



PM releases 8th instalment of financial benefit under PM-KISAN

Government is fighting COVID-19 with all its might

New Delhi, May 14
 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi released 8th instalment of financial benefit of Rs 2,06,67,75,66,000 to 9,50,67,601 beneficiary farmers under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme today via video conferencing. On this occasion, the Prime Minister also interacted with beneficiary farmers of the scheme from various parts of the country including Car Nicobar in A&N Islands, Unnao in Uttar Pradesh, Anantapur in Andhra Pradesh, Ri Bhoi in Meghalaya among others. PM-Kisan scheme has benefitted



millions of farmers since its launch on 24th February in 2019. Under this scheme 6000 rupees is transferred annually into the account of farmers in three equal instalments. Centre is committed to increase the ambit of the scheme covering every farmer in the country irrespective of their land holding. Over 11 crore 28 lakh farmers have benefited from the scheme so far. Over 1 lakh 16 thousand crore rupees have been transferred directly into the accounts of the farmers under this scheme. Nearly 43,000 crore was released into the accounts of the farmers during the first wave of the corona pandemic. Speaking on the

occasion, he lauded the efforts of the farmers who have made record produce in food grains and horticulture amidst the difficulties during this pandemic. He said Government is also setting new records in procurement at MSP every year. Paddy procurement at MSP had set new records and now wheat procurement at MSP is

 "It was a dream come true" for a farmer from Tapoiming village of Car Nicobar, Shri Patrick, when he had the opportunity to share the spotlight with Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on his passion towards organic farming. The interaction was part of an event telecast live, in which the Prime Minister released the 8th instalment of financial benefit under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) today. The Prime Minister interacted with Shri Patrick via video conferencing arranged in the conference hall of Secretariat.



The Prime Minister asked Shri Patrick to narrate his farming experience and in response, Shri Patrick said that since childhood he was motivated towards organic farming and he along with his family members continues organic farming in his village and also motivates others to follow the same. Organic products have good market value and Shri Patrick said, adding that he is planning to sell his organic produce in Delhi after its proper branding. This, he said, will fetch him good income. He also thanked the Prime Minister for starting PM-KISAN scheme under which, he gets a financial benefit of Rs. 6000/- per year. He said, with this financial assistance, he is able to procure various inputs to ensure crop health and procurement of seeds.

Responding to Patrick's views, the

Prime Minister said he is happy to see the happiness on the face of Shri Patrick being a proud organic farmer of a remote Island. The Prime Minister noted with appreciation that the concept of joint family is prevalent and all family members of Shri Patrick are contributing in farm activities. PM said that the vision of Shri Patrick to market the organic produce in Delhi shows his "determination and self confidence" which will surely motivate other farmers too. He said that Car Nicobar is moving forward in organic farming and congratulated Shri Patrick for his dedication towards organic farming. He also urged Shri Patrick to share his experience about organic farming to other farmers.

Later, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain also interacted with Shri Patrick and appreciated the large scale organic cultivation being done by him in his village. The Chief Secretary also suggested to motivate other farmers of his area to take benefit of organic certification to enhance their income.

Preventive steps to contain transmission of corona virus DM (SA) orders complete lockdown in 12 villages under Ferrargunj Tehsil from May 15 to 22

Port Blair, May 14
 In view of the recent surge in the positive cases of COVID-19 in the Islands, the District Administration, South Andaman has been taking various proactive steps to contain the spread of the virus in the District. The District Administration is closely monitoring the situation and noticed that there is a steep increase in positive cases in the past few days in some areas and which have been declared as Containment Zones. In order to place strict measures of isolation and social

distancing in the South Andaman District and to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr.P.C., has ordered complete lockdown to be imposed in the villages of Hopetown, Shorepoint, Bambooflat, Stewartgunj, Govindapuram, Nayapuram, Wimberlygunj, Kanyapuram, Mannarghat, Malappuram, Wright Myo and Shoal Bay under Ferrargunj Tehsil with effect from 15.05.2021. The order will be effective till 22.05.2021.

In view of this, no movement of men and material shall be allowed except for emergency cases, medical emergencies, pregnant women and patients availing medical services. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk Road, loading and unloading of essential cargo and travel of persons to proceed to their destinations on production of valid documents for

Centre to supply over one crore 91 lakh vaccine doses to States, UTs free of cost in next 15 days

New Delhi, May 14

Centre will supply over one crore 91 lakh vaccine doses to the States and UTs free of cost in the next 15 days. This will include 162.5 lakh of Covishield and 29.49 lakh of Covaxin. The delivery schedule for this allocation will be shared in advance.

States have been asked to direct the concerned officials to ensure rational and judicious utilization of allocated doses and minimize vaccine wastage. The basic objective behind informing the States and UTs in advance of the quantum of free vaccine doses to be made available from the Central Government for 15 days is to ensure that they prepare effective plans for judicious and optimum utilisation of these free vaccine doses which are meant for the age group 45 and above, and for HCWs and FLWs. In the previous fortnight, over 1.7 crore vaccine doses have been made available by the Centre to States, free of cost. (Source: india.gov.in)

RAT test conducted on these passengers, 6 persons were found positive.

The Secretary informed that in view of the recent surge in the positive cases of COVID-19 in the Islands, a complete lockdown will be imposed in some villages under Ferrargunj Tehsil from 15.05.21 to 22.05.21. An order to this effect has been issued by the District Magistrate, South Andaman District, he said.

The Secretary further stated that the number of COVID patients are increasing in G.B. Pant Hospital and Covid Care Centres in South Andaman. If such trend continues, the Administration will be left with no option to impose more stricter measures in the coming days, the Secretary IP&T cautioned.

The Director, ANIIMS, Shri A.K. Mandal informed that in G. B Pant Hospital 113 new COVID patients were admitted and 5 were discharged today while the Deputy Director, G.B. Pant Hospital, Shri Amitabha De informed that altogether, 10 COVID patients were admitted in Covid Care Centres today. Further, 4 patients were discharged and at present 53 patients are still in Covid Care Centres in South Andaman District, the Deputy Director added.

The Director, IP&T, Shri Alok Kumar and the Deputy Director, IP&T, Shri R.S. Meena also attended the press conference.

COVID-19 recovery rate improves to 83.50%; Over 3.43 lakh new cases reported

New Delhi, May 14

The Health Ministry said, in the last 24 hours over 3 lakh 44 thousand people have recovered from Covid-19 infection. The recovery rate is now at 83.50 per cent. Till now, over 2 crore 79 thousand people have recovered. More than 17 crore 92 lakh 98 thousand vaccine doses has been administered to beneficiaries till now in the country.

The country has reported over 3 lakh 43 thousand new COVID19 cases in the last 24 hours taking the total cases to over 2 crore 40 lakh. Four thousand deaths were reported in the last 24 hours and the death toll due to Coronavirus pandemic has reached 2 lakh 62 thousand 317.

There are over 37 lakh active cases in the country. Indian Council of Medical Research ICMR said, more than 31 crore 13

lakh samples have been tested in the country up till yesterday. It said, over 18 lakh 75 thousand samples were tested yesterday. (Source: india.gov.in)

also setting new records. He added that so far this year, about 10 percent more wheat has been procured at MSP, compared to last year. So far, about Rs. 58,000 crores for wheat procurement has reached the farmers' account directly.

Prime Minister remarked that the Government is constantly trying to provide new solutions and new options in farming. Promoting organic farming is also one of such effort. Organic farming delivers more profit and is now being practiced across the nation by young farmers. He said that now organic farming is being practised on both banks of Ganga and within a radius of about 5 kilometers, so that the Ganga remains clean.

Prime Minister stressed that during this COVID-19 pandemic, Kisan Credit Card's deadline has been extended and instalments can now be renewed by 30th June. He said more than 2 crore Kisan Credit Cards have been issued in recent years.

Prime Minister said that this once in a century pandemic is challenging the world, as it is an invisible enemy in front of us. He said the Government is fighting COVID-19 with all its might and ensuring that every government department is working day & night to ease the pain of the nation.

Prime Minister remarked that Central Government and all the State Governments together, are making continuous efforts to enable more and more countrymen to get vaccinated at a rapid pace. He said so far, around 18 crore vaccine doses have been given across the country. Free vaccination is being done in government hospitals across the country. Prime Minister urged everyone to register for the vaccine when their turn comes and ensure covid appropriate behaviour at all times. He added that this vaccine is an important means of protection against corona and will reduce the risk of serious illness.

Prime Minister said Armed forces are working with full strength to ensure oxygen supply in these tough times. Railways are also running oxygen express trains. The pharma sector of the country is manufacturing and delivering medicines at a large scale. He requested the State Governments to ensure strict laws to counter black marketing of medicines and medical supplies.

Prime Minister remarked that India is not a nation that loses hope in tough times and hoped that this challenge would be overcome with strength & dedication. He warned about the spread of COVID-19 in rural areas as well and urged the village panchayats to ensure proper awareness and sanitation in their respective areas. (Source PIB)

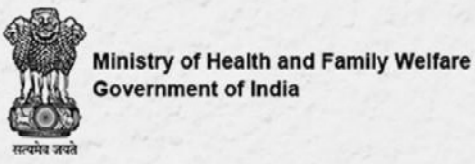
movement in and out of the above mentioned areas.

Officers/officials involved in essential and emergency services such as District Administration, Police, Home Guards, Civil Defence, Fire and Emergency Services, Family Welfare and all related Medical establishments, Electricity, Water Supply and Sanitation, Disaster Management, Forest and related services, Private Security Services, LPG Stores/Godown, Telecommunication, Internet Service Providers, Broadcasting and Cable Services, Cold Storages and Ware Houses shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Card to function within the above said areas.

All private medical personnel such as Doctors, Nursing Staff, Paramedical etc. and other Hospitals Services (such as Hospitals, Diagnostic Centres and Clinics) on production of valid Identity cards to perform their services within the above said areas.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and also fines shall also be imposed as per Order issued by District Office from time to time, the order to this effect issued by District Magistrate (SA) added.

Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs), BPPI and other stakeholders join hands to make available the essential medicines and other items at affordable prices

7733 PMBJKs are functional across the country

New Delhi, May 14

Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs), Bureau of Pharma PSUs of India (BPPI), Distributors and other stakeholders have come together and are contributing in the fight against the current wave of Covid 19 pandemic.

As on 13.05.2021, 7733 Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) are functional across the country in 36 State/UTs covering all districts of the country. 1449 medicines and 204 surgical & consumables are available in the basket of PMBJP for sale through these PMBJKs. Essential medicines and other items like face masks and sanitizers are easily available at PMBJKs, across the country. Under PMBJP, the best quality N-95 facemask is being made available at only Rs. 25/- per unit at all PMBJKs.

In the current financial year 2021-22 till 13.05.2021, BPPI has

made sales of Rs. 80.18 Crore which led to savings of approximately Rs. 500 Cr. to the citizens.

The logistics system is being strengthened. At present three modern warehouses at Gurugram, Guwahati and Chennai for storage and distribution of drugs are functional and a fourth one is under construction at Surat. Further, 37 distributors have been appointed across the country to support the supply of medicines to remote and rural areas.

In the year 2020-21, when the COVID 19 crisis started, Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) rendered essential services to the nation. The stores remained functional during lockdown and maintained operations as part of their commitment to ensure uninterrupted availability of essential medicines.

A medicine under PMBJP is priced on the principle of a maximum of 50% of the average

price of top three branded medicines. Therefore, the price of Jan Aushadhi Medicines is cheaper at least by 50% and in some cases, by 80% to 90% of the market price of branded medicines.

In the financial year 2020-21, BPPI clocked appreciable sales turnover of Rs. 665.83 crore despite the lock down and testing times. This has led to savings of approximately Rs. 4000 crores of the common citizens of the country. BPPI maintained adequate stock of the medicines which were in demand, such as Face Mask, Hydroxychloroquine, Paracetamol and Azithromycin. BPPI sold about 25 lacs Face Masks, 1.25 lacs units of sanitizers, 137 lacs tablets of Hydroxychloroquine and 323 lacs Paracetamol Tablets in the financial year 2020-21 through more than 7500 Jan Aushadhi kendras functioning across the country, at affordable prices.



BPPI has also supplied drugs worth Rs 30 crore to the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) for distribution to friendly countries.

There are many medicines and OTC items, being used during the treatment of COVID 19, available in the PMBJP basket.

Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya

JanAushadhi Pariyojana added several Nutraceutical products to help boost the immunity of all (including women and children).

PMBJP prices of all these products are 50%-90% lesser than the ones offered in the market. Last year, during the lockdown period, Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras

rendered their essential services by making available quality generic medicines at affordable prices to the common citizens of the country at their doorstep. Kendra pharmacists, popularly known as "Swasth Ke Sipahi" delivered the medicines to patients and elderly people at their doorstep.

Nearly 18 crore COVID vaccine doses administered in the country so far

New Delhi, May 14

India has administered nearly 18 crore COVID vaccine doses. With over 20 lakh 27 thousand vaccine jabs given in the last 24 hours, the nation has successfully administered nearly 17 crore 93 lakh doses so far. Till now over 4 crore 5 lakh people in the country have been vaccinated with both the doses while nearly 13 crore 88 lakh have been administered the first dose.

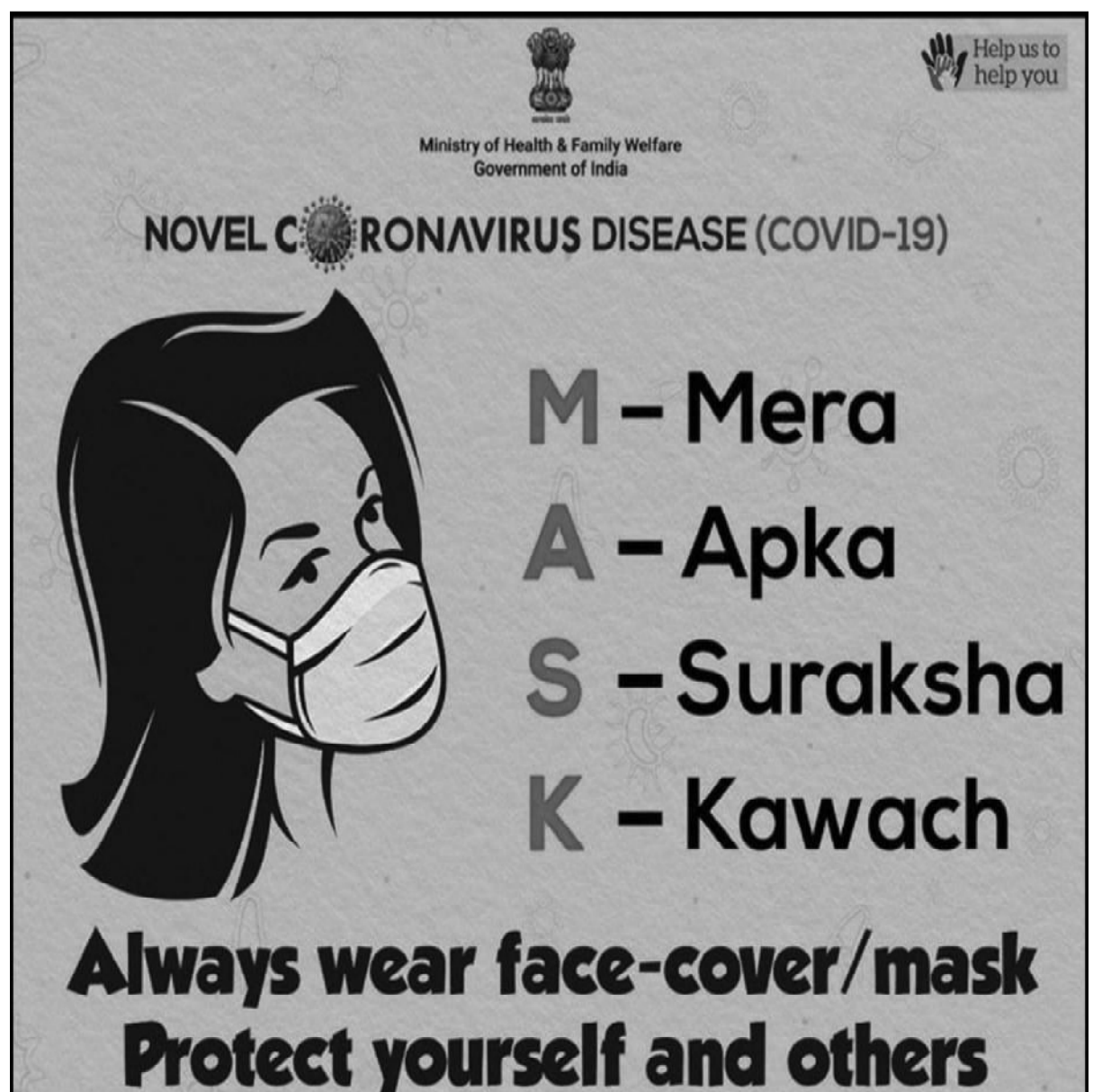
The Health Ministry has informed that with over 4 lakh 37 thousand vaccine doses administered to people in the age group of 18 to 44 years in the past 24 hours, so far nearly 39 lakh 14 thousand doses have been administered to beneficiaries in this age group. It added that the vaccination process is being regularly reviewed and monitored at the highest levels to continue fortifying its usage as a tool to



protect the most vulnerable population groups in the country from COVID-19. India's Cumulative Vaccination Coverage steadily nearing the 18 Crore mark. Over 17 crore 91 lakh Covid-19 vaccines have been administered in the country so far. Health Ministry said, on the 118th day of the vaccination drive yesterday over 19 lakh 75 thousand vaccine doses were given. Over 4 lakh 37 thousand beneficiaries of the age group 18-

44 years received their first dose of COVID vaccine today.

Till now over 39 lakh 14 thousand beneficiaries of the age group across 32 States and Union Territories have received vaccine since the start of Phase-3 of the vaccination drive. Over 1 crore 62 lakh doses of vaccines administered to Health Care Workers and Over 2 crore 24 lakh doses of vaccines have been administered to Front Line Workers so far. (Source: india.gov.in)
