This has been done in order to ensure hassle free access to verified OTRMS Certificates. The issued certificates will automatically be transferred to DigiLocker and the same may be traced at the website of National Council for Teacher Education and DigiLocker. The Minister also informed that the registration fee of 200 rupees payable for obtaining OTRMS Certificates, issued by NCTE has been waived off. When contacted, the staff manning the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadi Kendra functioning in the premises of G. B. Pant Hospital informed that the Kendra is open from 9 am to 1.30 pm and from 2.30 pm to 6 pm benefiting a large number of people through provision of medicines at lower rate. Apart from generic medicines, sanitary napkin at the rate of Rs. 4 for 4 pieces, diaper, glucometer are also being sold at affordable prices.

faced huge loss during this time. At that point of time, she realized that it was getting increasingly difficult to maintain the family and children with single income and she decided to start a poultry farm at her residence. She felt that she can start this business with little investment and can gain good profit from it. Smti. M. Kalaimani is also a member of a Self Help Group (SHG) namely 'Shivashankara' of Beodnabad village. In July 2020, she got loan from ANINRLM with which, she started her poultry business initially with only one hen and one rooster. With the passing of days, her business developed and today she has nearly 250 chickens of different varieties available in her poultry. Smti. Kalaimani happily shares that "now I have a turnover of 10 to 15 thousand rupees every month from the firm, the real game changer has been the loan available from NRLM Scheme. "Earlier, there were no such sources available for rural women like me", she mentioned.

Although the story of Smti. M. Kalaimani is just a testament to the success of Govt. run programmes; there are still thousands of rural women waiting to enjoy similar success. Smti. Kalaimani thanked the SHG 'Shivashankara', the GoI and the Department of RD, A&N Administration for making such schemes reach out to the grassroot level, a press release from Directorate of RD/Panchayats said.

The step was discussed in the 39th & 40th Transport Development Council Meetings and was appreciated & concurred to by participants from the states. The rules come even as the Ministry is in the pursuit of providing seamless movement to tourist passenger vehicles, after the success of goods carriage vehicles under National Permit Regime.

Moreover, the scheme allows flexibility in the form of authorization/ permit being granted, for a period of three months or its multiples thereof, not exceeding three years at a time. This provision has been incorporated keeping in mind those areas of our country where there is a limited season of tourism and also for those operators who have limited financial capacity. It will also consolidate a central database and fees of all such authorization/permits, which might give a sense of tourist movements, scope for improvement, promotion of tourism.

The step comes in the context of travel and tourism industry in our country increasing manifold in last fifteen years. The growth has been contributed by both domestic and international tourists, and there is a trend of high expectation and consumer experience.

and breeding, he started training fellow farmers of his village. By selling honey and bee-colonies, he is earning an additional income of Rs. 15,000/- per annum.



He also shows interest in poultry and livestock. With cows and few domestic fowls of local breed, he gets an additional income of Rs. 1,45,000/- per annum. According to him, dairy animals are part of organic farming systems because of the complementary and supplementary relationship between both enterprises. One of the main advantages of cattle-based organic farming is that there is no dependence on expensive chemical fertilizers, which leads to reduction in the production cost, which in turn saves energy and protects the environment in the long run, he opined.

Shri Chittaranjan Roy is a hard worker who self-motivated himself to take up new initiative for profitable agriculture. He is an example of a successful farmer and has proved that wonders can be done in agriculture, if investments are made in the right direction and farmers are equipped with the latest knowledge. Civil Aviation Ministry proposes about 392 routes under UDAN 4.1 bidding process

New Delhi, March 14 Ministry of Civil Aviation has proposed about 392 routes under UDAN 4.1 bidding process on the occasion of the commencement of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. The UDAN 4.1 round is focused on connecting smaller airports, along with the special helicopter and seaplane routes.



In addition to these, some new routes have been proposed under the Sagaramala Seaplane Services in consultation with the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways. Till date, 325 routes and 56 airports including 5 heliports and 2 Water Aerodromes have

been operationalised under the UDAN scheme. The Regional Connectivity Scheme, UDAN, Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik, is a flagship scheme of the Ministry of Civil Aviation envisaged to make air travel affordable and widespread in the country. The scheme intends to boost inclusive national economic growth, employment opportunities and infrastructure development across the nation. (Source: india.gov.in)

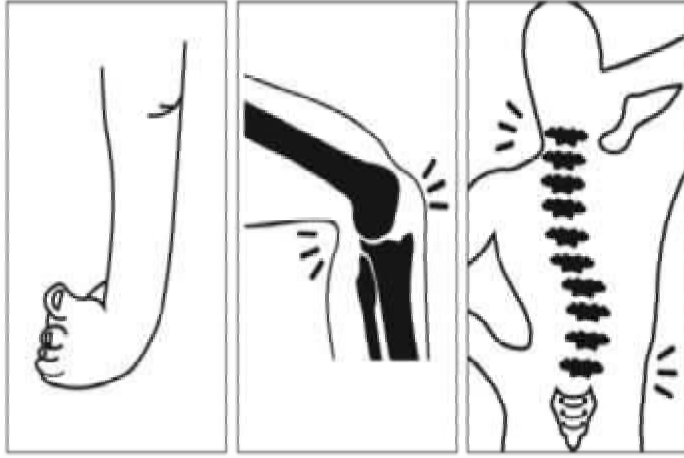

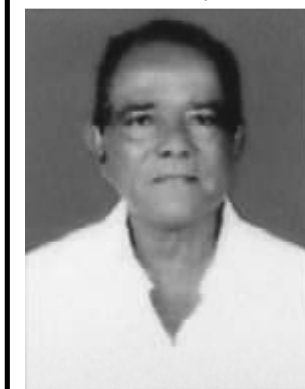

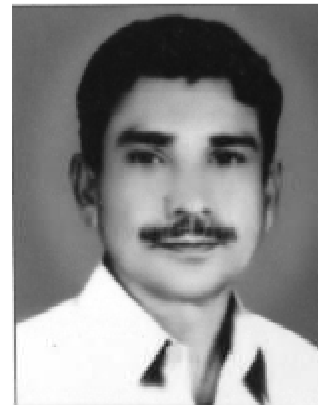
