President gives assent to bill aimed at checking malpractices in government recruitment examinations

New Delhi, Feb. 14 President, Smti Droupadi Murmu has given her assent to the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Bill, 2024. The Bill was passed by the Parliament in the recently concluded budget session.



The Bill is intended to prevent unfair means in the public examinations. Public examinations refer to examinations conducted by the Union Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission, Railway Recruitment Board, National Testing Agency, and Departments of the Central Government. The Bill intended to prohibit collusion or conspiracy to

facilitate indulgence in any unfair means. Unfair means include, unauthorised access or leakage of question paper or answer key, assisting a candidate during a public examination, tampering with computer networks, conducting fake examination, issuing fake admit cards and offer letters. The objective of the Bill is to bring greater transparency, fairness and credibility to the public examination systems and to reassure

the youth that their sincere and genuine efforts will be fairly rewarded and their future is safe. Candidates as defined in the Bill will not be liable for action within the purview of the Bill and will continue to be covered under the extant administrative provisions of the concerned public examination authority. As per the provisions of the Bill, committed offence will be punishable with imprisonment between three to ten years, and a fine up from ten lakh to one crore rupees. All offences under the Bill will be cognisable, non-bailable, and non-compoundable. (Source: india.gov.in)

He delivered the special keynote address on the theme of the Summit - "Shaping the Future Governments". Prime Minister had attended the World Governments Summit in 2018, also as Guest of Honour. The Summit this time saw participation of 20 world leaders, including 10 Presidents and 10 Prime

ORDER

Whereas, in view of the proposed visit of the VVIP to A & N Islands during the 3rd week of February, 2024, elaborate Law and Order arrangement are being made in Nicobar District for the safety & security of VVIP. Considering the significance and security requirement, it is imperative to ensure public safety and order during the period of the visit.

And whereas, it is necessary to take preventive measures to maintain law and order, mitigate potential security risks and facilitate the smooth conduct of the VVIP visit to A & N Islands.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Jyoti Kumari, IAS, District Magistrate, Nicobar District, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, do hereby prohibit the assembly of five or more persons in public places from 19th February till 21st February, 2024 in the area of Car Nicobar Tehsil in connection with the VVIP visit to those islands and doing so shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The order shall not apply to Executive Magistrates, Police Personnel and other Public Servants on duty and other Officials for VVIP Visit. In view of the emergent situation this order is passed ex-parte and addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be enforced by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Executive Magistrates and other Officials on duties during the above said period.

This order shall come into force with effect from 19th February to 21st February, 2024 till the return of VVIP. It shall extend to entire area/ jurisdiction of Car Nicobar Tehsil.

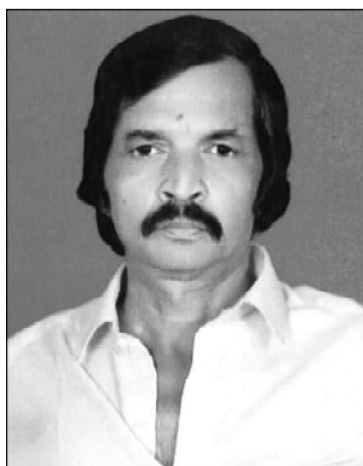

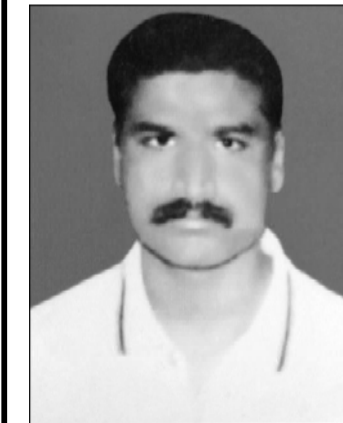
