PM Shri Narendra Modi holds series of bilateral meetings on the sidelines of G7 Summit in Italy

Apulia, June 14

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi held a series of bilateral meetings on the sidelines of the G7 Summit at Apulia in Italy on Friday. Shri Modi met French President Mr. Emmanuel Macron this afternoon. The two leaders discussed ways to further strengthen partnership including in areas of defence, nuclear, space, education, climate action, digital public infrastructure, critical technologies, connectivity and culture. They also exchanged views on key global and regional issues. They agreed to further intensify strategic defence cooperation with increased focus on 'Make in India'. Both leaders also agreed to expand cooperation in the realms of AI, critical and emerging technologies, energy and sports, while working closely

in context of the France next year. The two leaders also United Nations Oceans Conference to be hosted in global and regional issues.

They emphasized that a strong and trusted Strategic Partnership between India and France is crucial for a stable and prosperous global order and agreed to work closely to make it scale greater heights. Prime Minister extended his best wishes to President Mr. Macron for the forthcoming Paris Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Prime Minister Shri Modi also met his UK counterpart Mr. Rishi Sunak on the sidelines of the G7 Summit.

In a social media post, Shri Modi reiterated his commitment to further strengthen the India-UK Comprehensive Strategic Partnership in the third term of the NDA Government. He said there is great scope to deepen ties in sectors like semiconductors, technology and trade. Both leaders also talked about further cementing ties in the defence sector.

District Administration (N&MA) orders heavy penalty for illegal earth extraction at Diglipur Tehsil

Diglipur, June 14

On the basis of field reports from Tehsildar, Diglipur and team of Revenue Officials, the Deputy Commissioner, N&M Andaman has imposed a significant penalty for the illegal extraction and transportation of 1500 CBM of earth from land, situated at Sitanagar village in Diglipur Tehsil. This activity was carried out without the necessary permissions and is a direct violation of



the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Minor Mineral Rules, 2012.

A detailed report by the Tehsildar, Diglipur, confirmed that the agency illegally extracted

1500 CBM of earth, using the material for construction purposes.

According to Section 201(6) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Land Revenue and Land

Reforms Regulation, 1966, and Rule 34 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012, unauthorized extraction and sale of minerals attract severe penalties. The Tehsildar's assessment confirmed the illegal extraction of 1500 CBM, with a present market value of Rs. 4,50,000/-. Consequently, the penalty assessed at double this value amounts to Rs. 9,00,000/-.



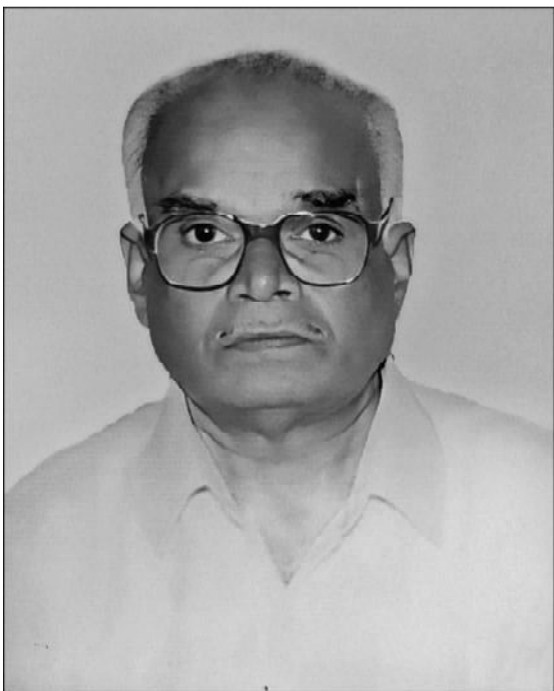

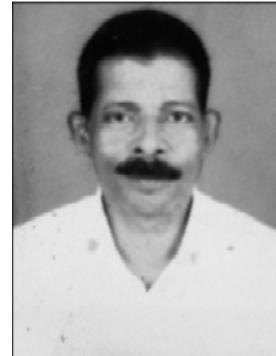
