## Lt. Governor reiterates his commitment towards taking Islands on the path of development

Port Blair, Nov. 15

The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands, Prof. Jagdish Mukhi has said that development of A&N Islands is of paramount importance. Besides developing tourism, basic necessities of the Islanders will be given equal importance, he said. The Lt. Governor was speaking in an interview broadcast over the All India Radio, Port Blair here this morning.

The Lt. Governor said, efforts are on to transform the entire Islands into pollution free Islands. He

said, the current power generation is diesel based, costing around Rs. 750 crores per year besides giving rise to pollution. Hence, it is his priority to make these Islands 100% green energy by Dec 31, 2018.

He said, diesel generated power shall be done away with; while, at present per unit cost of the power consumed is Rs. 18 and the rest are given under subsidy. As a measure to check this, a scheme has been launched, under which, a 100 MW Solar

power plant will be set up here in the Isles, said the Lt. Governor adding that the foundation stone for one solar power project has already been laid and two more will be taken up. "Once all these are set, the entire Islands will be completely changed to solar powered energy", he said.

The Lt. Governor also remarked that the Raj Niwas is the first building in the Islands where power requirement is met 100% through solar powered energy. Accordingly, 13

Government buildings/ Institutions have been identified for installation of roof top solar panels and within a month's time i.e. December end; these buildings will be completely solar powered. Meanwhile, efforts are on to sensitize the public to install roof top solar panel in their respective houses.

The Central Government will provide 70% subsidy and the Administration will make best use of the scheme for the benefit of the Islanders. Accordingly, (Contd. on last page)

### Additional measures for convenience of bank customers

Port Blair, Nov. 15

With a view to widen the existing facilities to exchange/ deposit the specified bank notes and withdraw cash from their accounts, the following additional measures so that member public enjoy as much convenience as possible in availing the facility.

The limit for exchange of Specified Bank Notes, over the counter has been increased from the existing Rs.4000/- to Rs.4500. The weekly limit of Rs.20000/- for withdrawal from bank accounts has been increased to Rs.24000 and the daily limit of Rs.10000/- per day stands withdrawn.

Arrangements will be made for separate queues for senior citizens and divyang (disabled) persons. Similarly, separate queues should also be arranged for those who come to exchange Specified Bank Note (Rs.500/- and Rs.1000/-) for cash and those who come to deposit into bank accounts.

In this regard, it has been decided that banks shall waive levy of ATM charges for all transactions (inclusive of both financial and non-financial transactions) by savings bank customers done at their own banks' ATMs as (Contd. on last page)

## Farmers undergo skill development trainings at mainland



Port Blair, Nov. 15 To create awareness about the latest interventions and for the holistic development of Horticulture, the High Value Agriculture Development Agency (HVADA), Directorate of Agriculture under the Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) - National Horticulture Mission Scheme - Human Resource Development, deputed two group of farmers (21 nos.) and three departmental officials as escorts for undergoing training on 'Organic Farming' and 'Production of High value vegetables crops under Protected conditions' at the Institute of Horticulture Technology (IHT), Greater Noida, New Delhi. The team proceeded on Nov. 10. The trainees will be trained on the skill oriented innovative technologies on organic farming as well as protected cultivation aspects of horticultural crops. This group will be taken to various farms, institutions relating to hi-tech cultivation & organic farming to view the advanced technologies adopted for Horticulture and Agriculture, a communication from the Joint Director (Agri.) HQ said.

## Encouraging organic livestock/ poultry farming at Havelock

Havelock, Nov. 15 Since antibiotic sensitivity, superbugs are the threat to human life, minimum use or non use of antibiotics, chemicals, hormones etc. in animal husbandry practices are recommended for organic production of livestock and poultry by products meant for human consumption. The by-products from the poultry/livestock maintained with home/self made feed, non-use of superfluous antibiotics, chemicals, and growth hormones are considered as organic. Industrial production of such by products with use of excess antibiotic, growth hormones became a current challenge in human.



Keeping this in view, efforts are being taken by the Senior Veterinary Officer, Havelock to encourage farmers for organic way of animal husbandry practices. To make it viable the Veterinary Dispensary, Havelock is keeping vigil on antibiotic use in some of the farm units to demonstrate other

farmers. One such farmer Shri. Madhav Das of Syam Nagar village, Havelock is maintaining poultry and goat units in organic way under the guidance of the Veterinary dispensary and he is earning substantially good income. Only the recommended vaccinations, scheduled deworming in his goat and poultry stock and treatment required with the consultation of Veterinary Dispensary is being followed.

Some farmers are unconcerned in maintaining the farm in hygienic condition, bio security measures and proper health care resultant to which the birds/livestock within the farm develop diseases and they use antibiotic to check mortality without an expert opinion or as instructed by the instructions of the entrepreneurs which is an unhealthy practice and hazardous to the consumers. Farmers involved in animal husbandry activities are hereby suggested to keep contact with the nearest veterinary institution for any disease condition of medium, large scale industries & other big

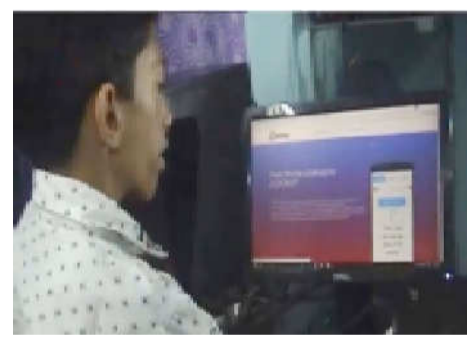

30% will be provided as bank loan, he said. "With this, the entire islands will be made into a green power and the cost of the power will also come down. Around 70 Panchayat Buildings, 24 Councilors, about 35 Zilla Parishad Members and Representatives of different political parties have been identified for this purpose. As many as 200 such identified persons will be asked to compulsorily install solar power roof top panel within a specified time and by March 31, 2018, the vision of turning the entire Islands into green Islands can be achieved.

The Lt. Governor further stated that efforts are also on to study the feasibility of harnessing energy from wind and tidal waves. Accordingly, some companies have been invited to carry out the feasibility study and present their views to the Administration. The Lt. Governor further stated that there would not be a need for conventional energy during rainy season, since power generation will be sufficient, though, it may be less. All such challenges have been taken into consideration already, he said, adding that every solar panel installed in the rooftop will be connected with power grid and consumers can utilize as per their requirements while the unutilized energy will automatically go to the grid and the consumer will be paid accordingly. Thus, the consumer can in turn utilize the saved energy during rainy season through payment. This way, power supply will not be interrupted.

Pertaining to connectivity in Isles, the Lt. Governor said, connectivity issue is quite challenging and the need of the hour is to ensure the availability of proper connectivity in the Islands. The Lt. Governor said, under a scheme, the idea of a submarine cable project was conceived in 2008 and in 2011, the Planning Commission gave its approval but due to some reason, it was not implemented. However, during his recent meeting with the Hon'ble Prime Minister, the Lt. Governor apprised him of the issues pertaining to connectivity and accordingly on September 21, 2016, the Cabinet approval has been obtained. Efforts are also on to pursue the completion of codal formalities by December 31, 2016 and by January 2017, the Optical Fiber Cable Project will be inaugurated, and the project will be completed by December 31, 2018, he said.

The Lt. Governor further stated that proper connectivity is important for Tourism, as tourists visiting these islands would want to remain connected with their family and business in mainland. Hence, there is need to improve connectivity. He said, air connectivity has improved significantly, as five new flights have started their services to Port Blair i.e. two flights from Delhi, Kolkata, and one each from Hyderabad, Mumbai & Bengaluru. This, he said has not only improved connectivity but has brought down the high airfare tariff.

The Lt. Governor said, he has also apprised the Central Government about Veer Savarkar International Airport, which has been declared an international airport by the Govt. but as such, no international flights touches Port Blair. Accordingly, the Lt. Governor has requested the Central Govt. that international flights flying above A&N Islands can have a short stopover at Port Blair. Through this, he said, tourism would automatically improve. Flights going to Phuket can connect Kolkata -Port Blair- Phuket which will improve the flow of business as well as tourism activities here. Opening of new hotels here in isles for high-end tourist will also be considered while low-end tourists are also being welcomed. Construction of Hotel Taj is complete and by March 2017 it will be inaugurated. However, the target of the Administration is to ensure more inflow of tourists and to make these Islands all year round tourism destination. "Low rates hotels are also available here for the tourists besides the Administration is also encouraging Islanders to open up their homes in the form of 'Home Stays' with 'Bed and Breakfast' facility, said the Lt. Governor adding that the concept of 'Home Stay' is picking up slowly here in these Isles too.

Besides tourism, the A&N Islands are also known as 'Water Sports Capital' of India and importance will be given to this sector too, said the Lt. Governor. Adventurous water sports like Scuba Diving, Sea Walk are quite popular among tourists visiting the Islands, said the Lt. Governor adding that efforts will be made to reintroduce seaplane services in the Isles. The Lt. Governor further stated that the Administration is also planning to introduce 'Submarine Scooter', which will be the first of its kind in Isles as well as the country and feasibility study as well as safety aspects are being studied.

The Lt. Governor said, virgin beaches of Isles will also be promoted for tourism activities and five more Islands will be opened for tourists. Neeli Aayog has decided four new places to be opened for tourism development. Ross Island, Smith Island, Long Island and Avis Island are the Islands which will be opened for tourism activities. Subsequently, Port Blair city will be given a facelift through the Smart City Mission, added the Lt. Governor.

The Lt. Governor said, plans are also in the pipeline to construct multi-storied buildings here in Port Blair and elsewhere. As these Islands comes under seismic zone, experts from Japan will be invited to study the feasibility with their technology to develop high rise buildings.

About Education in Isles, the Lt. Governor said, a Central University will be set up in Isles for the benefit of the students. He said Isles' students are quite bright and enthusiastic towards studies. "The blending of sports and education can be seen here in the Isles and it is quite good, because development of talent is necessary, said the Lt. Governor adding that recently opened Sports Academy besides the Law College & Medical College will largely benefit the Islanders.

He said, for quality education, a Central University is necessary which will cater to the educational needs of the Islanders in every aspect. Quality education is important and with the setting up of a Central University, better faculty will be available, thus improving the quality of education here, he said.

The Lt. Governor also reiterated his commitment towards taking the Islands towards the path of further development.

Islands and said, 94% of the total land is forest with umpteen varieties of species, found nowhere in the world.

He also informed that to ease the problem of tourists due to high air fare, 5 news flights have been added connecting to Port Blair. He also said that while high end tourists are being well catered to in A&N Islands, the Administration is also making efforts to ensure extending best facilities to the tourists visiting on LTC. He called upon all countrymen to visit A&N Islands, at least once in a lifetime.

He also thanked the Hon'ble Prime Minister for sanctioning the undersea cable project of Rs 1100 crore for improving connectivity in the Islands, the work for which will be allotted by December 2016 and which will be completed in two years.

The Lt Governor stated that on the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi, the Administration has banned the sale of tobacco in the entire Islands and will further ensure that tobacco consumption is completely stopped, considering the health hazards it poses.

The Lt. Governor informed that the Administration is also committed to bring down the consumption of liquor in the A&N Islands for which a new excise policy is being implemented and other essential steps are also being taken.

About power generation in A&N Islands, the Lt Governor said, target for the islands is 100% green power by December 2018, through alternative sources such as



solar, hydro, wind, waves and LNG. Several steps in this direction have already been taken, under which, solar roof top panels will be installed throughout the Islands. About the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan', the Lt Governor said, he is personally monitoring the project and reiterated that by 31st March 2017, no home in Port Blair and by March 31, 2018, no home in the entire A&N Islands will remain without toilets.

This waiver is applicable on transactions done at ATMs from November 10, 2016 till December 30, 2016, subject to review.

The Reserve Bank assures members of the public that enough cash in small denominations is also available at the Reserve Bank and banks. The Reserve Bank urges that public need not be anxious; need not come over to banks repeatedly to draw and hoard; Cash is available when they need it.

The current account holders (applicable to Current Accounts which are operational for last three months or more) are allowed to withdraw up to Rs.50000 in a week. Such tenders will be disbursed predominantly in Rs.2000 denomination only.

The customers use separate pay-in-slips for depositing specified bank notes and other legal tender bank notes. (If a depositor has a mixed bunch of SBN and legal tender notes, he has to segregate them and submit two separate Pay-in slips.
