

PM to launch Pan India Rollout of COVID-19 Vaccination drive today A&N Islands all set to inoculate 240 Health Care Workers at two sites on inaugural day

Port Blair, Jan. 15
 The Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will launch the pan-India rollout of COVID-19 vaccination drive tomorrow (Jan. 16) at 10.30 am via video conferencing. It will be the world's largest vaccination programme covering the entire length and breadth of the country. A total of 3006 session sites across all States and UTs will be virtually connected during the launch. Around 100 beneficiaries will be vaccinated at each session site on the inaugural day.
 Elaborate arrangements have been made in Andaman and Nicobar Islands where 240 Health Care Workers will be vaccinated in the two sites wherein School of Nursing at GB Pant Hospital will be on live interactive mode and AYUSH Hospital, Junglighat will be on live mode. Team of Doctors, Paramedics and Police personnel have been trained and deputed to handle the entire vaccination

process in each sites. Further, special medical team has been deployed to tackle any Adverse Effect Following Immunization (AEFI). A total of 6500 doses of COVISHIELD Vaccine have been received by the Health Department and the same have been kept under strict vigil in the Cold Storage Room of GB Pant Hospital. Vaccines to other two Districts will be transported soon, to carry out vaccination of COVID warriors in the

1st Phase.
 The COVID vaccine is safe and immunogenic. Two doses of vaccine will be given to every beneficiary. The 2nd dose will be given 28 days after the 1st dose. The effectiveness of the vaccine will begin 2 weeks after taking the 2nd dose. Even after vaccination, the beneficiaries should continue to wear face mask, maintain social distancing and ensure hand and respiratory hygiene.
 The vaccination programme is managed through Co-WIN, an online digital platform developed by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, which will facilitate real time information of vaccine stocks, storage temperature and individualized tracking of beneficiaries for COVID-19 vaccine. This digital platform will assist programme managers across all levels while conducting vaccination sessions, a press release from Directorate of Health Services said.

Administration committed to de-dieselize electricity generation in A&N Islands 4MWp floating solar PV project to be set up on Kalpong reservoir at Diglipur

Project to enable North Andaman Island to become a 'Diesel Free Island'

Port Blair, Jan. 15
 A&N Administration is committed to de-dieselize the electricity production in these Islands and has been taking several steps to shift towards renewable energy generation. This also has been mandated by Government of India and several meeting with Ministry of Power (MoP) and Ministry of New & Renewable Energy (MNRE) have been held both online & offline to fulfill this mandate. In 2019, Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) was directed by MNRE to carry out the process of setting up of 4MWp floating solar PV project with 1 MWhr. /2 MW BESS (peaking



batteries) at Diglipur on Kalpong reservoir in developer mode.

SECI has floated the tender and the lowest bidder was identified as M/s Sun Source Energy Private Limited, Noida through the competitive bidding process and Letter of Award (LOA) has been placed by SECI on the firm. This project has been taken up in PPA mode and the discovered tariff is Rs 6.95 per unit

which is highly competitive. The tariff will be valid for a period of 25 years. The details of the project are as below:

Capacity of the FSSPP	4 MWp + 1 MWhr/ 2 MW BESS
Expected Generation per day	0.01 MU
Expected Annual Generation	3.6 MU
Expected Generation for 25 years	91.25 MU
Expected cost of the project	Rs. 24.00 crores

The Administration is in the process of signing PPA with the developer. The ground work at site is expected to commence immediately after the PPA is signed with the developer. A&N Administration will see the commissioning of this first Floating Solar Power Plant with BESS in 2022-23 and this would enable North Andaman Island to become a 'Diesel Free Island', where already a part of generation is being met by 'Hydro Power Plant', a press release from Electricity Department said.
