Election to Lok Sabha-2019

Political parties & candidates urged to adhere to MCC

Port Blair, Mar. 15

The Election Commission of India has declared the Elections to the Lok Sabha Parliamentary Constituency of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, vide Press Notification dated the 10th March 2019. Under the provisions contained in Representation of Peoples Act, 1951, all the political parties and contesting candidates have been requested to strictly follow all the norms of Model Code of Conduct.

MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT BY POLITICAL PARTIES/CANDIDATES

- No party or candidate shall indulge in any activity which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic.
- Criticism of other political parties, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programme, past record and work. Parties and Candidates shall refrain from criticism of all aspects of private life, not connected with the public activities of the leaders or workers of other parties. Criticism of other parties or their workers based on unverified allegations or distortion shall be avoided.
- There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes. Mosques, Churches, Temples or other places of worship shall not be used as forum for election propaganda.
- All parties and candidates shall avoid scrupulously all activities which are "corrupt practices" and offences under the election law, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, canvassing within 200 meters of polling stations, holding public meetings during the period of 48 hours ending with the hour fixed for the close of the poll, and the transport and conveyance of voters to and from polling

station.

○ The right of every individual for peaceful and undisturbed home-life shall be respected, however much the political parties or candidates may resent his political opinions or activities. Organizing demonstrations or picketing before the houses of individuals by way of protesting against their opinions or activities shall not be resorted to under any circumstances.

- Political parties and candidates shall ensure that their supporters do not create obstructions in or break up meetings and processions organised by other parties. Workers or sympathisers of one political party shall not create disturbances at public meetings organised by another political party by putting questions orally or in writing or by distributing leaflets of their own party.
- All advertisement for telecasting on TV channels and cable networks by any political parties must be viewed, scrutinized and certified by Monitoring Committee on Media Certification (MCMC).
- All political parties should try to avoid the use of plastic/polythene for preparation of posters, banners etc. during election campaign.
- Any and all advertisements at the cost of the public exchequer regarding achievements of the party/ Government in power are prohibited.
- No inducement, financial or otherwise, shall be offered to the voter.
- Race/caste/communal/religious/ language feelings of the electors shall not be appealed to. (Section 125, RP Act 1951)
- No activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes, communities or religious or linguistic groups shall be attempted.

India's competitions at Special Olympics World Games

Abu Dhabi, Mar 15
India will be competing in Badminton, Powerlifting, Swimming, Table Tennis, Football, Basketball, Handball and Roller Skating in the Abu Dhabi Special Olympics on Friday.

Team India is the second largest contingent after the host UAE with 387 players, along with coaches and other staff.

The Games kicked off last evening with a spectacular star-studded ceremony on Thursday evening.



The Games were declared open by Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi. 7,500 special athletes from 200 countries marched at the Zayed Stadium to the rousing ovation of the 40,000 strong crowd.

Final decision on 48-team 2022 World Cup set for June: FIFA

Paris, Mar 15
FIFA chiefs are likely to decide on Friday whether to back an expansion of the 2022 World Cup to 48 teams but a final decision will only be taken at a meeting in Paris in June, sources said Thursday.

The FIFA Council meeting in Miami on Friday will give its verdict on an internal feasibility study which supported increasing the number of teams at the 2022 tournament in Qatar from 32 to 48.

However a final vote on increasing the number of teams at the football showpiece would only be taken at a full Congress meeting of football's global governing body in June. And any declaration of support by FIFA's Council on Friday would acknowledge that expansion in 2022 can only take place if one or more countries on Qatar's borders are able to host games, according to a document seen by news agency AFP.

FIFA's feasibility study into an expanded World Cup in 2022 said Bahrain, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, Oman and United Arab Emirates were potential options to host games in three years



time. But Bahrain, Saudi Arabia and the UAE would only be candidates if their governments ended a diplomatic blockade of Qatar launched in 2017, the study said.

A final decision on whether to expand the 2022 World Cup would be taken in Paris on June 6 after FIFA and Qatar jointly submit the names of potential co-host nations to the governing body's Congress.

FIFA President Gianni Infantino is an enthusiastic supporter of expanding the 2022 World Cup, bringing forward an increase in the number of teams which had initially been planned for the 2026 finals staged in the United States, Mexico and Canada. The increase in teams will

see the tournament feature 80 matches instead of the 64 used in a traditional 32-team World Cup.

For the 2026 tournament in North America, 60 games will be held in the United States with Canada and Mexico getting 10 games each. A similar division is anticipated for 2022, with Qatar retaining the bulk of the matches. A

FIFA document on Thursday said an expanded 2022 tournament would use the same format planned for 2026, with the six regional confederations would receive the same number of qualifying slots allocated for the tournament in North America.

Apex Court sets aside life ban on cricketer S Sreesanth

New Delhi, Mar. 15

The Supreme Court has set aside the life ban on cricketer S Sreesanth, imposed by the BCCI. A bench comprising justices Ashok Bhushan and K M Joseph said the disciplinary committee of the Board of Control for Cricket in India, BCCI imposed the ban on Sreesanth for his alleged involvement in the 2013 IPL spot-fixing scandal. The bench made it clear that Sreesanth will get the



opportunity of being heard by the committee on the quantum of the punishment. The apex court also said that its verdict shall have no effect on the criminal proceedings pending against the former cricketer in the Delhi High Court. The bench passed this order on Sreesanth's plea challenging the decision of a division bench of the Kerala High Court which had restored the life ban imposed on him by the BCCI.

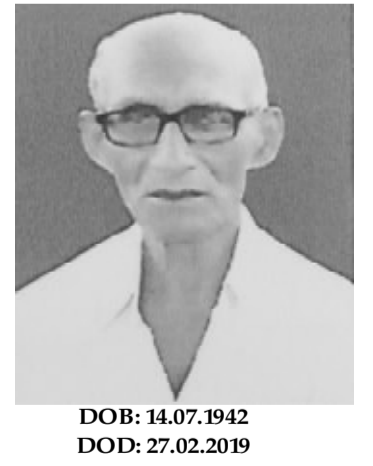

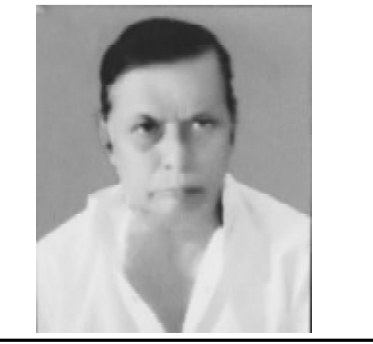
