## PM says poorest of the poor benefited in over 16000 villages in 20 days through Gram Swaraj Abhiyan

New Delhi, May 24 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has expressed happiness that through the Gram Swaraj Abhiyan, the fruits of development was taken to the poorest of the poor in 16,850 villages from the 14th of last month to the 5th of this month as a tribute to Dr BR Ambedkar. In a series of tweets, Shri Modi said, as part of the Abhiyan, various teams ventured across the villages and ensured complete coverage of seven leading central government schemes. The Prime Minister said, during the period, over 20 lakh 53,000 Jan Dhan

### Commendable acts by Tourism Deptt. Officials & staff; 80 year old tourist evacuated from Havelock

Port Blair, May 24 Last Tuesday, Shri Ram Udar Rai, aged about 80 years, while on his visit to Radha Nagar Beach in the evening, met with a cardiac arrest. On seeing the distressed tourist, the Life Guard team of the Tourism Department, A&N Administration under the supervision of Shri Madhavan (In-charge Island camping) swung into action and tendered the Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation on the beach itself. After stabilizing the patient, he was shifted to PHC Havelock, where on examination, the Chief Medical Officer, In-charge, Dr. P.K. Palit advised the patient to be shifted immediately to G.B. Pant Hospital, Port Blair. Since it was evening, the Indian Coast Guard was approached, who promptly deployed their vessel ICGS C-423 and went for evacuation of the patient. Even though facing bad weather in mid sea, the brave men of Indian Coast Guard managed to evacuate the patient from Havelock and brought him safely to Port Blair by 11.05 pm. During the whole operation, commendable work was also done by Shri Rustum Ali, In-charge Dolphin Resort. Mr Rai was admitted to GB Pant Hospital at night and now he is recuperating in ICU. **BCCI mulling mini-IPL for women cricketers despite low turnout in Mumbai exhibition game**

Mumbai, May 24  
The women's T20 challenge might not have provided the kind of "exhibition" that the BCCI was looking for in terms of an in-stadia audience for them to seriously consider a women's IPL in the future. But they haven't given up on the idea yet and the Indian board is learnt to be mulling a mini-IPL of sorts for next year with 3-4 teams expected to be involved. Unlike Tuesday's match, which was played at the Wankhede Stadium on the same day as the first IPL qualifier, the women's matches will instead be held at smaller venues with the hope of attracting bigger crowds. The board is said to be keen on there being some continuity with regards to the promotion of women's cricket in the country. They are, however, looking at seeing how the women's game develops in



an IPL format over the next three years before actually deciding to introduce a women's IPL. Vinod Rai, the CoA chief, had already spoken about there being a possibility to commence the tournament in three years' time. "It's important to have continuity. The exhibition game was just a start. We agree to the fact that we could have planned it better which we will do from next season. There were various reasons for the stadium being near-empty but we are hopeful that slowly the popularity will

increase. That is why we are now mulling a 3-4 team women's league from next year in smaller centres. Smaller cities like Baroda, have seen a great turnout for women's games generally," a BCCI official informed. The biggest issue for the delay faced by the women's IPL being is there not being enough players at the moment to form a necessary pool. The board is also expected to begin identifying a set of players who'll be good enough to play the shortest format at an IPL level.

**Nepal to make ODI debut against the Netherlands**

Kathmandu, May 24  
Nepal will play their first two ODIs against Netherlands on the 1st and 3rd of August, it was revealed today (May 23). The two matches will take place at as-yet-undisclosed venues in the Netherlands immediately following the two nations' T20 tri-series with the MCC at Lords, which is scheduled for the 29th of July. The two sides last met at the World Cup Qualifier in Zimbabwe in March, with the Dutch side winning the seventh-place playoff by 45 runs at Kewkwe, after Nepal had secured ODI status by besting PNG at Harare two days earlier. Though both countries had by

then secured ODI status - Netherlands by sealing the World Cricket League Championship title with a victory over Namibia in Dubai back in December - the match was not an official ODI as the ICC awarded the two sides status only after the conclusion of the tournament. The games will be the first ODIs hosted in the Netherlands since the Dutch welcomed South Africa for a one-off match at the VRA Ground in Amstelveen in May 2013, and will also mark the Netherlands' return to ODI cricket after an absence of almost five years, their last recognised ODI coming against Canada at the World Cup

Qualifier in New Zealand in January 2014, the tournament where they lost their status. Nepal's most recent visit to the Low Countries was in August of 2016, when the two sides shared honours in two List A internationals in the fourth round of the World Cricket League Championship. "We're delighted to welcome Nepal for their first ODIs, and our first ODI on home soil since 2013. After the honour of being invited to play at Lord's, we look forward to showing our home fans what we can do. Nepal are an exciting team as we've all seen from the IPL. Sandeep Lamichanne is a world class player, will be a privilege to have them here.

**French Open 2018: Yuki Bhambri set to make French Open debut**

New Delhi, May 24  
Yuki Bhambri remembers sitting patiently in the stands at the 2008 French Open and watching the opening round mixed doubles match between Mahesh Bhupathi and Leander Paes. The action on court may have been enthralling - given the history between the two former partners - but Bhambri couldn't care less. Seated just behind the chair umpire, equidistant to both Bhupathi and Paes' respective benches, the then 15-year-old had a plan of his own. "I decided that whoever will win, I'd slide to that side of the court and ask for a towel as a memento," he recalls. "Mahesh won that match, and he was kind enough to give me one." Ten years on to this summer, Bhambri will be travelling to the same venue of Roland Garros, this time as a main draw entrant. This will be the second consecutive main draw appearance at a Grand Slam for the 25-year-old, after he rose through the qualifiers at the



Australian Open, and now earned his berth in Paris as a top-100 ranked player. In a career that has been ravaged by injury, this is the first time the world no. 94 will feature in two successive main draws at the majors. "It means a lot, especially after being where I was in 2016," Bhambri says, referring to a tennis elbow injury that saw him miss more than half the season. "After not being able to hold a racquet for six months, I didn't think I was going to play at this level again at that point in time. But being here and being able to play in the Slams is for myself, a big achievement." He's put on a decent run so far this season, and even rose to
