Higher Educational Institutions can now offer Certificate, Diploma and Degree Progs. in full-fledged online mode

New Delhi, May 26
In a landmark reform in the field of Higher Education, University Grants Commission has approved UGC (Online Courses) Regulations, 2018 in its meeting held on May 24, 2018. Higher Educational Institutions can offer Certificate, Diploma and Degree Programmes in full-fledged online mode in only those disciplines in which it has already been offering the same or similar Programmes /Courses at graduation level in regular mode (of classroom

teaching) or in Open and Distance Learning mode and from which at least one batch has been graduated and approved by the statutory councils, as applicable. Online Programmes requiring Practical/ Laboratory Courses as a curricular requirement shall not be permitted. The Examinations shall be conducted in proctored mode and in conformity with any norms for such examinations stipulated by the commission. The online learning shall have

minimum four quadrants: video lectures, e- content, self-assessment and discussion forum to clarify doubts. The Higher Educational Institutions will be eligible to offer Online Programmes if they have been in existence for at least five years and are accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a valid minimum score of 3.26 on a 4-point scale; and should be in the top-100 in overall category in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) for at least two years in the previous three years. However, NAAC and NIRF conditions shall not be applicable to existing government Open Universities till NAAC or similar accreditation system or NIRF are made available. Aadhaar and Passport shall be used to authenticate the Indian and foreign students respectively for all online interactions including teaching-learning and examinations. (Contd. on last page)

Towards garbage free city

PBMC to phase-out plastic carry bags; people urged to use eco-friendly bio-degradable bags

Port Blair, May 26
India is the global host of 'World Environment Day - 2018', this year with the theme 'Beat Plastic Pollution'. The world is coming together to combat single-use plastic pollution on June 5th, 2018. To combat single-use plastic pollution, the Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) will be taking measures towards plastic reduction and segregation of waste at source level, in order to make the Port Blair, a garbage free city.

PBMC is a march to phase-out and replace the plastic carry bags with PBMC bags (Eco friendly & Bio-Degradable) through the involvement and participation of businessmen and general public. In this regard, an interaction-cum-sensitization program will

be organized at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Auditorium of PBMC on May 30 between 10 to 11 am involving all stakeholders for replacement/phasing out of plastic carry bags including the spun bags with an alternative products like cloth bags and biodegradable bags.

On receipt of few complaints from the PDS beneficiaries regarding distribution of sub-standard quality of

fortified wheat flour under Public Distribution System, the Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs randomly collected the samples of wheat flour from the premises of the selected millers M/s Associated Industries, Dollygunj and M/s Jai Kumar General Store and Flour Mill, Rangat and got it tested from the Govt. approved NABI Accredited Laboratory at Kolkata, which revealed that the quality of wheat flour confirms with all the parameters incorporated in various Rules/Regulations framed under the Food Safety and Standard Act, 2006. Virat Kohli, MS Dhoni likely to get BCCI nod to play 100-ball tournament in England

Mumbai, May 26, Top Indian cricketers including skipper Virat Kohli and his predecessor Mahendra Singh Dhoni are likely to get the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) nod to feature in a 100 ball-cricket tournament, slated to be held in England in 2020.

According to a report in the dailymail.co.uk, the BCCI, which doesn't allow its players to play in overseas T20 tournaments to protect their market-leading Indian Premier League, are understood to be considering making an exception for the Hundred because it is played over 100 balls compared to 120. The report further goes on to claim that BCCI's decision to let Indian cricketers take part in the



100-ball tournament would pave the way for negotiations around an IPL franchise in London. "Having Virat Kohli, MS Dhoni, Rohit Sharma and other top Indians playing would be an immense boost for the Hundred in its inaugural year, especially when England's Test players will not be involved." "It would also be a helpful bargaining chip for future negotiations around an IPL franchise in London," the report said. Earlier, the BCCI had given its approval to the women cricketers for participating in the Kia Super League T20, starting in England this summer.

Former champions CSK and SRH lock horns for IPL 2018 trophy

Mumbai, May 26 Nerves will play a big role as two title-hungry outfits, Chennai and Hyderabad look to outdo each other and regain the coveted IPL crown when they square off in what promises to be a humdrum of a summit contest on Sunday.

The winners-take-all T20 final, in front of a capacity crowd at the Wankhede Stadium, will see Chennai, who are gunning for their third IPL crown, take on 2016 winners Hyderabad five days after their first play-off game at the same neutral venue. These two southern rivals met at the bull-ring on May 22 in Qualifier 1 in which Chennai, champions in 2010 and 2011, just about managed to ward off their rivals in a low-scoring thriller after looking down in the

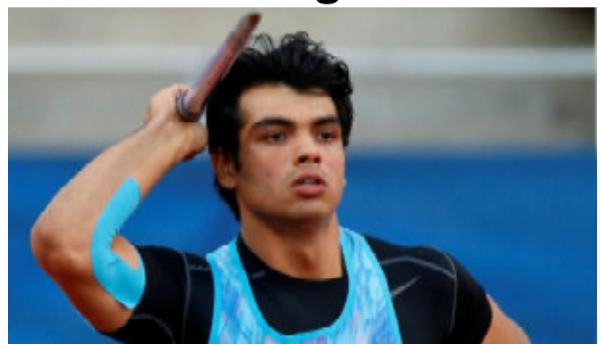


dumps at one stage during the run-chase. That victory, by 2 wickets, enabled Chennai to enter their seventh final in nine attempts directly, while dumping their Hyderabad rivals to their third successive defeat in head-to-head contests this season. SRH had to travel to Kolkata to book their final berth after knocking out two-time former champions Kolkata by 14 runs in Qualifier 2 on Friday night. While Chennai are blessed with a four-day break in between their two games, SRH will be hoping that their winning momentum will help overcome the tiredness of travelling to and from Kolkata and playing their third game, which also happens to be the championship-deciding one, in seven days. Afghanistan leg-spinner Rashid Khan, who came up with a sensational 3 for 19 last night apart from scoring a rapid-fire 34 in ten balls and then taking two catches and effecting a run-out, had troubled CSK with a 2 for 11 burst in the first qualifier.

Neeraj Chopra finishes 6th in Eugene leg of Diamond League

Eugene (US), May 26 Top Indian javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra finished sixth in the Diamond League Series third leg with a below-par effort of 80.81m.

The 20-year-old Indian, the reigning Asian and Commonwealth champion, had shattered his own national record with a throw of 87.43m while finishing fourth in the first leg in Doha last month. But at the Prefontaine Classic, he was not at his best as he had three foul throws. Neeraj began with a 76.95m effort and then came up with 80.81m in the second which turned out to be his best of the



day. He had 80.26m in his third attempt before fouling the final three throws. The top three spots in the eight-man field were expectedly taken by the Germans with the reigning Olympic champion Thomas Rohler unleashing the biggest throw ever witnessed at the venue with a best effort of 89.88m under cool and breezy conditions. Reigning world champion Johannes Vetter took the silver with a best throw of 89.34m while Andreas Hofmann took the third spot with a best effort of 86.45m.

Australia aim to be world's most professional team: Justin Langer

Sydney, May 26 Australia is striving to be the most professional and honest team in world cricket, coach Justin Langer said today as the squad prepares for its first international tour following a damaging ball-tampering scandal.

The former opener recently took the reins during a time of crisis after the 12-month suspensions of ex-captain Steve Smith and his deputy David Warner over the scandal which also saw previous coach Darren Lehmann quit. Speaking to reporters in Brisbane as the team readies



for a five-match one-day international series in England next month, Langer said they were aspiring to a culture of world-best professionalism, honesty and humility. "It doesn't matter how much money you have got or how many games or how many runs. If you're not a good bloke -- that's what people remember," Langer said he recently told the group. "Our mateship is really important. Sticking together is really important -- that's all of us in the Australian cricket team."

Jürgen Klopp praises "brilliant fighter" Zinedine Zidane on eve of Champions League final

Liverpool manager Jürgen Klopp called opposite number Zinedine Zidane "a fighter" before the Champions League final against Real Madrid and praised the Frenchman for his supreme record in Europe's elite competition despite his short coaching career.



Zidane took the leap from coaching Madrid's reserve team to the top job at the Spanish giants in January 2016 and so far has won nine trophies, including back-to-back Champions League wins. "Zidane has been a fighter his entire life, when you grow up where he did in Marseille and had the career you have, you need to be," Klopp told a news conference on Friday. "He was one of the best five players ever, he was such a good player that it looked like he didn't need to fight but he did. "I've been at Liverpool longer than he has been a coach and he could win the Champions League three times in a row, that's never happened before so either he's lucky or he's brilliant, I prefer to think he's brilliant, like he was as a player."

(Contd. from page 1) The learners' engagement will be monitored via participation in asynchronous / synchronous discussions, assignment activity and Programme involvement. The analytics of Learning Management System shall be used for ensuring the learner's participation at least for 2 hours every fortnight. Overall Regulations provide enabling provisions for maintaining sanctity of admissions, teaching-learning, examination, authenticity of the learner and mandatory disclosure of Programme-wise information such as duration, start & end dates, fee, number of students, name of students with identifier, results, on HEI website/public domain. These regulations will be made applicable from the academic session 2018-19. This initiative is a big step towards attaining the targeted GER of 30% by the year 2020.


