New Delhi, Feb 16 The Minister of Women and Child Development, Smt. Maneka Sanjay Gandhi has urged schools to strictly observe Guidelines for Eliminating Corporal Punishment, issued by the National Commission of Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) of WCD Ministry. The WCD Ministry has asked the Ministry of Human Resource Development for wide spread circulation and implementation of the Guidelines for Elimination of Corporal Punishment in schools. This was done in the light of the recent

disturbing incident of girl students who were meted out tormenting corporal punishment in the school for not completing their homework. The incident was widely reported in the media, thereby bringing to public attention the issue of corporal punishment used in

schools. The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) under the authority of Ministry of Women & Child Development has developed and issued Guidelines for Eliminating Corporal Punishment in schools.

New Delhi, Feb 16 Five new judges were appointed to the Supreme Court, taking its working strength to 28. President Shri Pranab Mukherjee has signed their warrants of appointment. Those elevated to the apex court are five High Court Judges, including four Chief Justices of State High Courts. The news Judges are Madras High Court Chief Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul, Rajasthan HC

Chief Justice Naveen Sinha, Kerala HC Chief Justice Mohan M Shantanagouder, Chhattisgarh HC Chief Justice Dipak Gupta and Karnataka HC judge S Abdul Nazeer. The working strength of the Supreme Court has received a fillip with the fresh appointments. Though it has a sanctioned strength of 31, the top court is working with only 23 judges.

Tax Department's mobile app for income tax, PAN soon

New Delhi, Feb 16

The Income Tax Department is developing an App that will soon allow assesses to pay taxes or apply for PAN using smart phones. The department is also working on a project to issue Permanent Account Numbers, PAN to assesses within minutes by way of e-KYC authentication using Aadhaar.

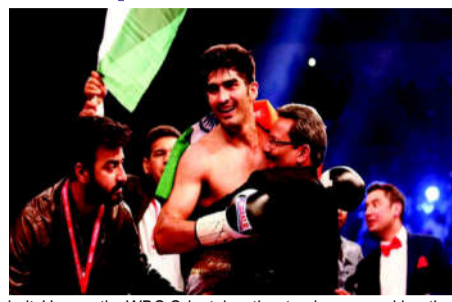
Karate tourney, grading exams & seminar held

Enforcement team of Dte of CS&CA conducts inspection in Mayabunder

Port Blair, Feb. 16
The enforcement team of the Directorate Of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs conducted surprise inspection in and around Mayabunder Tehsil recently and found 13 autoriskshaw drivers/owners violating the provisions of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Legal Metrology (Enforcement) rules, 2011 and three shopkeepers violating the provisions contained under the Legal Metrology (packaged commodities) Rules, 2011 farmed under the legal metrology act, 2009. This year's rice production is higher by 2.21 million tonnes than previous record production. Wheat production, estimated at 96.64 million tonnes is also a record. The Ministry said, as a result of significant increase in the area coverage and productivity of all major pulses, total production of pulses is estimated to be 22.14 million tonnes which is higher by 2.89 million tonnes than the previous production. With an increase of 8.35 million tonnes over the previous year, total oilseeds production in the country is estimated at record level of 33.60 million tonnes. However the production of sugarcane is estimated to be around 310 million tonnes, lower by 38 million tonnes in last year.
