A sensitive justice system is essential for a capable nation and a harmonious society

New Delhi, Oct. 15 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the inaugural session of All India Conference of Law Ministers and Law Secretaries today via video message. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister noted that the critical meeting of law Ministers and Secretaries of all States in the country is taking place under the grandeur of the Statue of Unity, and it is the inspiration of Sardar Patel that will help us achieve our goals by pointing us in the right direction during this phase of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

The Prime Minister pointed out the need for a dependable and speedy justice system for a healthy and confident society in a developing country like ours. He further added that the judicial system and various procedures



and traditions in every society have been developing according to the needs of the time period. Shri Modi said, "When justice is seen to be delivered, then the faith of the countrymen in the constitutional institutions is strengthened. And when justice is delivered, the confidence of the common man goes up." He further added that such events are very important for the continuous

improvement of the law and order of the country.

The Prime Minister informed that the development journey of Indian society is thousands of years old and we have made steady progress despite facing critical challenges. "The biggest aspect of our society is the tendency to improve itself internally while moving forward on the path of progress", Shri Modi added. Stressing the need for continuous improvement, the Prime Minister pointed out that it is an indispensable requirement for the smooth functioning of every system. "Our society keeps on weeding out irrelevant laws and wrong customs. Otherwise, when any tradition turns into orthodoxy, it turns out to be a burden on society", he added, "The

PM to dedicate 75 Digital Banking Units to nation today

New Delhi, Oct. 15

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will dedicate 75 Digital Banking Units (DBUs) to the nation at 11 AM tomorrow (Oct. 16) through video conferencing. He will also address the gathering on the occasion. As part of the Union budget speech for 2022-23, the Finance Minister had announced the setting up of the 75 DBUs in 75 districts of the country to commemorate the 75 years of independence of the country.

The DBUs are being set up with an objective to ensure benefits of digital banking reach every nook and corner of the country and will cover all the States and

Union Territories. Eleven Public Sector Banks, twelve Private Sector Banks and one Small Finance Bank are participating in the endeavour.

DBUs will have physical outlets which will provide a variety of digital banking facilities to people such as opening of savings account, balance-check, print passbook, transfer of funds, investment in fixed deposits, loan applications, stop-payment instructions for cheques issued, apply for credit or debit cards, view statement of account, pay taxes, pay bills, make nominations, etc.

DBUs will enable customers to have cost-effective, convenient

access and enhanced digital experience of banking products and services all round the year.

They will spread Digital Financial Literacy and special emphasis will be given to customer education on cyber security awareness and safeguards. Also, there shall be adequate digital mechanisms to offer real-time assistance and redress customer grievances arising from business and services offered by the DBUs directly or through Business Facilitators or Correspondents.

As part of this, a programme will be held at Digital Banking Branch of SBI at Port Blair. (Source: india.gov.in)

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, IAS, along with Shri Dilkhush Meena, IAS, Sub-Divisional Magistrate (SA), Shri Radhey Shyam Meena, Director (RD & PRIs) and Tehsildar, Port Blair visited Shaheed Dweep today. The Pramukh, Port Blair Panchayat Samiti, Pradhan and Zilla Parishad Member, Neil Kendra were also present.

During the visit, the DC (SA) inaugurated newly constructed e-Patwarkhana, situated at Neil Kendra village, Shaheed Dweep. The modern e-Patwarkhana consists of e-corner facilities to cater all online services through which the citizen can avail all online services directly. With this, the District Administration, South Andaman has achieved the target of cent percent online services throughout the district. The DC (SA) issued few senior

citizen certificates to the beneficiaries generated on the spot through the e-corner.

The Deputy Commissioner also made field visits to Bharatpur beach and Sitapur sunrise point along with PRIs to check the various issues raised by the PRIs and directed the concerned line Department to resolve the issue at the earliest. The DC (SA) inspected the road towards the Sitapur sunrise point and it was informed by the EE, APWD that the estimate for the road has already been submitted. The PRI members requested DC (SA) to take up the matter with the Forest Department for construction of eco-friendly huts and also a Police Booth at Sitapur.

During the visit to Bharatpur beach, DC (SA) requested the stakeholders to keep the beach neat and clean. He further informed private boat operators to shift the boat anchorage location from the beach area and requested Fisheries Department to identify suitable location for

anchorage of private boats and the same will be resolved. At the Jetty area, the PRI members requested for construction of open canopy sheds and a Police Assistant Booth for the passengers as the frequent arrival of boats creates congestion at the Jetty. In order to resolve the issue, DC (SA) directed the Tourism Officer to put up a proposal for smooth schedule of the boats to reduce the congestion at the Jetty area. DC (SA) also inspected the internal road connecting Bharatpur beach to the Medical and subsequently to the Jetty. Since the road belongs to Zilla Parishad, DC (SA) requested the Zilla Parishad Member to put up the proposal for the road and directed the CEO (ZP) to expedite the work.

The DC (SA) also inspected the land proposed for allotment under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (G) and directed the revenue field functionaries to submit the proposal for allotment on priority.

people of the country should feel neither the absence of Government nor the pressure of the Government."

Throwing light on the special emphasis on removing the pressure of the Government from the citizens of India, the Prime Minister informed that in the last 8 years, India has repealed more than one and a half thousand archaic laws and reduced more than 32 thousand compliances to put an end to the legal hurdles that obstruct the path of innovation and ease of living. "Many of these laws were continuing from the time of slavery", he said. The Prime Minister further added that many old laws from the time of slavery are still in operation in the States and urged the dignitaries present on occasion to make way for the abolition of such laws at this conference. "In this Azadi Ka Amrit Kaal, new laws should be made by abolishing the laws which have been going on from the time of slavery", Shri Modi added. The Prime Minister also pointed towards reviewing the existing laws of the States while focusing on Ease of Living and Ease of Justice for the people.

The Prime Minister noted that the delay in serving justice has come across as the biggest challenge and the judiciary is working with utmost seriousness in this direction. Throwing light on the mechanism of alternative dispute resolution, the Prime Minister suggested that it has been put to good use in the villages of India for a long time and can now be promoted to the State level. "We have to understand how to make it a part of the legal system at the local level in the States", Shri Modi added. The Prime Minister further added that state governments should work with a humane approach regarding undertrial prisoners so that the judicial system moves forward with human ideals. "A sensitive justice system is essential for a capable nation and a harmonious society", Shri Modi added.

"When the judicial system grows along with society, it has a natural tendency to adopt modernity. As a result, the changes that take place in society are also visible through the justice system", Shri Modi said. Putting the spotlight on the integration of technology in the judicial system, the Prime Minister pointed out the emergence of e-courts and virtual hearings and the promotion of e-filings. Shri Modi further added that these systems will get a major boost with the arrival of 5G in the country. "Every State will have to update and upgrade its systems. It should also be an important goal of our legal education to prepare it according to technology", he added.

**India wins Women's T20 Asia Cup defeating Sri Lanka by 8 wickets**



Sylhet, Oct. 15

India have won the Women's Asia Cup 2022 after defeating Sri Lanka by 8 wickets in the Final at Sylhet International Cricket Stadium, Bangladesh. The Women in Blue have defeated the Lankan for the fifth time in an Asia Cup final. This is India's

record seventh Women's Asia Cup title. It turned out to be an easy chase as Smriti Mandhana led the innings with a half-century, scoring an unbeaten 51 off 25 balls. Skipper Harmanpreet Kaur also contributed with 11 not out as India won the game with 69 balls to spare.

Earlier, India restricted Sri Lanka to 65 for 9 in the stipulated 20 overs. Inoka Ranaweera 18 not out was the top-scorer for Sri Lanka. The other batter to cross the double figure was Oshadi Ranasinghe who scored 13 runs. For India, Renuka Singh picked up three wickets.

Liquid Waste Management Centre and inspected its operation, the DC directed the Sanitary Supervisor to coordinate with the agency and to send the packed wastes immediately and to further ensure regular collection of dry waste.
