026, were heard and disposed of in accordance with the provisions of the relevant rules and

regulations. The Assistant Commissioner, South Andaman also reviewed the ongoing progress of Modernized Sea Port Terminal at Swaraj Dweep.

Further, on July 12, a total of 18 Unnatural Death (UD) cases were also disposed of during a special Camp Court held at Police Station, Swaraj Dweep.

District Administration (N&MA) conducts Anti-Encroachment Drive at Radhanagar Village, Diglipur

Diglipur, July 14

The District Administration, North & Middle Andaman continued its anti-encroachment drive on Government land by carrying out an encroachment eviction operation at Radhanagar Village under Diglipur Tehsil.

During the operation, encroachments in the form of temporary sheds, arecanut plantations and banana plantations were removed from six different locations and an area of 1.5 hectares of revenue land was restored into the Government Revenue Records.

The District



Administration has reiterated its commitment to protecting Government land from unauthorized occupation and has warned that strict action will continue to be taken against all encroachments in accordance with the

provisions of the law. The public has also been urged to refrain from encroaching upon Government land and to cooperate with the Administration in safeguarding public property, a press release from DC, N&MA said.

STOP Diarrhoea Campaign to be observed by DHS from July 15 to Aug. 31

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 14

The STOP Diarrhoea Campaign 2026 will be observed by Directorate of Health Services from 15th July 2026 to 31st August 2026 with the objective of reducing deaths due to diarrhoea among children under five years of age. The campaign focuses on prevention, early identification, and effective management of diarrhoeal diseases through community participation, strengthened healthcare services, and inter-sectoral collaboration. The campaign's slogan for 2026, 'Diarrhoea ki Roktham, Safai aur ORS se Rakhen Apna Dhyaan,' emphasizes the importance of prevention, hygiene, sanitation, and timely treatment with ORS and Zinc to protect children from diarrhoea.



During the campaign, intensive Information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities will be carried out through various platforms to raise awareness among parents, caregivers, schools, and communities. Special emphasis will be given to promoting exclusive breastfeeding, safe drinking water, handwashing with soap, proper sanitation, and appropriate infant and young child feeding practices. The campaign activities include strengthening diarrhoea case management services at all health facilities, establishing ORS-Zinc Corners, ensuring adequate availability of ORS and Zinc at healthcare institutions, and pre-positioning ORS packets and Zinc tablets by ASHAs in households with children under five years of age. arrangement under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Mission Vatsalya, where a child below 18 years in need of care and protection is placed with a fit and willing foster family for a temporary or long-term period, as determined by the Child Welfare Committee (CWC). Foster Care ensures that every child grows up in a safe, nurturing and family-like environment while protecting the child's rights and best

Joint Search & Rescue Operation conducted by ANC saves two fishermen adrift at Sea

Demonstrating their unwavering commitment to safeguarding lives at sea, Indian Navy and Indian Coast Guard assets deployed under the Andaman Nicobar Command successfully rescued two fishermen from a distressed Andaman Nicobar registered fishing boat after they remained stranded and adrift in rough seas for nearly three days following an engine

failure.

The rescued fishermen have been identified as Shri Amarendra Halder (34) and Shri Parimal Rai (40). On July 13, the Maritime Rescue Coordination Centre (MRCC), Indian Coast Guard Regional Headquarters (A&N), Sri Vijaya Puram, received a Distress Alert from Indian Fishing Boat DEEP (IND-AN-SA-MO-178) from a position approximately 50

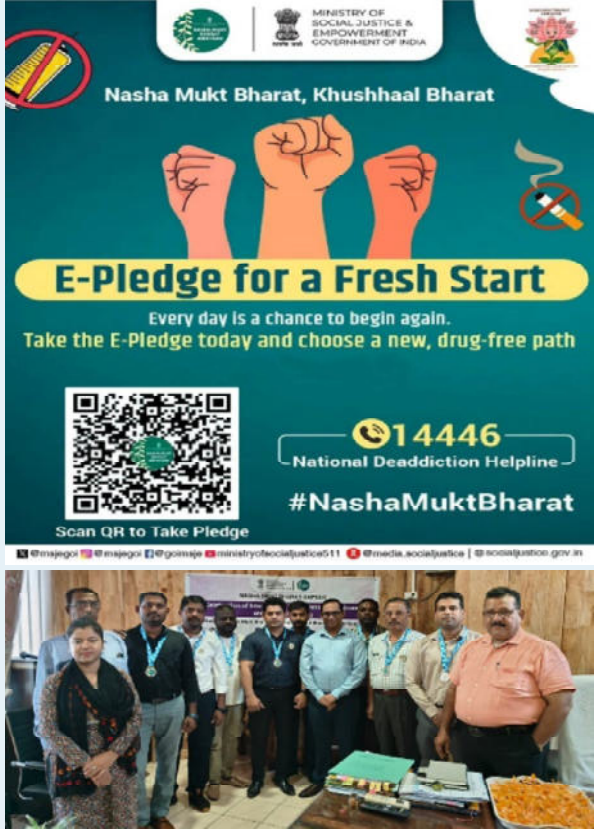

nautical miles south-east of Sri Vijaya Puram.

The fishing boat had sailed from Deepika Nandapur Fish Landing Centre, Hut Bay, at 1000 hours on July 10 with two crew members onboard for fishing. Shortly after sailing, the vessel suffered a complete engine failure, leaving it helplessly adrift amidst severe weather conditions. For nearly three days, the fishermen battled rough seas, heavy swells and strong winds, with no means of propulsion or communication except the onboard Distress Alert Transmitter (DAT), which ultimately became their lifeline.

Immediately upon receipt of the distress signal, a joint Search and Rescue (SAR) operation was launched under the Andaman Nicobar Command. Indian Navy Air assets and Indian Coast Guard Ship Rajveer were deployed for the mission. Despite adverse weather conditions, the distressed fishing boat was located at approximately 1400 hours on July 13.

The Coast Guard crew recovered both fishermen and brought them safely onboard, where they were administered first aid and medical assessment. The rescued fishermen were found to be in stable condition and were subsequently handed over to the concerned authorities at Sri Vijaya Puram for further formalities, a press release from ANC said.

The two-day programme covers important aspects of disaster risk reduction, including Basics of Disaster Management, School Safety, Search and Rescue (SAR), Medical First Response (MFR), and Fire Safety. The sessions comprise both classroom lectures and practical demonstrations conducted by experts from the Directorate of Disaster Management, Directorate of Education, Health Department, National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), and Fire Services.

Earlier, welcoming the gathering, Shri Janik Ram, Assistant Director (Admn.), Directorate of Disaster Management highlighted the importance of strengthening disaster preparedness in educational institutions. The inaugural session concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Shri Sudev Kumar, Statistical Officer, DDM, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

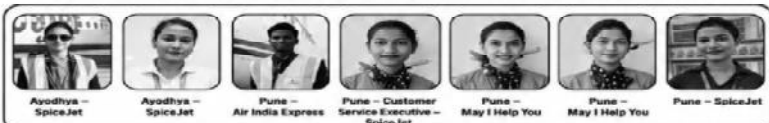
