



Govt. cancels Class 10th Board Exams, postpones Exams for Class 12th

New Delhi, April 14 The Government has postponed CBSE Board Exams for class 10th and exams for class 12th stands cancelled. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today held a meeting with the Union Education Minister and other senior officials in New Delhi and reviewed the matter of CBSE Board exams which was scheduled to be held in next month. The Prime Minister asserted that the well being of the students has to be the top priority for the Government. He also stated that the Centre would keep in mind the best interest of the students and ensure that their health is taken care of at the same time their academic interests are not harmed. Considering the present situation of the pandemic and school closures and also taking into account the safety and well being of the students the board exams for class 12th have been postponed. These

Administration committed to protect Islanders against COVID-19 Pandemic

Timely intervention of Chief Secretary ensured supply of essential materials to A&N Islands free of cost

Port Blair, April 14 There has been a sudden surge in COVID-19 cases all over the country. Of late, our Islands too are witnessing a sudden rise in the number of COVID positive cases. The Administration with the commitment to protect the Islanders against the pandemic is leaving no stone unturned. To ensure that there is no dearth of materials required for containment of COVID-19 virus in A&N Islands considering the fact that most of the materials come from mainland, the Administration has directed the Health Department to procure materials and equipments in adequate quantity. It is worth mentioning that with the timely intervention of Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, a large quantity of essential materials like PPE Kits (100000), goggles (100000), face mask-N95 (200000), disposable face mask (300000), face shield (9000), disposable shoe cover (27000 pairs), hand gloves (200000 pairs), etc. were supplied by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI through HLL Company, free of cost, which would have cost the exchequer of UT Administration an amount of Rs. 13.71 crores, a press release from DHS said.

Passengers tested positive shall be kept under Institutional Quarantine as per SOPs

Port Blair, April 14 There has been a rapid surge in the COVID-19 positive cases in the South Andaman District and in order to contain further spread of virus for the safety of the Islanders as a whole, the District Magistrate, South Andaman has ordered that compulsory Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) shall be conducted on all incoming passengers at the Veer Savarkar International Airport, Port Blair with effect from April 16, 2021, free of cost. This will be in addition to the mandatory RTPCR negative test report to be carried by the passengers, already in force. All the inbound passengers have been directed to cooperate with the officials performing the test at the airport and support the Administration in the fight against COVID-19. Passengers who are tested positive by the Rapid Antigen Test shall be kept under Institutional Quarantine as per Standard

Port Blair, April 14 The four-day 'Tika Utsav' has been a tremendous success with about 8734 beneficiaries vaccinated in 36 sessions and by about 85 teams in the entire UT today. With this, the total number of people in the age group of 45 + vaccinated till date has reached more than 60000 in the Islands. Meanwhile, 30,000 additional doses released by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI has reached Port Blair today and a special trip of pawanhans has been arranged to deliver the vaccine to North and Middle Andaman tomorrow. Food grains at affordable price under ONORC scheme

NFSA beneficiaries appealed to make maximum use of Toll-free number & 'Mera Ration' App

Port Blair, April 14

The Government of India launched a landmark scheme 'One Nation One Ration Card' (ONORC) to facilitate migrants and meeting their requirement of foodgrains at a very affordable rate. This scheme was implemented by the Central Government in a war footing manner in the wake of pandemic COVID-19 to avoid struggle of the socio-economically weaker migrant laborers to meet both ends of their livelihoods.

The UT Administration has taken relentless efforts by leaving no stone unturned to implement this scheme within the established timeframe by the Central Government and made functional with effect from February, 2021 in true letter and spirit.



For effective implementation of this scheme, the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has launched a toll free number 14445 to address all the queries and provide information related to NFSA at their fingertips. The NFSA beneficiaries can register their grievances by contacting over toll free number 14445 from 8.45 am to 5 pm on all working days which will be addressed promptly by the Department.

In addition to this, the Government of India has launched a mobile App

namely 'Mera Ration' to facilitate the ONORC-related services among beneficiaries of the NFSA, particularly migrant beneficiaries, Fair Price Shops and other stakeholders. The App can be used for the registration of migrant beneficiaries, identification of nearest FPS, checking of foodgrains entitlement as well as previous six months transactions along with status of Aadhaar seeding. Besides this, the App also provides option to submit suggestions and feedbacks related to FPS. This attempt by the UT Administration will be an

additional feather in the cap towards the direction of providing e-Governance for better service delivery to the citizens.

Shri Deepak Pundir, Director (CS&CA) alongwith Shri Rajesh Kumar, Deputy Director (CS&CA) interacted directly with the NFSA beneficiaries in various Fair Price Shops to sensitize them about the salient features of this scheme such as toll-free number and 'Mera Ration' App. The Director (CS&CA) appealed to NFSA beneficiaries i.e. PHH & AAY to make maximum use of the Toll-free number and 'Mera Ration' App. The beneficiaries provided positive feedback to the officials on the services provided by the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs through the Fair Price Shops, a press release from Directorate of CS&CA said.

Observance of Fire Service Week commences in A&N Islands

Together with the rest of the country, the A & N Police Fire Service is observing the Fire Service Week from April 14 to 20. The theme for this year is 'Maintenance of Fire Safety Equipment is Key to Mitigate Fire Hazards'. The Fire Service Week is organized every year in memory of a major fire incident that occurred on 14th April, 1944 at Victoria Harbour in Mumbai, in which 336 persons died and 1040 were injured. Out of 336 who died, 68 were Officers and Jawans of Mumbai Fire Brigade. The tragedy occurred when a ship namely SS Fort Strikine loaded with explosive materials exploded while berthing at Jetty causing fire in several other vessels berthed in the wharf.

In A&N Islands, the 'Fire Service Week' commenced with the observance of 'Commemoration Day' to pay homage to those



brave officers and men of Mumbai Fire Brigade who lost their lives during the fire fighting operation. Shri Manjeet, Superintendent of Police (Fire Service) was the chief guest on the commemoration day parade.

In his address, the chief guest highlighted the duties and responsibilities of Fire Service personnel towards safety of life and property of the Islanders and also about the role of Fire Service personnel in the event of any type of disaster in these Islands. He appreciated the Fire Service personnel of A&N Islands for being

alert and attentive in their job and exhorted them to maintain a high degree of professionalism while fighting against fire and disaster in these Islands.

A two minutes silence was observed at Fire Service parade ground in memory of those Fire Service personnel who sacrificed their lives during discharge of duty in the year 2020. 1) Instructions have been issued by this Administration regarding use of Stamp paper and e-stamp paper for the purpose of registration of instruments/documents for property transactions vide Order No.3064 & 3065 dated 22/10/2019 respectively. As per the said order, it was directed that payment for purchase of stamp papers/e-stamp papers shall be borne only by one among the parties, either buyer or seller in case of deeds pertaining to exchange/sale/transfer of interest over immovable property.

2) As per the provisions of Section 29 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, in the absence of an agreement to the contrary, the expense of providing Stamp duty shall be paid:-

(i) in the case of an instrument of exchange – by the parties in equal shares ;




