Financial assistance scheme for Nicobari ST patients requiring medical treatment

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 15

The Directorate of Tribal Welfare is implementing the A&N Islands Scheme for Providing Financial Assistance to Tribal Patients for Medical Treatment to provide financial support to Nicobari ST patients suffering from serious illnesses and requiring treatment at recognized hospitals in the mainland. Under the scheme, eligible Nicobari ST patients who are referred by the Directorate of Health Services for specialized treatment outside the Islands are provided one-time financial assistance to meet the cost of treatment.

The scheme covers patients suffering from serious diseases such as heart ailments, kidney diseases, cancer, and other major illnesses requiring specialized medical care in mainland hospitals. The financial assistance includes expenditure towards medical investigation, treatment, medicines, and

transportation. The mode of travel, whether by ship or air, will be decided based on the recommendation of the Directorate of Health Services, taking into account the seriousness of the disease and the medical condition of the patient.

Under the scheme, 90% of the estimated cost of treatment and transportation is released as advance financial assistance. The remaining 10% is released after completion of the treatment upon submission of the prescribed documents, including supporting bills and vouchers.

Financial assistance under the scheme is sanctioned by the Secretary (Tribal Welfare), A&N Administration, based on the recommendation of the Director of Health Services, A&N Administration.

SVPMP clears illegal Construction & Demolition Waste dump along roadside from Power House to Megapode stretch
Civic body warns of strict fines for indiscriminate dumping

Sri Vijaya Puram, July 15

An inspection was conducted by the higher authorities of the Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council (SVPMP) today wherein it was found a large quantity of Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste, discarded tyres and other waste materials was seen accumulated along the roadside from Power House to Megapode Junction.

In compliance with the directions, the Senior Sanitary Inspector-I and the concerned Sanitary Inspector of Ward No. 03 carried out a special cleanliness drive along the identified stretch. During the drive, approximately 2 truckloads of Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste were collected and handed over to the Junior Engineer (Road Works)

for reuse in road development works. In addition, discarded tyres and other waste materials were removed and transported for proper disposal, thereby restoring the cleanliness and aesthetics of the area.

SVPMP appeals to all residents, contractors, commercial establishments and the general public not to dump Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste, discarded tyres, construction materials or any other waste on roadsides, public places or open spaces. Such indiscriminate dumping not only spoils the city's appearance visible cleanliness but also causes environmental pollution, obstructs public movement and poses serious health and safety hazards. Any person or

establishment found violating these directions shall be liable for penal action, including the imposition of Environmental Compensation/fines, under the provisions of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2026, relevant Municipal By-laws and other applicable laws.

The Council has urged the general public to cooperate in maintaining a clean and healthy Sri Vijaya Puram by disposing of waste only through authorized collection and disposal systems. Public participation and responsible waste disposal are essential for achieving the objectives of Swachh Bharat Mission and keeping the city clean and sustainable, a press release from SVPMP said.

Awareness prog. on stray dog bite prevention & stray dog management conducted at GPS, Bada Enaka, Nancowrie

The Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services Department, Veterinary Dispensary (VD) Kamorta, conducted an awareness programme on stray dog bite prevention and stray dog management at Government Primary School, Bada Enaka, Nancowrie.

The awareness session was conducted by the Senior Veterinary Officer of VD Kamorta. During the programme, students were educated on the do's and don'ts to be followed when encountering stray dogs and the immediate steps to be taken in the event of a dog bite.



Emphasis was laid on avoiding provocation of dogs, maintaining a safe distance from unfamiliar animals, informing elders immediately after any bite or scratch, thoroughly washing the wound with soap and running water for at least 15 minutes, and seeking prompt medical attention without delay.

A total of 22 participants, including students and teachers, attended the programme. The participants actively interacted during the session, raised relevant questions, and showed keen interest in understanding the preventive measures and safety practices, a press release from Deptt. of AH&VS said.

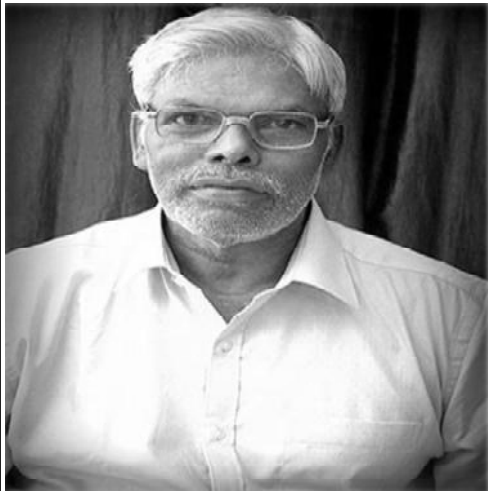
