FM reviews implementation of Insurance Scheme for Health workers fighting COVID 19 announced under PMGKP

Emphasizes need for speedy settlement and benefit reaching out to nominees at the earliest

New Delhi, July 14 (PIB)

The Union Minister of Finance & Corporate Affairs, Smt Nirmala Sitharaman chaired a meeting to review the implementation of Insurance Scheme for Health workers fighting COVID 19 announced under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP) through video conferencing yesterday. The meeting was attended by senior officials from Department of Financial Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and New India Assurance Company Limited.

A presentation was made by the Chairman & Managing Director of New India Assurance providing details about the highlight of the scheme and its status of implementation as on date. Officials from



Ministry of Health & Family Welfare provided an overview of the mechanism being followed with State nodal authorities to expedite the claims, also highlighting the issues being faced while reaching out to the family of deceased as well as obtaining the legal heir certificate.

Of the 147 intimations received till date, claim documents have been submitted for 87, out of which 15 have been paid, 4 approved for payment while 13 are under examination. Further, a total of 55 claims have

been found ineligible out of which 35 claims fall outside the scope of the cover like police personnel, municipal workers not related to hospitals, people from education, revenue departments, etc. while another 20 claims submitted have the cause of death other than COVID-19 like cardiac arrest, etc.

During the meeting, the Finance Minister highlighted the importance for a speedy settlement and emphasized the need of the benefit reaching out to the nominees at the earliest.

New Delhi, July 14

The Union Health Ministry has pushed for an increased expenditure on public health. In a meeting with the 15th Finance Commission, the Union Health Minister, Dr. Harsh Vardhan highlighted that the Government aims at gradually increasing the public health expenditure to 2.5 per cent of the nation's GDP by the year 2025.

The Minister asserted that the outlay for primary health expenditure



will also be made increasing the state's health sector spending to nearly 8 per cent of their total budget. The Health Ministry appraised the Finance Commission of the need to further strengthen the public health sector,

surveillance and public health management, preventive and promotive health care system in the country.

The Health Ministry has also revised its requirement of around 4.9 lakh crores to 6.04 lakh crores in view of the COVID pandemic. It has asked for additional resources for the States which would be utilized for achievement of the National Health Policy targets. (Source: india.gov.in)

Laudable performance by students of A&N Islands in class XII exam

Overall pass percentage stood at 95.06; registers increase of 11.06 % compared to last year

Pass percentage higher than national average of 88.78%

Port Blair, July 14

The result of All India Senior School Certificate Examination 2019-20 (Class XII) was announced on 13th July, 2020. A press release from Education Department, A&N Administration received here today stated that during the academic session 2019-20, 66 Sr. Sec. Schools (including all managements) have registered with CBSE for conducting class XII examination 2020.

During the first level compilation of results of all the 66 schools, out of 3665 candidates appeared in the examination, 3484 candidates have qualified in the examination and 151 candidates have been placed in compartment. The overall pass percentage of class XII standing at 95.06 % is unprecedented with an increase of 11.06% as compared to previous year results of 84%.

The release further said that over the last two decades, the pass percentage has not touched the 90% mark except in 2017-18 which was 90.32%. It is also worth to mention here that the pass percentage of these Islands is 6.28% higher than the national average of 88.78%. Further, as compared to previous year, the schools achieving cent percent results has more than doubled from 10 to 23 schools.

Union Sports Minister interacts with Sports Ministers of 18 states, UTs to plan collaborative roadmap

New Delhi, July 14 (PIB)

Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports, Shri Kiren Rijiju met Ministers as well as Senior Officials of the Youth Affairs and Sports Departments of 18 States and Union Territories through video conferencing today. The meeting was the first part of the two-day conference where all States and UTs will share the roadmap forward for resumption of sports post COVID19 as well as of engaging more volunteers of the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) and National Service Scheme (NSS) to promote various schemes at the State-level.

Addressing the meeting, Shri Rijiju said, "The NYKS and NSS



volunteers have done a commendable job working alongside civil administration during COVID19. There are currently 75 lakh volunteers and we have decided to take that number up to 1 crore in Unlock 2. Prime Minister has already announced Aatma Nirbhar Bharat. As the country opens up, our volunteers will create awareness among all sections of society such as farmers, small business owners and

others, regarding the direct benefits that they can get through being self-reliant. I call upon the States to promote volunteers and support them to work better. They will be working directly with the District Administration with minimal intervention of the Centre." Discussing the points included in the concise agenda, representatives of large number of States lauded the steps taken by the Ministry to promote

grassroot-level sports as well as Olympic-level training in all the States. The setting up of one Khelo India State Centre Excellence (KISCE) in each State and following the One State One Sport policy found favour with States, as Ministers and officials showed keen interest in adopting one sport in which the State has traditionally been strong. Shri Rijiju Said, "Our Ministry will assist and fund the States in the endeavour to achieve excellence in one or two sport. The KISCEs will become the nodal centre for a particular sport where athletes can be groomed at world-class facilities for Olympics. States can also choose to train athletes in other sports, including traditional sports, but the focus should be on one or two disciplines." The

representatives of the States said that setting up of 1000 Khelo India Centers in all Districts across the country will help to not just tap into local talent, but also create a culture of sport in the country. Several States shared their own success stories in promoting grassroot-level sport. The Minister further stated that the participation of States in activities related to the Fit India Movement have been encouraging, with more than 2.5 lakh schools across India enrolling to become Fit India Schools. The Minister added, "I request all State and UT Governments to take active part in including all schools in their States and UTs to register as Fit India Schools so that fitness becomes a way of life for youngsters."

Challenge Track 1 has been launched in the following 8 broad categories viz. Office Productivity & Work from Home, Social Networking, E-Learning, Entertainment, Health & Wellness, Business including Agritech and Fintech, News and Games.

Process for Innovation Challenge:- The Innovation Challenge is available on www.innovate.mygov.in. The last date of submission of entry is 18th July 2020. The applicant needs to apply only online to submit their proposals by registering and logging on MyGov portal: www.mygov.in. Applicants are advised to provide self-contained proposals with essential supporting materials provided as uploads for an informed and fair evaluation/review; no changes will be accepted once proposals are submitted and providing incorrect information will lead to outright rejection of proposals.

The Applicants Proposal/Apps will be evaluated on some parameters such as ease of use, robustness, security features and scalability. There will be a two-stage selection process viz. 1st Stage-Screening of eligible entries and 2nd Stage-Evaluation by Jury, with actual Demo.

The selection process will consist of jury with experts from Private Sector & Academia will evaluate; shortlisted Apps will be awarded & put on Leader boards and Government will adopt suitable Apps & guide them to maturity.

The Innovation Challenge is available on www.innovate.mygov.in/app-challenge from 4th July, 2020. Screening of entries received will be done from 20th to 24th July, 2020. Evaluation by the Jury will be done from 27th July to 3rd August, 2020 and final announcement will be made on 7th August, 2020.






