## Health Minister asserts Govt's commitment towards improving Access to Quality Education for younger generation Through concerted efforts of Govt., significant increase of 87% in MBBS seats and a massive 105% increase observed in PG seats in last 8 years: Minister

### 22 new AIIMS and projects for up-gradation of 75 Govt. Medical Colleges taken up under PMSSY

New Delhi, Dec. 15 (PIB) "Through concerted efforts of Government, there has been a significant increase of 87% in MBBS seats and a massive 105% increase observed in PG seats in last eight years". Union Health Minister, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya stated that while briefing media, while reiterating the Government's commitment towards bringing a drastic paradigm shift in education in the country. He further emphasised that "Since 2014, several steps have been taken to ease the access to quality education in the country for the younger generation". He underlined the impact of several initiatives taken under the visionary leadership of Hon'ble

Prime Minister. Dr. Mandaviya said that "we can see change happening at every nook and corner of the country." He was also hopeful that with this momentum and coordination among stakeholders, we will be able to create a holistic ecosystem of education in the country. Union Health Minister said that "since the Modi Government came into power, concerted efforts have been taken to train and improve the affordability and accessibility to quality education for our students." Informing about the massive change in the medical education sector, Dr. Mandaviya said that "While India had a limited number of 387 medical colleges in 2014,

the system was riddled with far too many problems. Union Health Minister further stated that "There is a paradigm shift from input-based outcome-based approaches and reforms under Modi Government. Consequentially, we now have 648 medical colleges in 2022 with a whopping 96% increase in the number of Government Medical Colleges (GMC) alone and a 42% increase in the private sector, since 2014. At present, out of 648 medical colleges in the country, 355 are Government and 293 are Private. MBBS seats have also seen a massive 87% increase from 51,348 in 2014 to 96,077 in 2022. Similarly, PG seats have observed an

increase of 105% with 31,185 seats in 2014 to 63,842 in 2022." He said that with a vision to create 10,000 MBBS seats in Government Medical Colleges (GMC), 58 colleges across 16 States have been approved with an increase of 3,877 MBBS seats. Similarly, to increase PG seats, 72 medical colleges in 21 States/ UTs have been approved in phase I, with an increase of 4,058 PG seats. To create 4,000 PG seats in the GMCs, in phase II, a total of 47 colleges have been approved with an increase of 2,975 PG seats. Emphasizing on correcting regional imbalances in the availability of affordable and reliable tertiary healthcare, Pradhan

Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) was launched. The program targets establishment of AIIMS likes institutions and the upgradation of existing GMCs (by establishing super-specialty blocks) in a phased manner. 22 new AIIMS and projects for the up-gradation of 75 Government Medical Colleges were taken up under the scheme. For fair examination and selection process, a common entrance test-National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) for 'one country, one examination, one merit' system was introduced in 2016 with and a common counselling system. This allowed students from anywhere

Family Planning Programme is being implemented in A&N Islands effectively by the Directorate



of Health Services for which different types of contraceptive methods/services are being provided for men and women at Health Centres spread over the Islands by ANM, LHV, Medical

Officers and gynaecologists. Now, Family Planning programme is not only dealing with population stabilization but also promoting reproductive health by reducing maternal, infant & child mortality and morbidity. By reducing rates of unintended pregnancies, family planning also reduces the need for unsafe abortions. A woman's freedom to choose 'when to become pregnant' has a direct impact on her health and well-being as well as the neonate. This is achieved by providing

(Contd. from page 1) launchers under commercial agreement. Dr Jitendra Singh informed that Forex generated through launching of these 177 foreign satellites from January 2018 to November 2022 is approximately 94 million USD and 46 million Euro.

On the subject of Space Reforms, Dr Jitendra Singh said, far-reaching reforms in the sector were announced in June 2020, with an intent to enhance participation of Non-Government Entities [NGEs] in the sector and bring in a commerce-oriented approach to space activities - all steps towards enhancing the nation's share in the global space economy.

The result of these reforms was reflected with the heaviest commercial launch by India in the form of LVM3, carrying 36 OneWeb satellites and the recent suborbital launch by an Indian Private entity - M/s Skyroot Aerospace - which was the first such instance.

Moreover, the creation of IN-SPACe as a single-window agency for the promotion and handholding of Non-Government Entities in conducting end-to-end space activities has resulted in a remarkable interest in the Start-up community, with 111 space-startups registered, as on date, on the IN-SPACe digital platform.

Over the last five years, Government has taken several steps to strengthen space program and take it to greater heights. Significant progress has been made in the development and realization of space systems catering to earth observation, satellite communication and space science. Multiple successful flights of operational launch vehicles, along with development, realization and testing of major technology elements of future launch vehicles, was seen during this period.

**Development of Infrastructure at Airport AAI and other Airport Developers have targeted capital outlay of approximately Rs. 98,000 crore in airport sector in the next five years**

New Delhi, Dec. 15 (PIB) Upgradation/Modernisation of airports' infrastructure is a continuous process and is undertaken by Airports Authority of India (AAI) and other Airport Developers from time to time depending on the availability of land, commercial viability, socio-economic considerations, traffic demand/willingness of airlines to operate to/from such airports. AAI and other Airport Developers have targeted capital outlay of approximately Rs. 98,000 crore in airport sector in the next five years for expansion and modification of existing terminals, new terminals and strengthening of runways, among other activities.
