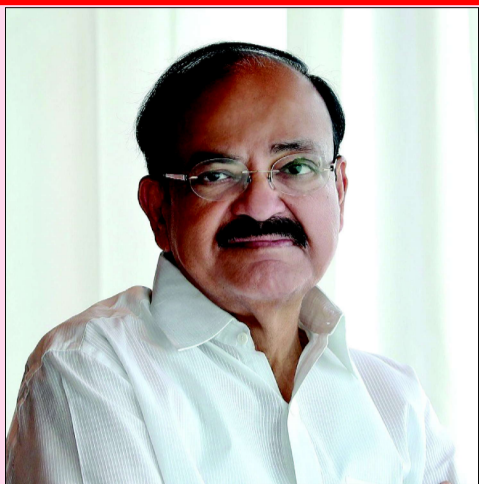

Vice President to visit A&N Islands from Jan 16 to 19

Port Blair, Jan 14
The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu will visit the Andaman and Nicobar Islands from 16th to 19th of January, 2020. During the visit, Shri Naidu will lay wreath at Martyr's Column in National Memorial Cellular Jail and witness the Light and Sound Show there. He will also inaugurate a Nature Park and Interpretation Centre (NPIC) in Port Blair during his stay in the Islands.



The NPIC has been set up in an area of 3.6 hectare as one of the prime destinations in Port Blair city for recreation, education and show-casing the

richness of biodiversity of Islands. Further, the Vice President will also flag-off AC buses, newly inducted by the Department of Transport, Andaman and Nicobar Administration for improving the quality and quantity of urban public transport in the Islands. The Vice President will also attend a civic reception and address the gathering, during his visit, a PIB release said here today.

Home Minister chairs meeting of IDA focusing on 'Green Development in Islands to reach a new Height'

New Delhi, Jan 14
The Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah, chaired the sixth meeting of the Island Development Agency (IDA) held here yesterday. The Island Development Agency reviewed the progress made towards the programme "Holistic development of islands". The meeting was attended by the Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral D. K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Administrator of Lakshadweep, Shri Dineshwar Sharma, Shri Rajiv Gauba, Cabinet Secretary, Shri Amitabh Kant, CEO, NITI Aayog, Secretaries and senior officials from the Ministries of Home, Commerce, Tribal Affairs, Environment and Forest, Petroleum and Natural Gas, Telecommunications, Shipping, Water Resources, Earth Sciences, New and Renewable Energy.



Islands have been prepared and are being implemented in four islands of Andaman & Nicobar and five islands of Lakshadweep. In the second phase, suitable sites in 12 more islands of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and 5 islands in Lakshadweep have been covered.

Model tourism projects both Land-based and Water Villas were planned and bids have been invited

for private sector participation. As a unique initiative, to spur investment, it was decided to obtain clearances for implementation of the planned projects up-front. All necessary clearances would be in place before bids finalization. Environment and Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) clearances have already been obtained for four exemplary tourism projects

of Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

For strengthening infrastructure support, projects for improving air, sea and digital connectivity are also being implemented. Port Blair and another 7 Islands in Andaman & Nicobar would get digitally connected through submarine optical fibre cable by June, 2020. Better communication

GSAT-30 satellite to be launched from French Guiana on Jan 17

New Delhi, Jan 14
GSAT-30, a communication satellite of India, is scheduled for launch onboard Ariane-5 launch vehicle (VA 251) from French Guiana on January 17, 2020, at 0235 hrs IST. Weighing 3357 kg, GSAT-30 is to serve as replacement to INSAT-4A spacecraft services with enhanced coverage. GSAT-30 will be extensively used for supporting VSAT networks, Television uplinking and Teleport services, Digital Services News Gathering (DSNG), DTH-Television services, cellular backhaul connectivity and many such applications. The communication payload of GSAT-30

is specifically designed and optimised to maximise the number of transponders on the spacecraft bus. The satellite provides Indian mainland and islands coverage in Ku-band. It also provides extended coverage in C-band which helps

services would facilitate setting up of Information Technology based and other Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the islands with incentives through Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands Industrial Development Scheme (LANIDS), 2018 notified on 1st January, 2019. The proposed airports in Great Nicobar Island of Andaman & Nicobar and Minicoy Island of Lakshadweep would catalyze the development process in the region.
In the meeting, a detailed presentation was made by CEO, NITI Aayog highlighting current status of the planned projects being implemented for islanders' benefits. The status of implementation of decisions taken in the last meeting was also highlighted in the presentation.
