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## India tops list of fastest growing economies for coming decade: Harvard study

New Delhi, May 6  
India tops the list of the fastest growing economies in the world for the coming decade and is projected to grow at 7.9 per cent annually, ahead of China and the US, according to a Harvard University report. The Centre for International Development at Harvard University (CID) said in new growth projections that countries that have diversified their economies into more complex sectors, like India and Vietnam, are those that will grow the fastest in the coming decade. "India tops the list as the fastest growing country for the coming decade, at 7.9 per cent annually, in the economic complexity growth projections. India has made inroads in diversifying its export base



to include more complex sectors, such as chemicals, vehicles, and certain electronics," the report said. It said that India's productive capabilities far exceed expectations for its current income level, which contributes to the projection of rapid growth for the coming decade. The researchers also find India ranks the best on the criteria termed the Complexity Opportunity Index (COI), which

means India has many "unrealised opportunities" to diversify into related, high-value sectors to continue to drive productivity growth and job creation. "Up to now, that potential remains unrealized, however, as India's complexity has not changed over the past decade. The rapid growth that is predicted is effectively capitalizing on previous gains in complexity," the report added.

It stressed that ensuring the long-run potential of India's economic growth

## India's 7% projected growth rate 'amazingly fast', can double economy in 10 years: ADB

New Delhi, May 6  
Asian Development Bank Chief Economist Mr Yasuyuki Sawada has said, India's projected GDP growth of over 7 percent for the current fiscal is amazingly fast and if this momentum is maintained the size of the economy can double within a decade. He said, the country should not worry about not achieving 8 percent



growth but focus on increasing domestic demand by reducing the income inequality. He said, growth is driven more by domestic consumption than exports. Mr Sawada said,

inequality and poverty reduction would play a very important role in achieving higher growth because consumption can stimulate more production and that can create more employment. He said tapping the broadening market will be important to achieve higher growth, adding that the services sector too would play a role in pushing up economic growth.

## Need for fast tracking technology infusion for country's sustainable economic growth: Minister

New Delhi, May 6  
Minister of State for External Affairs, General V K Singh has stressed on the need for fast tracking technology infusion for the country's sustainable economic growth. This include strengthening Research and Development that helps economic growth. General Singh inaugurated a conference on- Economic Diplomacy for Development - under the Deccan Dialogue initiative in Hyderabad this morning. The External Affairs Ministry has organised the first conference under the



Deccan Dialogue initiative, jointly with the Indian School of Business. Speaking on the occasion, General Singh highlighted the need for greater coordination between ministries like External Affairs, Trade and

Commerce and more cooperation with states to achieve economic strides on sustainable manner. Stating that India is doing well when the rest of the world is facing sluggish economy, General Singh said, demographics,

especially large number of youth and vast markets are India's advantage. He said, there is an urgent need to use economic diplomacy at every level with each country as each one has their own strengths and resources. The Minister further said India need to focus on manufacturing sector, besides services sector, with a focus on MSMEs to make use of its strengths. He also said, there is a need to look at the growing Global Labour Mobility and protect the interests of workforce as well as prevent illegal migration.

## Govt set target of providing gas connections to 80 lakh households in Odisha by end of year: Minister

Bhubaneswar, May 6  
Union Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas Shri Dharmendra Pradhan has said that government set a target of providing gas connections to 80 lakh households in Odisha by end of December this year. The minister said that LPG penetration in Odisha has already reached 58.55 percent till 1st May 2018 from 20 percent level in June 2014. He was speaking at the Pradhan Mantri LPG Panchayat at Mangalajodi of Khorda district in Odisha yesterday as part of Gram Swaraj Abhiyan.



Shri Pradhan said that 24.23 lakh connections have been released in the state under the Prime Minister Ujjwala Yojna. He also said that currently, four bottling

plants are there in Odisha and three new bottling plants are being planned to be set up in Khorda, Bolangir and Rayagada districts.

## Govt likely to notify 8.55% interest on PF for FY18 this week

New Delhi, May 6  
The Labour Ministry is likely to notify this week the 5-year low 8.55 per cent interest on PF for 2017-18, paving the way for retirement fund body EPFO to credit returns into the accounts of around 5 crore subscribers. The Finance Ministry has ratified 8.55 per cent rate of interest on EPF for last fiscal. "The Labour Ministry has sought Election Commission's approval to notify rate of interest for crediting the same into members' accounts by the EPFO in view of model code of conduct for Karnataka elections," a source said.

"The nod is expected anytime this week to provide 8.55 per cent rate of interest to the EPFO subscribers," the source said. The recommendation on the rate of interest by the Central Board of Trustees, the apex decision making body of Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), is sent to the finance ministry for its concurrence. Once ratified, the labour ministry notifies the rate of interest and the EPFO credits the return for the particular year into its members account. The CBT, headed by the labour minister, had

decided to fix 8.55 per cent rate of interest for last fiscal in its meeting held on February 21, 2018. It could not be implemented for the want of finance ministry's concurrence and was further delayed due to the model code of conduct for Karnataka elections on May 12. EPFO had provided 8.65 per cent interest for 2016-17. The members got 8.8 per cent each in 2013-14 and 2014-15. In 2012-13, EPFO had provided 8.5 per cent rate of interest on EPF. Thus, at 8.55 per cent for 2017-18, it is a five year low.

**Neeraj Chopra shatters own national record, finishes 4th in Doha Diamond League**

Doha, May 6  
Star Indian javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra shattered his own national record by clearing a distance of 87.43m en route finishing fourth in a star-studded field in the season-opening Diamond League series meet. Neeraj, who recently won a gold in the Commonwealth Games with a throw of 86.47m, was up against Olympic champion Thomas Rohler, world champion Johannes Vetter and Andreas Hoffman, all Germans and all in the 90m club, but the 22-year-old Indian was not intimidated as he sent the spear to 87.43m in his second attempt last night to better his earlier national mark of 86.48m. In the process, Neeraj beat 2017 London World Championships silver medalist Jakub Vadlejch of the Czech Republic, who finished fifth with a best throw of 86.67m.



Neeraj had the earlier national record of 86.48m when he won the gold in the 2016 World Junior Championships in Poland. That mark is also the existing world junior record. Just after winning gold in the Gold Coast CWG, he had said that he would like to be in the 90m club -- the gold standard mark in javelin -- soon. Even Vetter had predicted that Neeraj should be able to throw between 88m to 90m this year itself. Saturday's performance showed that Neeraj has been constantly improving.

He began with an 81.17m, then came up with 87.43m before fouling his next three attempts. He had an 81.06m in his sixth and last throw. Rohler won the gold with a best throw of 91.78m which he came up in his second attempt. Vetter was second with 91.56m while Hoffman was third with 90.08m as Germans swept all the top three spots. Neeraj will next take part in the Eugene (United States) leg of the Diamond League series on May 26 and there again he will be up against Rohler, Vetter, Hoffman and Vadlejch.

**India's target should be to win medals in double digits in 2020 Tokyo Olympics, says Narinder Batra**

New Delhi, May 6  
Indian Olympic Association President Narinder Batra said that the country should aim to win "double digit" medals at the Tokyo Olympics and around 25 at the 2024 Games in Paris. The IOA president feels that a good show in the Olympics will then help India gain public support in its bid to host the 2032 Summer Games. Batra had recently told International Olympic Committee chief Thomas Bach — when he visited the country last month — that India would bid for 2032 Olympics, 2026 Youth Olympics and 2030 Asian Games. "Our target should be to win medals in double digits in 2020 Tokyo Olympics, 25 in 2024 Olympics and around 40 medals at the 2028 Olympics. This we need as we want to bid for 2032 Olympics. It is difficult to win public support (to

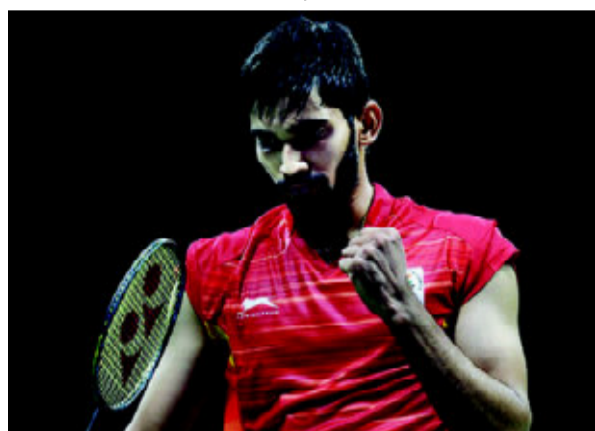


bid for Olympics) if we do not do well and win medals in the Olympics itself," Batra said. "We have to plan for 2020 and 2024 Olympics and we have to find the talent in the country. We have to do this together with the national federations as well as government. We have to work with the government as they are having schemes like Target Olympic Podium Scheme," he said at a felicitation function of the badminton players who have won medals at the recent Commonwealth Games.

He also gave a thumbs up on the politicians heading National Sports Federations, saying it's good for Indian sports. "60 out of the 66 medals India won in the CWG were by players from NSFs being headed by politicians. Badminton, table tennis, wrestling, weightlifting, shooting to name a few are headed by politicians and they are giving medals to the country," said the IOA chief. "Politicians heading NSFs are not bad but they are actually good for Indian sports," he added.

**Kidambi Srikanth may skip Super Series for Asiad, Worlds**

New Delhi, May 6  
After winning a silver medal at the Gold Coast Commonwealth Games, ace shuttler Kidambi Srikanth is focused on bringing more medal glory to the nation at the forthcoming Asian Games and World Championships. However, for the World No. 3 singles player, remaining injury-free remains a big concern given the crammed BWF competition calendar. To keep fit and active on the circuit, Srikanth, who briefly held the World No. 1 position recently before slipping down the ranking ladder, may skip a few Super Series tournaments in the run up to the Jakarta Asiad. "Injuries are becoming a major concern for all of us (badminton players), including me. I was injured last year and in the early part



of this year. I really want to keep my health in mind. My first preference will be to take care of my body. For that, I might be skipping a few of them (Super Series). I can't play all of them," Srikanth told TOI. "I am targeting the Asian Games and World Championships, that's where my priority lies. Obviously, I have to maintain my ranking, so I have to plan my season

accordingly. However, I don't play for rankings. For me, it's important to do well in tournaments. Becoming World No. 1 was a special feeling and I am happy about that," added Srikanth, who was in the capital along with PV Sindhu, Saina Nehwal and other CWG team members to attend the Badminton Association of India's (BAI) felicitation function.

**Delay of rail traffic in different sections would be resolved soon: Minister**

New Delhi, May 5  
Minister of State for Railways Shri Manoj Sinha has said, delay of rail traffic in different sections would be resolved soon after completion of ongoing track maintenance and renovation works. Addressing a function organised at Gorakhpur Junction in Uttar Pradesh today, Shri Sinha said, safety and security of passengers is paramount for railways and it would be never compromised. He said, off late delay in running of trains is temporary in nature and the inconvenience caused is due to utmost precautions maintained

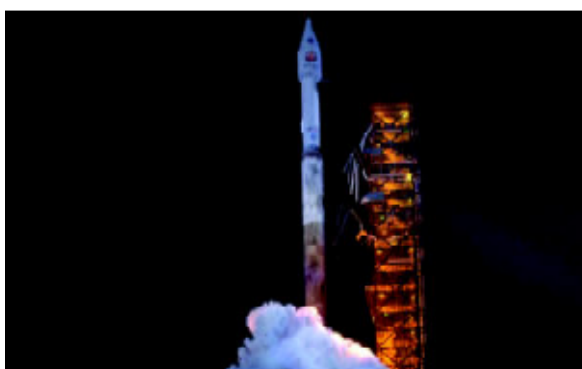

**NASA launches its latest mission to Mars**

Washington, May 6  
NASA has blasted off its latest Mars lander, InSight, designed to perch on the surface and listen for "Marsquakes" ahead of eventual human missions to explore the Red Planet. The project aims to expand human knowledge of interior conditions on Mars, inform efforts to send human explorers there, and reveal how rocky planets like the Earth formed billions of years ago. If all goes as planned, the lander should settle on the Red Planet on November 26. Its name, InSight, is short for Interior Exploration using Seismic Investigations, Geodesy and Heat Transport. NASA



chief scientist Jim Green said experts already know that Mars has quakes, avalanches and meteor strikes. After the lander settles on the Martian surface, a robotic arm is supposed to emerge and place the seismometer directly on the ground. The probe will bore down 10 to 16 feet below the surface, NASA said, 15 times deeper than
