Bijapur, Apr 15

Online nominations under INSPIRE awards- MANAK Scheme

Port Blair, April 15
The INSPIRE Awards Programme has been renamed as INSPIRE Awards MANAK (Million Minds Augmenting National Aspiration and Knowledge) to align it with the Action Plan 'Start-up India' initiative launched by the Prime Minister of India. The programme shall target school kids with an outreach to 10 lakh innovations (2-3 best ideas

from each school) from 5 lakh schools across the country. The programme shall cover students in the age group of 10-15 years studying in classes 6-10 of all recognized schools, whether Government or private aided or unaided, run by Central Govt. State Govt., or local bodies viz. District Hoards, etc.

The online system for nomination under revamped inspire award scheme for the year 2018-

19 is already open to all the schools from April 1, 2018. The nomination will remain open till June 30, 2018 and the submission of the project synopsis has now been made mandatory along with submission of online nomination. Surprise inspection conducted in Fair Price Shops FPS licensees cautioned against indulging in unfair trade practices

Port Blair, April 15
The Enforcement Team of the Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs conducted surprise inspections in the Fair Price Shops functioning in South Andaman District during the month of February & March, 2018 and noticed many discrepancies such as failure in display of information regarding category-wise PDS stock of food grains & its retail selling price, non-display of

certificate of stamping issued by the Legal Metrology Wing of the Department, disparity in physical stock compared to ePoS data etc. which attracts violation of various PDS Control Orders framed under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and Rules & Regulations framed under the Legal Metrology Act, 2009.

The Department has taken a serious view of such violation and not satisfied

with the reply furnished by FPS licensee to the Show Cause notice issued to them. However, taking a lenient view being the first offence after switching to new system on implementation of ePDS, warning letters were issued to the offenders directing them to refrain from such offences in future. Further, all the licensees of Fair Price Shops functioning in this UT have been advised not to indulge in any unfair trade practices which may

lead to any type of violation of the PDS Control Orders framed under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and Rules & Regulations framed under the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 failing which strict legal action as deemed fit as per law shall be initiated against the offenders.

The Lt. Governor, A&N Island, Admiral DK Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) led the Islanders in paying rich tributes to the Architect of our Constitution, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar on his 127th Birth Anniversary at a function organized by the A&N Administration at the statue of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, near Ambedkar Auditorium on April 14. The Member of Parliament, Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Anindo Majumdar, DGP, Smti. Nuzhat Hassan, Adhyaksha, ZPSA, Smti. Baby Fareeda, other Senior Officers of the Administration, PRI Members, PBMC Councillors and general public also attended the programme.

The Lt. Governor offered floral tributes at the statue of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar followed by floral tributes by the Member of Parliament, Chief Secretary, DGP, other dignitaries and citizens.

Addressing the gathering, the Lt. Governor remarked that Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was an accomplished jurist, economist, politician and a social reformer whose life has been a quest for equality and justice. He devoted his life and efforts towards bringing a positive difference in the lives of the poor, marginalized and the lesser privileged. Multifaceted and multi-talented that he was, Dr. Ambedkar left behind his marks on various domains, said the Lt. Governor adding that his views will continue to remain a source of motivation and propel us to do more for socio-economic empowerment, to take our nation towards greater heights.

His caution while our Constitution became operative was that "at one



stroke, we will have equality in Political domain but the same may not apply to social and economic domain with such ease. In Politics, we will be recognizing the principle of one man, one vote and one value, one value. In our social and economic life, we shall by our social and economic structure continue to deny the principle of one man, one value. And if it is denied for long, we will be doing so only by putting our political democracy at peril".

This very thought remains a touchstone for assessing our development process and progress, every time, awakening us from our slumber and invigorating us towards harder work as a community to attain higher societal goals, said the Lt. Governor.

The Lt. Governor further remarked that Dr. Ambedkar was a nationalist to the core. He wanted our loyalty as Indians to be effective and to rise above any

competitive loyalty, whether these loyalties arises out of religion, of our culture or out of our language. He wanted all people to be Indian first, Indian last and nothing else but Indians.

The Lt. Governor congratulated the Prime Minister for dedicating Dr. Ambedkar National Memorial at Delhi to the nation on April 13, where Baba Saheb's life and works will be showcased through (Contd. on last page)

PBMC to privatize sanitation works; proposals invited Ward No: 19 to be taken up as pilot project

Port Blair, April 15

The Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) has invited sealed proposals for providing Services of door to door collection, secondary storage and transportation of Municipal Solid Waste for Ward No.: 19 of PBMC. This is a first of kind in Port Blair as well as in A&N Islands that, the sanitation work has been privatizing. The PBMC has passed a resolution recently for privatizing Ward No: 19 for sanitation work. Firstly one ward will be selected to carry out the sanitation work through private agency as a pilot project. After its examination and observations, further extension of the project as well as the implementation to other wards will be carried out.

For participating in the Request for Proposal (RFP), the bid security

amount is kept as Rs. 2,00,000 and the contract is initially for a period of 3 years. The RFP has been uploaded in the National Portal of NIUA, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, GoI, i.e., SMARTNET. Indian competitors end their campaign at 21st CWG with 26 Gold, 20 Silver & 20 Bronze medals

Gold Coast, Apr 15

Indian competitors have ended their campaign at the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, with 26 Gold, 20 Silver and as many Bronze medals.

On the final day today, India won seven medals which include one Gold, Four Silver and two Bronze. The lone Gold came in women's singles badminton, in which star shuttlers P V Sindhu and Saina Nehwal were pitted against each other in the final. In a match that started on equal footing, Saina's aggression and intensity quite literally wilted her compatriot. Saina won the high-pressure match in straight games 21-18, 23-21 that lasted an hour.

Saina had earlier claimed the singles Gold in the 2010 Delhi Games also.

However, in men's singles final, world No.1 Srikanth let slip a strong start to lose in three games to Malaysian icon Lee Chong Wei, who claimed his third individual gold in Commonwealth Games.

Srikanth settled for the Silver. In Men's doubles also, Satwik Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty claimed a Silver losing to English pair of Marcus Ellis and Chris Langridge.

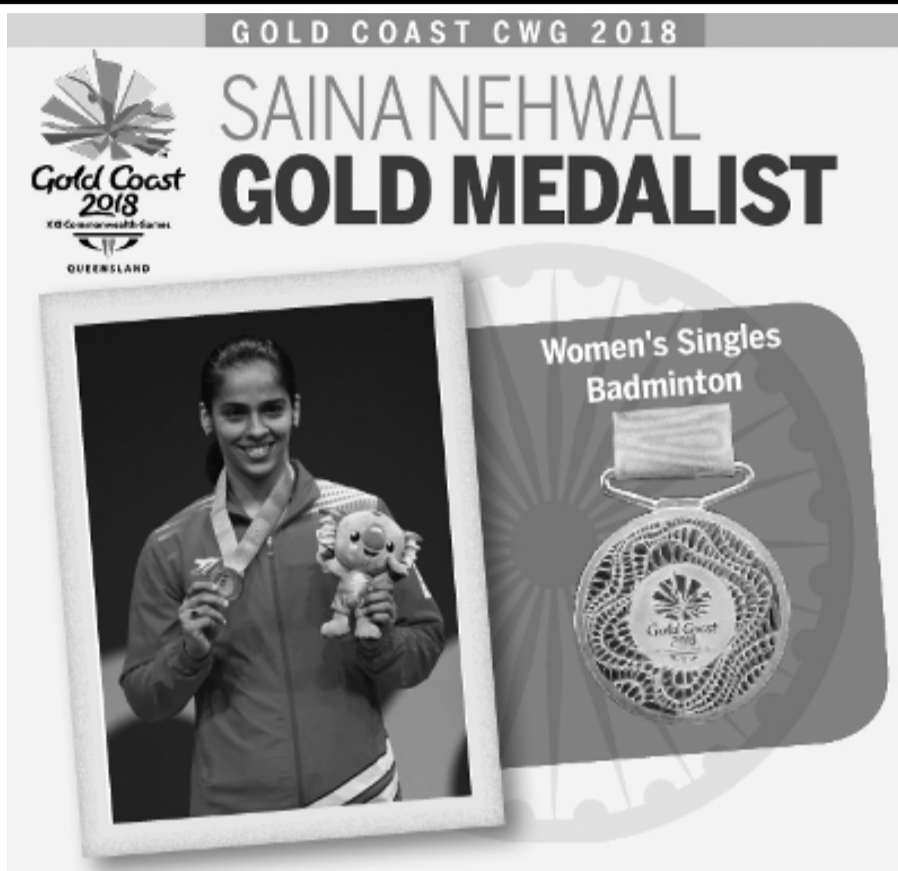
Another Silver came in squash competition when the duo of Dipika Pallikal Karthik and Joshna Chinappa lost to Joelle King and Landers-Murphy of New Zealand in women's doubles final.

The two Bronze medals were won in Table Tennis. In an all-India affair, Manika Batra and Sathiyam Gnanasekaran beat Achanta Sharath Kamal and Mouma Das in three games in the mixed doubles match. In Men's singles, Achanta Sharath Kamal defeated Samuel Walker of England for the second Bronze.

In the overall analysis, the Indian contingent will return with 66 medals, just two medals more than the total of 64 they won in the last Games held in 2014 at Glasgow. But the Gold medal tally of 26 this time is significantly higher than the figure of 15 won in the last edition.

Eleven days after spectacular opening, the Games conclude with the Closing Ceremony which is expected to be a fitting tribute to the remarkable athletic feats, extraordinary teamwork and community participation. Veteran Boxer M C Mary Kom, who claimed a Gold on debut at the Commonwealth Games, is to be India's flag-bearer at the closing ceremony.



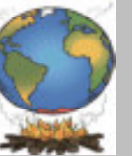
