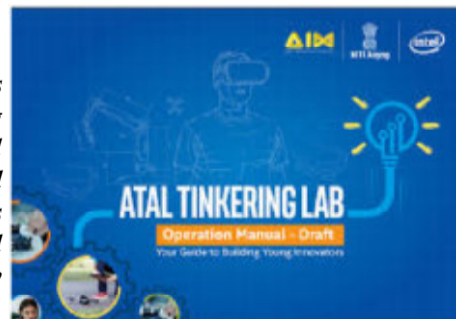

Virat Kohli receives Polly Umrigar Trophy at annual BCCI awards

Mumbai, Jun 13
He is not a part of the historic one-off Test match against Afghanistan but India captain Virat Kohli was the star attraction at the BCCI Annual Awards function on Tuesday as he received the prestigious Polly Umrigar Trophy (Cricketer of the Year) award for two consecutive seasons. The Indian skipper, who has been in prolific form, received the award for his stupendous performance during the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons. He is currently undergoing rehabilitation for a neck injury sustained during the IPL, which ruled him out of his much debated County assignment for Surrey. Kohli is expected to appear for a fitness test at the NCA on June 15. The Awards function was also attended by the Afghanistan national team which will take



on India in their first ever Test match, starting Thursday. Anshuman Gaekwad and Sudha Shah received the CK Nayudu Lifetime Achievement award. The domestic cricketers got their due recognition as Jalaj Saxena, Parvez Rasool, Krunal Pandya were all feted for their consistent domestic

performances. Jalaj and Rasool were adjudged 'Best All Rounders' in Ranji Trophy while Krunal was rewarded for his performance in the Hazare one-day championship. However, Krunal did not turn up to receive the award as he is on national duty with the India A team.

New Delhi, June 13
Ten-year-old Rishi Tej of Karnataka and 11-year-old Nathania John K. of Tamil Nadu will be two of the Official Match Ball Carriers (OMBC) at the upcoming FIFA World Cup in Russia. One of them will carry the match ball during the Belgium vs Panama game while the other will get a chance to get onto the pitch before the Brazil vs Costa Rica match. India captain Sunil Chhetri conducted the trials — as part of the Kia Official Match Ball Carrier (OMBC) programme — in Gurugram last month. As many as 1600 children participated in the programme, with 50 short-listed for the final selections.



Gavit Murali Kumar bags gold in men's 10,000 metre race at Gouden Spike meeting

Leiden, Jun 13
Young long distance runner Gavit Murali Kumar bagged a gold in men's 10,000 metre race at the Gouden Spike meeting in Leiden, The Netherlands. The 21-year-old Kumar, hailing from Gujarat, clocked a personal best of 28 minutes 43.34 seconds.



It was the best by an Indian in the ongoing season. It was also the second fastest time by an Indian ever in the distance race, just short of long-distance coach Surendra Singh's national

record of 28 minutes 02.89 seconds set at Vigo, Spain in 2008. The Gouden Spike is one of the top meetings in The Netherlands. Its current European Athletics status is Outdoor Meetings with

National Permit. Meanwhile, Indian athletes continued their preparations by taking part in various competitions during their training-cum-exposure tour of Europe.

Women's hockey: Spain beat India by 3-0 in the opening game

Madrid, Jun 13
The Indian Women's Hockey team lost its opening game of the five-match bilateral series against Spain, 0-3 in Madrid last night. The Indian eves put up a spirited performance but failed to recover from Carlota Petchame's early strike. Lola Riera, then, scored a brace to seal the game for the hosts and give them a 1-0 lead in the series.



The tournament is part of Rani Rampal-led Indian team's preparations for the World Cup which will be played in London on the 21st of next month.

Shubhankar Sharma, India's premier golfer, ready for US Open challenge

Chandigarh, June 13
Shubhankar Sharma can do little wrong these days. After the Augusta Masters and a berth in the British Open confirmed, Shubhankar added yet another feather to his cap by qualifying for the US Open. This caps the 21-year-old's fine-run, which started with him winning in the Maybank Open in Malaysia, where a stunning

final round saw him clinch the title. In a way, Shubhankar has managed to accelerate and move with such finesse that it has only cemented his position as the next talent to watch out for. As the US Open starting June 14 to 17 draws close, Shubhankar seemed gung-ho about his chances relying on his mental toughness and fearless approach to the game.

"Per se there has been no major changes to my game. But, yes, I have moved on with my game. Equipment has become more precise and suitable to my game, thanks to my friend and tech adviser Gurbaz Mann. Of course, the experience of playing in US and on the PGA Tour also helped," Shubhankar said, on the eve of his second golf Major.

Lowly-ranked Russia, Saudi Arabia meet to kick off FIFA World Cup 2018

Moscow, June 13
The FIFA World Cup 2018 is set to start and finish with games at the opposite ends of the spectrum. The lowest-ranked teams at the tournament will meet in the opener on Thursday when Russia host Saudi Arabia at Luzhniki Stadium in Moscow, which is also the venue for the July 15 final. The No. 70-ranked Russians got an automatic spot as tournament host and the Saudis, at No. 67, have the lowest ranking of the 31 countries which secured places via qualifying. They're the longest of long shots to reach the final. The home team will likely need to win to



have a realistic hope of advancing from Group A, and is expected to have Russian President Vladimir Putin in the crowd for support as it bids to

end a winless streak of seven games. Only one World Cup host nation has failed to get past the group stage — South Africa in 2010.

Suarez who could cause major problems for the Russia and Saudi defenses. The Saudis lost their last three games but remain upbeat at their first World Cup appearance for 12 years. Juan Antonio Pizzi and Russia's Stanislav Cherchesov bring very different personalities and coaching tactics to the tournament. Pizzi won the 2016 Copa America title with Chile using an all-action style with constant pressure on the opposition. He'll struggle to replicate that with a Saudi team he took over after it had qualified for the World Cup.

Boxing: India bag 1-Gold, 2-Silver medals at Umakhanov Memorial Tournament

Kaspiysk, June 13
Indian boxers bagged one Gold and two Silver medals at the Umakhanov Memorial Tournament in the Russian city of Kaspiysk yesterday. Saweety Boora won the coveted yellow metal in the Women's 75 kg category after beating local favourite Anna Anfinogenova in the Final. In the Men's section, Brijesh Yadav in the 81 kg division and Virender Kumar in 91 kgs lost



their Final bouts to settle for Silver medals. Earlier, India had claimed four Bronze medals in the Tournament.

Govt approves revision of carpet area of houses eligible for interest subsidy under PMA

New Delhi, Jun 13
The Government has approved a 33 per cent increase in carpet area of houses eligible for interest subsidy under its affordable housing scheme Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) to attract more beneficiaries. The carpet area of a house has been enhanced to 160 square metres from 120 square metres for Middle Income Group-1, while it has been increased to 200 square metres from 150 square metres in case of Middle Income Group-2. The new rules will be effective from 1st of January, 2017, the date on which the scheme became operational. The enhancements will now enable more Middle Income Group customers to qualify

for subsidy and avail the benefits provided under the flagship mission of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban. Apart from increasing the number of beneficiaries, the enhancement in carpet area will increase the construction activity and will give a push to housing sector. Under the Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme, each beneficiary can avail subsidy up to two lakh 35 thousand on purchase of a house under the scheme.

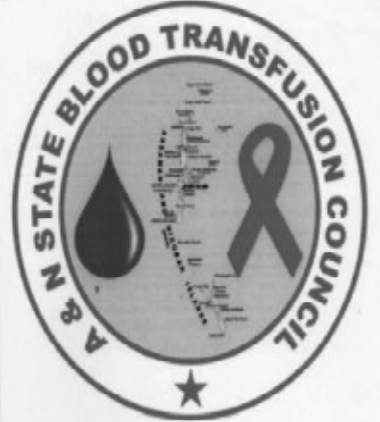
