MP meets CEO, NTPC 15 MW Power Plant to be set up in South Andaman District

Port Blair, March 15
The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray met Shri AK Garg, Chief Executive Officer, NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Ltd yesterday at NTPC Headquarters, New Delhi to discuss about the setting up of 15 MW Power Plant in South Andaman District to alleviate the power crisis.



The Chief Executive Office, NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Ltd informed that the work for purchase of power through DG sets to deliver 5 MW continuous power supply to the 33 KV Grid of Electricity Department at Chatham Power House, South Andaman has been awarded to M/s Aggreko Energy Rental India Pvt. Ltd, a Pune based company

through competitive bidding. A power supply agreement (PSA) in the matter has been executed with the Electricity Department of A & N Administration and the plant will start generating the power from 3rd April, 2018. The Chief Executive Officer, NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Ltd further informed that the tender for

10 MW power plants at Bamboo flat, South Andaman District has also been floated and the technical evaluation is under process. It is also assured that the successful bidder may be awarded the work during March, 2018 and probably, the plant will be in operational during May, 2018, a communication said.

Lionel Messi breaks Cristiano Ronaldo's record of fastest to 100 Champions League goals

Madrid, Mar 15
Barcelona star forward Lionel Messi on Wednesday surpassed Real Madrid's Cristiano Ronaldo to become the fastest to reach the 100 goal landmark in UEFA Champions League. The Argentinian scored twice against Chelsea at the Nou Camp in the second leg of the Champions League Round of 16 fixture to help his side attain a 3-0 victory against the Antonio Conte's side. With the feat, Messi reached the 100 goal-landmark in just 123 games in the tournament and became only the second player in history to do so. Ronaldo, who broke the record first, took 144 games to reach the mark. He reached the landmark in the quarterfinal of the tournament against Bayern Munich in the previous season. While the Portugal star



continues to be top goalscorer in the European competition, having 117 goals in 155 games, his Barcelona rival is not far behind. Another interesting bit is the fact that both the stars have equal no. of hat-tricks in the competition, seven. While it took Ronaldo 30 matches to get his first goal in the competition, Messi scored his first goal in his fourth appearance. Both the players have also scored 60-all-time group stage goals in the competition. In the ongoing

season, the Real Madrid No. 7 has scored 12 goals in 8 appearances in the Champions League, while Messi has scored 6 goals in 6 appearances. The Barcelona star was at his ultimate best against Chelsea on Wednesday, scoring twice and assisting Ousman Dembele for the third goal. He also scored his fastest goal in the tournament, getting one behind the net in just two minutes and eight seconds of play.

Roger Federer wins at Indian Wells, sets up rematch with Chung Hyeon

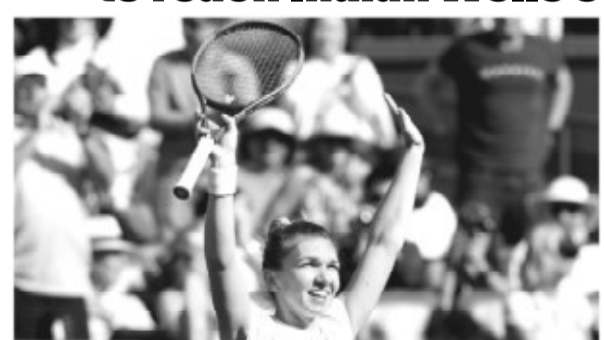
Indian Wells, Mar 15
Roger Federer defeated Jeremy Chardy of France 7-5, 6-4 in the fourth round of the BNP Paribas Open on Wednesday, and at 15-0 the world's top-ranked men's player is off to his best start since 2006. The 36-year-old Swiss superstar can equal his season-best start of 16-0 with a win in the quarterfinals, where he will meet Chung Hyeon of South Korea in a rematch of their Australian Open semifinal. "This might be the last day, so we'll see," Federer said, smiling. "Don't jinx it." He advanced to the final in Melbourne when Chung retired in the second set trailing 6-1, 5-2 because of blisters on his left foot. Federer went on to win a five-set final against Marin Cilic for his 20th Grand Slam



title. Chung, seeded 23rd at Indian Wells, beat 30th-seeded Pablo Cuevas of Uruguay 6-1, 6-3. Since his Grand Slam breakthrough Down Under, Chung has been on a roll. He's reached the quarterfinals or better in four of five tournaments and improved to 15-5 this year. "I was honestly quite surprised how quickly he came back," Federer said. "Because that thing looked nasty and it takes some time to heal. But he seems fine and he played a great

match today. So I'm excited to play against him." Federer is chasing a record sixth title in the desert. "Just playing really fast and good serve, good baseline," Chung said of Federer. "He play everything good, so I'm just trying to enjoy on the court." Against Federer, Chardy played a tough first set in windy conditions that persisted throughout the day. Federer earned the only break in the 11th game and then served a love game to take the set.

Simona Halep edges past Petra Martic to reach Indian Wells semi-finals



Indian Wells, Mar 15
World No. 1 Simona Halep punched her ticket to the Indian Wells semi-finals with a 6-4, 6-7 (5/7), 6-3 win over Croatia's Petra Martic on Wednesday. The 26-year-old Halep improved to 18-1 on the season and is looking to win her second WTA Tour title of 2018. Halep, of Romania, needed two hours and 23 minutes to put Martic away under taxing

conditions as strong winds swirled around the main stadium court. "It was difficult conditions to play in today because of the wind," she said. "It was tough to play, because the ball was really moving. Halep is guaranteed to hold onto her No. 1 ranking at the end of this event after world number two Caroline Wozniacki was eliminated on Tuesday. Halep moves on to the semi-

finals where she will face either Japan's Naomi Osaka or fifth seeded Karolina Pliskova. "I just fought and that's maybe why I won because I refuse to lose." Halep blasted two aces and broke Martic's serve four times. Halep won the final five games of the third set after being broken once and falling behind 3-1 early. The turning point in the third set came for Halep after she won a challenge in the eighth game with Martic holding serve. On the very next point Martic hit a forehand wide as Halep took the game and a 5-3 set lead. Halep then served for the match, winning five of the final six points after the challenge. Halep said her early struggles in the final set were from nerves and frustration with the playing conditions.

Veteran Wasim Jaffer joins elite club with double ton in Irani Cup

Mumbai, Mar 15
When former Indian cricket team opener Wasim Jaffer got past the 160 run mark in the first innings of the Irani Cup match between Vidarbha and the Rest of India in Nagpur on Thursday, he overtook the first-class tallies of batting legends such as Dilip Vengsarkar (17868) and GR Viswanath (17970). Jaffer later went on to score a double hundred. He is now sixth on the list for India's all time leading first-class scorers. He is also the fifth

Indian first-class cricketer to score a double ton after the age of 40. When he scored 250, he became the first Asian cricketer to score 250-plus score after the age of 40. With Vidarbha's captain Faiz Fazal and Sanjay Ramaswamy falling on Day 1 after getting the Ranji Trophy winners to fine start, Jaffer rallied to solidify his team's claim to the title. And in doing so, Jaffer managed to get Vidarbha past 400 run mark just before lunch on Day 2; but more significantly he completed 18,000 runs in first-class cricket, a feat that was

applauded by all present at the Vidarbha Cricket Association Stadium. Jaffer, who turned 40 last month, has always maintained his mettle in the domestic cricketing realms in India since his first-class debut in 1996/97. The most recent of his successes came earlier this year, when under the guidance of Mumbai's coach Chadrakant Pandit, Jaffer lifted the ninth Ranji Trophy title of his career with Vidarbha – a team no one had expected anything from, let alone making their maiden final.

Indian athletes depart for Commonwealth Games

New Delhi, Mar 15
To sharpen their skills further and get acclimatised to the conditions ahead of next month's Commonwealth Games, a four-member Indian athletics team, including star javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra, on Wednesday departed for Gold Coast. National record holder triple jumper Arpinder Singh and long jumpers Nayana James and Neena Varakil also left along with Chopra, the IAAF U20 World Champion. The Indians will camp and train at Super Sports Center in Gold Coast till March 25th before moving to the Commonwealth Games Village. Of the 31-member athletics team selected for CWG, Tejaswin Shankar, Indian record holder in high jump, who is currently training in US will join the Indian team later. Other members of the team will depart in different groups later this week, according to an Athletics Federation of India (AFI) release. "Super Sports Center in Gold Coast has an IAAF approved athletics track. The facility has other required amenities as well which will help our athletes in their training. Reaching Gold Coast in advance will help

athletes acclimatised to the conditions and we hope we will have good results during the Games," Radhakrishnan Nair, deputy chief coach of India said. Meanwhile, a 13-member athletics team departed for the Asian Cross Country Championships, scheduled to be held at Guiyang, China on March 15. Team:

BCCI to have re-examination for Level-I Umpires' test

New Delhi, Mar 15
In the wake of numerous complaints about irregularities in the question paper set for 'Level I Umpires Test', the BCCI has ordered re-examination for the candidates who had appeared on June 10 last year in Indore and Visakhapatnam. The Level 1 examination was held on different dates in two phases. The first test was conducted in Mumbai and Bangalore for umpires hailing from Mumbai, Karnataka and Vidarbha on June 7 while the candidates from North Zone, Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Andhra took the test on June 10 in Indore and Vishakhapatnam. Interestingly,

only one out of 35 candidates passed during the June 10 phase examination, in which the candidates complained that most of the questions were hypothetical in nature. There was a perception that the question paper set on June 7 was of basic nature with 42 percent candidates clearing the examination. "Yes, the BCCI has decided to conduct the re-examination of the June 10 candidates. Only 1 candidate passed and we believe that each and every aspirant should get a fair opportunity to pass the exam. Our endeavour is to provide everyone with a level-playing ground," BCCI acting president CK Khanna told.

Rohit Sharma breaks Yuvraj Singh's record of most sixes by an Indian in T20Is

New Delhi, Mar 15
Rohit Sharma is arguably one of the cleanest strikers of the ball in T20 cricket and on Wednesday, the India opener demonstrated his prowess with the willow as he went on to register the most number of sixes -75- by an Indian in T20 cricket. Sharma blasted his way to the record with the fifth six of his innings against Bangladesh in Colombo, thus eclipsing Yuvraj Singh's tally of 74. Others players featuring on the list are - Suresh Raina (54 sixes), MS Dhoni (46) and Virat Kohli (41). Meanwhile, in the ongoing Indias Trophy tri-series, skipper Rohit's form was a

cause of concern but he put all the doubts to rest with a fine innings of 89 off 61 balls. Sharma is renowned for his six-hitting abilities. Among the batsmen who have hit the most number of sixes in T20I innings for India, Sharma tops the list with 10 maximums. Sharma also holds the record of most number of sixes in a calendar year. While the Mumbaier has slammed 64 of them in 2017, AB De Villiers had hit 63 in 2015. Rohit Sharma has eclipsed Sachin Tendulkar's record of most number of sixes in a year by an Indian. While Tendulkar hit 52 Sharma slammed 56 in 2017.
