Port Blair, Jan. 14

Bharat Net is a Flagship programme of Government of India. It envisages an information superhighway through creation of robust middle-mile infrastructure for reaching broadband connectivity to Gram Panchayats. The objective of Bharat Net is to facilitate the delivery of e-governance, e-health, e-education, e-banking, Internet and other services to rural India. To achieve this, it is planned to connect all the 2,50,000 Gram Panchayats in the country and provide 100 Mbps connectivity to all Gram Panchayats. The existing unused fibres (dark fibre) of public sector



undertakings (PSUs) (BSNL, Railtel and Power Grid) will be utilized and laid to connect to Gram Panchayats wherever necessary. Non-discriminatory access of the Network will be made available to all the service providers like Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) and Cable TV Operators and

content providers to launch various services in rural areas. The project is funded by Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) and executed by a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) namely Bharat Broadband Network Limited (BBNL).

In Andaman and Nicobar Islands, it is proposed to connect 70

Gram Panchayats, 6 Tribal Councils and 7 Blocks with incremental OFC from the nearest BSNL exchange. Out of the 70 Gram Panchayats, 4 Gram Panchayats and out of 6 Tribal Councils, 4 Tribal Councils are planned to be connected through VSAT. The implementation of the work has been taken over by BBNL and Purchase Order has been issued to M/s ITI Ltd Bangalore in September, 2020.

As on date, 12 Gram Panchayats have been connected by OFC and is ready for providing services. VSAT equipment for 4 Gram Panchayats and 4

100% subsidy for General & Tribal Fishers for purchase of two way communication devices

The Department of Fisheries, A & N Administration is implementing a UT Plan programme under the Scheme 'Development of Capture & Culture Fisheries and Resource Management'. The programme envisages assistance @ 100% subsidy for General and Tribal Fishers having motorized boats on purchase of two way communication device for Geo-fencing of protected area, communication with the fellow vessels at Sea as well as with shore authorities under the programme during 2020 - 21. In this regard, the owners of Motorized Fishing Boats have been requested to collect the prescribed application form from the Office of the Assistant Director of Fisheries, Zonal Fisheries Office, South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar District or Fisheries Sub - Stations: Shaheed Dweep, Swaraj Dweep, Little Andaman, Katchal, Teressa, Nancowry, Campbell Bay, Kadamtala, Rangat, Billiground and Diglipur. The filled in application with relevant documents may be submitted to the nearest Zonal Fisheries Office / Fisheries Sub - Station on or before 20th January, 2021, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

vehicles to inform the change of residence or place of business to the registering authority having jurisdiction over the new place. In case of failure to do so, the owners of such motor vehicles are liable to be penalized under MVA Act 2019. As per Rule 39 of ANIMVR'2006 if any motor vehicle which is not registered in the UT has been kept for a period exceeding 14 days, the owner of the vehicle shall inform the same to Registering Authority, A & N Islands with details viz. name, address, registration mark, description of vehicle and in case of transport vehicle the date on which the permit has been issued. This has been brought to the notice of all concerned on earlier occasion by publishing it in the local newspapers but it is observed that such vehicles continue to ply on the road violating the legal provisions.

All the vehicle owners of mainland registration vehicle are therefore once again advised to intimate the Transport Department of their vehicle details alongwith complete information of the owner with phone number. If any person/vehicle owners whose vehicles registered in others States are found plying on the roads in A&N Islands without intimation and permission from this Department, strict action will be taken against them. All the owners of the motor vehicles registered in other States but brought to the UT of A&N Islands have been directed to intimate the details of such change in address to the Office of Transport Department within 14 days as prescribed above to avoid legal action as per law. Such owners are also advised to keep documents related to transportation of their vehicles to this UT for verification.

Transport and Police Department will be conducting stringent enforcement drives to regulate such practices and defaulters/violators will be booked under relevant MV Act/Rule for penal action, a press release from Directorate of Transport said.

pandemic. The scheme has not only dispelled the darkness but acted as the pathway for the street vendors, in their most distressed times.

Meet one of the beneficiaries, Shri K. Srinu, a street vendor, whose regular income came to a standstill during pandemic. He used to run a fast food business, opposite A m b e d k a r A u d i t o r i u m , Aberdeen Bazaar and lost all hopes for revival of life and business until he heard about PM SVANidhi scheme. Srinu, who supports a family of four members including his wife and two school going children, was badly hit by the pandemic and struggled hard to make ends meet.



Managing even one proper meal a day for his family was getting difficult. His wife recalls how she had to borrow money from her parents to feed her starving children. They got some ration from grocery store on credit basis to support themselves in the difficult times. When the markets re-opened, Srinu did not have money to buy stocks for his fast food shop. He came to hear about the working capital loan of Rs 10,000 facilitated by PBMC Office and applied for the same. Upon receipt of the loan, he bought ration for family as well as the essential stocks for re-establishing his fast food business. He also paid back the money borrowed from his parents and also settled the credit of grocery shop.

PM SVANidhi has helped him in bringing back his life on track. He has regained his self-esteem and confidence and expressed his gratitude to the Administration and PBMC for the support. (Source: PBMC)

In view of the outbreak of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza in some of the States of the country, which is a highly contagious avian disease having zoonotic potential of causing huge loss in terms of mortality and trade of poultry, it is necessary to take precautionary measures and restrict the possibility of ingress of the disease into the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

In view of the above, Temporary ban on Import of Poultry and Poultry Products from all States and UTs into the Andaman and Nicobar Islands is imposed. Advisories have already been issued to the concerned authorities for active and targeted surveillance against the disease.

This order comes into force with immediate effect and will remain in force until further orders.

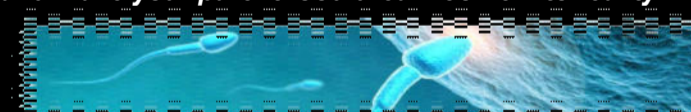

Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And, whereas, the Directorate of Industries (hereinafter referred to as the Department), is implementing the Entrepreneurship Development and Skill Upgradation Scheme (hereinafter referred to as the Scheme) to realize the goal of small business owners to remain self-employed, who may need skill upgradation and entrepreneurial and marketing assistance in order to sustain themselves through practical and cost effective skill building program;

And, whereas, under the Scheme, skill building/upgradation training and stipend thereon (hereinafter referred to as the benefit) is given to the trainees who include school dropouts, unemployed local youth, artisans, members of the Self Help Groups, individual entrepreneurs, who may be boys/girls and men/women from age of 14 years and adults upto 45 years of age (hereinafter together referred to as the beneficiaries), as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

And, whereas, the Scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of India ;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), A & N Administration hereby notifies the following, namely:-

1. (1) An individual desirous of availing the benefit under the Scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar Number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.

(3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar Enrolment Centre located in the respective Block or Taluka or Tehsil, the Department shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves;

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, the benefit under the Scheme shall be given to such individuals subject to production of the following documents, namely:-

I. For children below 18 years old :

(a) if the child has been enrolled after attaining the age of five years (with biometrics collection), his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip, or of bio-metric update identification slip; and

(b) any one of the following documents, namely:-

(i) Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; or

(ii) School Transfer Certificate, duly signed by the Principal of the School, containing parent's names; and

(c) any one of the following documents as proof of relationship of the beneficiary with the parent or legal guardian as per the extant Scheme guidelines, namely:-

(i) Birth Certificate; or Record of Birth issued by the appropriate authority; or

(ii) Ration Card; or

(iii) Islander Identity Card issued by Competent Authority;

(iv) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or

(v) Passport; or

(vi) Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) Card; or Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Card; or Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Card; or

(vii) Pension Card; or

(viii) Army Canteen Card; or

(ix) any Government Family Entitlement Card; or

(x) any other document as specified by the Department.

II. For beneficiaries above 18 years old :

(a) if he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip; and

(b) any one of the following documents, namely :-

(i) Birth Certificate; or Record of Birth issued by the appropriate authority; or

(ii) School Transfer Certificate, duly signed by the Principal of the School, containing parent's names; and

(iii) Islander Identity Card issued by Competent Authority;

(iv) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or

(v) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or

(vi) Passport; or

(vii) Ration Card; or

(viii) Voter Identity Card; or

(ix) MGNREGA Card; or

(x) Kisan Photo Passbook; or

(xi) Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or

(xii) Certificate of Identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or

(xiii) any other document as specified by the Department;

Provided further that the above documents shall be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Scheme conveniently, the Department shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the requirement of Aadhaar under the Scheme.

3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely :-

(a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department request the Registrars of UIDAI or Aadhaar enrolment agencies authorised by the A & N Administration for iris scanning/face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;

(b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-Based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
