World Youth Skills Day celebrated through virtual mode

Skill India Mission has enhanced opportunities to access employment both locally and globally: PM

New Delhi, July 15 (PIB)

In his message to the Digital Skills Conclave held today on the occasion of the World Youth Skills Day and the fifth anniversary of 'Skill India' mission, the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi exhorted the youth to skill, reskill and upskill in order to remain relevant in the rapidly changing business environment and market conditions. He congratulated the youth of the country on the occasion and said the world belongs to the youth due to their ability to acquire new skills all the time.

The Prime Minister stated that the Skill India Mission launched five years back on the same day has led to creation of a vast infrastructure for skilling, reskilling and upskilling and enhancing opportunities to access employment both locally and globally. It has led to hundreds of PM Kaushal Kendras being set up across the country and increase in the capacity of the ITI ecosystem. Due to these concerted efforts, more than five crore youth have been skilled in the last five years. Referring to the portal launched recently for mapping the skilled employees and employers, he stated that this would help the skilled workers, including the migrant workers who have returned to their homes, to access jobs easily and the employers to contact skilled employees at the click of a mouse. He emphasized



that the skills of migrant workers would also help in changing the local economy. The Prime Minister described skills as a gift which we can give to ourselves and added that skills are timeless, unique, a treasure trove and a means by which one can not only become employable but also help in leading a satisfying life. He said that a natural attraction to acquire new skills provides new energy and encouragement in one's life. Skills are not only a means to a livelihood but also a reason to feel lively and energetic in our daily routine.

The Prime Minister also brought out the distinction between 'knowledge' and 'skills' in his address. He illustrated this with an example - that knowing how a cycle runs is 'knowledge' while actually being able to ride a cycle was a 'skill'. It is important

for the youth to realize the difference between the two and their different contexts and implications. With an example from carpentry, he explained the nuances between skilling, reskilling and upskilling. He further highlighted the potential of the country to capitalize on the skilling opportunities available in the country. He gave the example of the healthcare sector where Indian skilled manpower can supplement the global demand. He stressed the need to map this demand and align Indian standards with those of other countries. Similarly, the PM suggested that the Indian youth with a long maritime tradition can contribute as expert

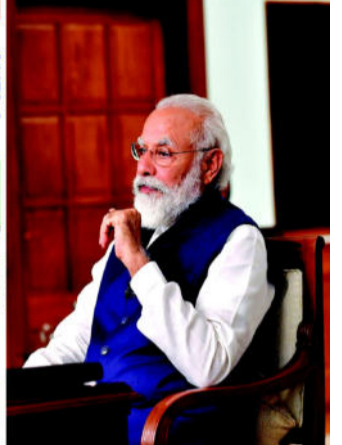
15th Virtual India-EU Summit held

Govt. committed to strengthen and deepen relations between India & European Union: PM

New Delhi, July 15

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi today said, his government is committed to strengthen and deepen the relations between India and the European Union and highlighted the need to adopt a long-term strategic perspective for this.

Addressing the India EU Summit in virtual mode this afternoon, Shri Modi said, an action-oriented agenda should be made which can be implemented within the stipulated time frame. He said, India and EU are natural partners and the partnership is also useful for peace and stability in the world. He added that this reality has



become even more clear in today's global situation.

The Prime Minister said India and the EU share universal values like democracy, pluralism, inclusivity, respect for international institutions,

multilateralism, freedom and transparency. He pointed out that both the health and prosperity of citizens are facing challenges today and there are different types of pressures on rules-based international order. He said that in

such a situation, India-EU partnership can play an important role in economic reconstruction, and in building a human-centric and humanity-centred globalisation.

Support for setting up Industrial concern in Isles ANIIDCO to provide financial assistance to interested individuals



Port Blair, July 15

The Credit & Finance Division of ANIIDCO provides financial assistance for setting up Industrial concerns under its General Scheme, as per the guidelines of SIDBI/IDBI. Under the scheme, financial assistance is provided to industrial concern engaged in manufacturing, preservation or

processing of goods, transport for passengers/goods etc, hotels and restaurants, assembling, repairing or packing any article with the aid of machinery or power, providing engineering, technical knowledge or other service for promotion of industrial growth, providing medical health or other allied service, setting up or development of tourism related facilities

etc. The quantum of loan is maximum 75% of the total project cost upto Rs. 10 lakh and minimum 66% of the total project cost exceeding Rs. 10 lakh for purchase of machinery, construction of building. The promoters contribution is minimum 25% for project cost upto Rs.10

lakh and 34% for the project cost exceeding Rs. 10 lakh.

The rate of interest for different loan amount is fixed based on SIDBI's prime lending rate which is at present 11.00%. Accordingly, rate of Interest calculated as per the range of finance is as under:

Range of Finance	Interest Rate
Upto Rs. 50,000	9.00%
Above Rs. 50,000/- to Rs. 2,00,000	10.00%
Above Rs. 2,00,000 upto Rs. 25,00,000	10.50%

Interest rate is subject to change as per changes in the SIDBI Prime Lending Rate (PLR). A rebate of 1% is provided for prompt payment and 2% lower rate is admissible for industrial concerns engaged in tourism, horticulture,

fisheries, food processing and environment friendly projects like recycling waste etc. A maximum Repayment period of 10 years with a moratorium period of 6 months to 2 years depending on the

Govt. decides to allow Invalid Pension to Armed Forces Personnel with less than 10 years of qualifying service

New Delhi, July 15 (PIB)

The Government has taken a decision to allow Invalid Pension to Armed Forces Personnel with less than 10 years of qualifying service. Invalid pension is granted to the Armed Forces Personnel who is invalidated out of service on account of disability which is accepted as Neither Attributable to Nor Aggravated (NANA) by Military Service. The proposal has been approved by

Raksha Mantri, Shri Rajnath Singh. Benefit of this decision will be available to those Armed Forces Personnel who were in service on or after 04.01.2019.

Earlier, the minimum period of qualifying service actually rendered and required for invalid pension was 10 years or more. For less than 10 years qualifying service, invalid gratuity was admissible. By this decision, Armed

Forces Personnel whose service is less than ten years and became/become invalidated out of service on account of any bodily or mental infirmity which is Neither Attributable to Nor Aggravated (NANA) by Military service and which permanently incapacitates them from military service as well as civil re-employment, will be benefited and it will make them economically sound.

Rural Development Minister holds review meeting on progress of Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyaan

New Delhi, July 15

Union Minister of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar held a review meeting on the progress of Garib Kalyan Rojgar Abhiyaan through video-conferencing yesterday with the Rural Development Ministers and officials of six states. It is being undertaken in 116 districts of Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Rajasthan.

The Abhiyaan will continue for 125 days. 25 works coming under 11 different Ministries have



been identified for completion. The Abhiyaan was found to be progressing well under various parameters which are being regularly monitored.

Speaking to the State representatives, the Union Minister said, it is the effort of the Government to provide employment to the migrant workers at their native places.

The Abhiyaan is not only

providing employment to returning migrants and similarly affected rural citizens, but also strengthening the economy. He expressed satisfaction at the rate of progress of the special drive by active cooperation between the Centre and the States. He laid emphasis on further accelerating the drive and creation of maximum infrastructure.

CBSE Class 10th exam results declared Overall pass percentage stood at 91.46; girls have done better than boys

CBSE has announced the results of Class X Examinations. The overall pass percentage stood at 91.46 percent. Girls have outshone boys again this year with a pass percentage of 93.31 percent. A total of 90.14 percent boys and 78.95 transgenders have passed.

CBSE said there has been a marginal increase in the pass percentage since last year. Students can check their results at cbse.nic.in or cbseresults.nic.in. The results can also be checked via DigiLocker and Umang apps.


