ISRO scripts history by launching 104 satellites in a single flight

President, VP & PM congratulate scientists on the great feat by ISRO

Sriharikota, Feb 15

The Indian Space Research Organization has scripted history today as it launched a record 104 satellites in one go on board a single rocket PSLV from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota.

President, Shri Pranab Mukerjee has tweeted his congratulations on the great feat by the ISRO. In a tweet the President said, "This day shall go down as a landmark in the history of our space programme".

The Vice President of India, Shri M. Hamid Ansari in his congratulatory message said, the flawless launch underlined the efforts to make the use and exploration of space more accessible and affordable.



Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi while congratulating the scientists, said, this remarkable feat by ISRO is yet another proud moment for our space scientific community and the nation. India salutes our scientists, he added. The 39th mission

of ISRO PSLV-C37 was successful as it placed the 104 satellites in the orbit. Of the 104 satellites, 101 satellites were from international clients. Of these-96 belong to USA, 5 from International customers of ISRO - Israel, Kazakhstan, Netherlands,

Switzerland, United Arab Emirates, respectively. Two other Indian nano satellites INS-1A and INS-1B were also placed in orbit. India now surpasses the record of Russian Space Agency which had earlier launched 37 satellites in one go.

UTLBC meeting held

CS urges banks to improve performances to achieve set targets

The Union Territory Level Bankers' Committee (UTLBC) meeting, which was held in the conference hall of Megapode Resort here today, reviewed and discussed the performances and progress made by banks during the quarter ending December 31, 2016. These included credit disbursement position for priority/non priority sector, outstanding advances, progress under education and housing loan and the recovery position during the last quarter. Matters regarding implementation of centrally sponsored schemes such as PMEGP, KCC, GCC, SHGs/JLGs were also reviewed and bankers were advised to improve the performances so as to achieve the targets set for the financial year ending March 31, 2017.



Speaking as the chief guest of the meeting, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar

acknowledged the achievements made during the last quarter and said that improvements have been made by banks despite the big challenge of demonetisation during the quarter. This was possible because of the joint efforts made by banks and the Administration in tackling

the situation that arose out of demonetization, in meeting the cash requirements of the Islanders as well as tourists. He said, there has been growth in registration of digital transaction, seeding of Aadhaar and mobile phone numbers with saving bank accounts

despite the great challenge of connectivity. The Chief Secretary urged all banks to improve their performance in achieving the targets.

Police asks scuba & snorkelling operators to take all safety measures for tourists

Port Blair, Feb. 15
The South Andaman police has warned all the scuba, snorkelling and tourist boat operators to take all safety measures for the safety of every tourist and behave properly with them. The advisory has been issued in view of the recent incident that occurred at North Bay, wherein a tourist died, and the frequent instructions being given to the scuba

and snorkelling operators, tourist boat operators from time to time, besides conducting meetings with them to sensitize them about the issues. In a press release received here today, the Superintendent of Police, South Andaman, has stated that the service providers have not been following the safety measures besides not behaving properly with tourists, especially ladies.

They have been warned to refrain from such practices. Any violation and negligence would be viewed seriously and stringent legal action would be initiated against the erring scuba instructors and others responsible, which may lead to cancellation of their practice certificate/license for operations and serious legal consequences, the release added.

Usain Bolt, Simone Biles win Laureus Sports person of the year award

Monaco, Feb 15
Sprint king Usain Bolt pipped the likes of Cristiano Ronaldo and LeBron James to win the 'Sportsman of the Year' trophy for the record-equalling fourth time while gymnast Simone Biles clinched the top honour in the women's category at the Laureus World Awards. They are the little and large of sport - while Bolt stands 1.95 metres, Biles measures just 1.45 metres - but they were both giants at the Rio Olympics and enjoyed an ecstatic welcome as they received their statuettes, the birthplace of the first ever Laureus awards 17 years ago.



Bolt, who won this award in 2009, 2010 and 2013, walked away with the 'Oscar of Sports' for the fourth time, joining tennis legends Roger Federer and Serena Williams, and surfer Kelly Slater as four-time Laureus award winner.

Bolt received his award from legendary Michael Johnson, who urged him not to break other people's records. To which Bolt responded by saying, "I am sorry to have broken your record." Olympic gymnastics champion Biles notched up the 'Sportswoman of the Year' trophy, courtesy her brilliant show at the Rio Games, where she finished with four golds and a bronze.

The most decorated Olympian of all-time, Michael Phelps bagged the 'Comeback of the Year' award after returning to the swimming pool and scooping five more gold medals. After the 2012 Olympics, Phelps retired from swimming but came out of the retirement and subsequently at the Rio Games last year, he bagged as many as five gold medals and a silver. In other categories, Italy's Beatrice Vio, the only quadruple amputee in international wheelchair fencing, clinched the disability

award, while the Olympic refugee team, led by Tegla Loroupe, won the Laureus Sport for Good award for sporting inspiration at the function, which was hosted by Hollywood star Hugh Grant. The powerful surf therapy programme 'Waves for Change' bagged the Sports for Good award. The South Africa based project used sport for vulnerable young adults growing up in the country's most violent communities. The world's greatest downhill mountain biker Rachel Atherton won the Action Sports person of

the year, while Leicester City bagged a special Laureus Spirit of Sport award to mark their remarkable achievement by winning English football's premier league. Another historic team performance was Chicago Cubs' first Major League Baseball World Series victory for 108 years. This feat won them Laureus Team of the year award. The winners were chosen by members of the Laureus World Sports Academy. For the first time ever, sports fans had a chance to make their voices heard in a brand new Best Sporting Moment of the Year Award and that honour went to Barcelona Under-12 team.
