Indian diaspora in Singapore represents diversity of India: PM Narendra Modi

Singapore, May 31
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said, Indian diaspora in Singapore represents diversity of India. He was addressing the Indian business and community event at Marina Bay Sands Convention Centre in the South East Asian country today.

The Prime Minister said, Indian community has become part of Singapore's progress. He said, when India opened up to the world and turned to the East, Singapore became a partner and a bridge between India and ASEAN. He said, the success of Singapore lies in its multi-cultural society. Shri Modi said, relations between



India and Singapore are among the warmest and closest. He described it as a natural partnership from a shared vision. He said, defence relation between the two countries are strongest, for both.

The Prime Minister said, in India, the present situation is changing rapidly and a new India is taking shape. He said, rapid growth is taking place in the Infrastructure sector. Earlier, Shri Modi

inaugurated the India-Singapore Enterprise and Innovation Exhibition at Marina Bay Sands Convention Centre. Thirty companies from India and Singapore are taking part in the day-long event that

displays products related to health care, digital payments, pharmaceuticals and manufacturing. The exhibition of start-ups and innovations was organised by Indian High Commission in Singapore. The Prime Minister also witnessed a dance and yoga presentation. The performance titled "Anushasanam" depicted the benefits of the practice of yoga. During this visit, Shri Modi will hold delegation level talks with his Singaporean counterpart Lee Hsien Loong, and deliver the keynote address tomorrow at the 17th Shangri La Dialogue.

India releases Rs 33.10 Cr to Nepal for 2 road Projects

New Delhi, May 31
India has released Rs. 33.10 Crore to Nepal towards cost of two road packages of Birgunj-Thori Road being implemented under Postal Highway Projects in Nepal with Government of India's grant assistance. Deputy Chief of Mission in the Indian Embassy, Dr. Ajay Kumar handed over a Cheque of the grant to Secretary, Ministry for Physical Infrastructure and Transport, Nepal,

Madhusudan Adhikari Kathmandu on Tuesday. The amount has been released towards 25% of tendered cost (including 10% mobilization advance) of the Postal Highway Projects. The Government of India has so far released a total of 117.63 Crore rupees to the Government of Nepal for implementing 14 packages of the Postal Highway Projects. The construction of Dhangadhi-Bhajaniya-Satti road and

Lamki-Tikapur-Khakraula road has been completed. Since 1950, the Government of India has been supporting infrastructure development of Nepal and has provided financial assistance for construction of various Highways, Roads, Bridges, Airports, etc. as part of its multi-sectoral and multi-dimensional India-Nepal Economic Cooperation Programme.

Govt to launch first ever guidelines for Adventure Tourism

New Delhi, May 31
The Government is for the first time issuing guidelines for Adventure Tourism in India. These guidelines have been launched by the Tourism Minister K. J. Alphons in New Delhi today.



The guidelines on Safety and Quality Norms for Adventure Tourism in India have been formulated along with the Adventure Tour Operators Association of India. In an effort to make adventure sports safer, the set of guidelines list out the basic minimum standards required for adventure

tourism activities in India. Adventure tourism has grown rapidly over the past few years playing a vital role in the economic growth of India as well as attracting a large number of travellers from across the globe to the country. The aim of this initiative is to help adventure tour

operators understand and execute safety guidelines in a better manner. These guidelines cover land, air and water based activities which include mountaineering, trekking, bungee jumping, paragliding, kayaking, scuba diving, snorkeling, river rafting and many other sports.

Hockey India on Thursday announced the 18-member Indian Men's Team which will take part in the final edition of the prestigious Rabobank Men's Hockey Champions Trophy Breda 2018 in the Netherlands starting June 23. The team will be led by ace goalkeeper PR Sreejesh under whose captaincy the Indian team created history in the previous edition by clinching silver after a tense final encounter with World No.1 Australia. It was India's first podium finish at the Champions Trophy in 34 years. Sreejesh will be joined by youngster Krishan Pathak as goalkeeper while India's defence will see the experienced Birendra Lakra make a comeback into the squad. He will be joined by drag-flickers Harmanpreet Singh, Varun Kumar and Amit



Rohidas along with Surrender Kumar and debut player Jarmanpreet Singh who earned a place in the core group after a stupendous domestic season. India's midfield will be formed by stalwart Sardar Singh, Manpreet Singh, Chinglensana Singh Kangujam and the talented Vivek Sagar Prasad. The

forward line will feature SV Sunil, Ramandeep Singh, Akashdeep Singh, Mandeep Singh, Dilpreet Singh and Sumit Kumar (Jr). "The team is a good mix of youth and experienced players. Rabobank Men's Hockey Champions Trophy Breda 2018 is an extremely important tournament for the players to showcase their

5-7 6-4 win in the opening round of the clay court Grand Slam. They next face second seeds Oliver Marach and Mate Pavic. Another Indian in the second round is Rohan Bopanna, with his partner Edouard Roger-Vasselin. The 13th seeded Indo-French pair are up against local team of Benjamin Bonzi and Gregoire Jacq.

India seek winning start in Intercontinental Cup against Chinese Taipei

Mumbai, May 31

A fairly impressive AFC Asian Cup qualifying campaign being the confidence-booster, the Indian football team begins its preparations for the continental showpiece by taking on Chinese Taipei in the lung-opener of the Intercontinental Cup here on Friday. The four-nation tournament, with teams from three separate continents -- Chinese Taipei, Kenya and New Zealand -- apart from the hosts, was conceptualised to test the Indian team ahead of the Asian Cup to be held in the four cities of the UAE from January 5 and February 1. The Stephen Constantine-coached side has come into this tournament after a 13-match unbeaten streak from June 2016 to March this year. The team booked a berth for the Asian Cup in October 2017 with two matches left to be played. India will enter Friday's



match with a psychological advantage as they are the highest ranked side at 97th, besides also having an impressive head-to-head record against the East Asians. India have beaten Chinese Taipei thrice while drawing once in the past decade. Friday's match at Mumbai Football Arena at Andheri will also see star striker Sunil Chhetri inch towards the milestone of 100 matches for the country. He will be playing his

99th international match in India jersey. "I am not one for records as teams and players change all the time and they (Chinese Taipei) will be coming to try and beat us. Under Gray White, they have improved and will be very organised. We will show them the respect they deserve, but of course winning the game is our aim," he said. Chhetri said the "desire to win among the players is 100 percent".

Teams touring India will play practice games against Afghanistan: BCCI

Kabul, May 31

All international teams touring India will now play one practice game against Afghanistan, an arrangement which will constantly provide international exposure to the team from strife-torn nation. The announcement was made by BCCI acting secretary Amitabh Choudhary during his visit here, per Afghanistan Cricket Board (ACB). Choudhary is in Afghanistan capital to discuss the bilateral cricketing relation between the two countries. India will host Afghanistan in their historic first-ever Test match in Bengaluru from June 14-18.



Choudhary said it will be a vital addition as it will help increase the morale and also upgrade the skills of players. "Cricket will further strengthen ties between the two countries and

deliver a message of peace. Afghan players are well known and loved in India because of their participation in IPL which will increase in the coming years," BCCI acting secretary said.
