Revenue Department simplifies process of permission for transportation of earth

The Revenue Department has simplified the process of permission for transportation of earth. It is clarified that under the provisions of Rule 47 of Andaman & Nicobar Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012, the permission is only for transportation of earth. Accordingly, the following arrangements have been made by the Revenue Department:

Development/Improvement of House and commercial sites (area not more than 500 sq.mtrs) for construction of building without transportation of earth.
1. No permission is required from Revenue Authority.
2. The land should be House or Commercial site.
3. Building Plan should be approved by the appropriate authority (PBMC or (Contd. on last page)

Indian shooters win men's 10m air pistol team gold at University Shooting Championship

New Delhi, Mar 16
India won team gold in the men's 10m air pistol at the FISA World University Shooting Sport Championship 2018 in Kuala Lumpur, while promising Indian shooters Meghana Sajjanar and Elavenil Valarivan won silver and bronze respectively in the 10m air rifle individual competition on Friday.
The men's team of Anmol Jain, Achal Pratap Singh Grewal and Nishant Sindhu shot a score of 1725 to claim the gold medal.
Bengaluru-based Meghana, 24, had in 2017 become the first woman from Karnataka to make the national senior shooting team for last year's ISSF World Cup.
A computer science engineer who graduated from Jain University in 2016 with 75



percent marks, Meghana cemented her place in the squad by winning the first trials and finishing fifth in the second at the National Shooting Championships that same year.
Valarivan, 18, who hails from Gujarat, is another promising talent. In December 2017, she captured the women's 10m air rifle gold at the 61st National

Cricket's Himalayan torch-bearers: Nepal's road to ODI status

New Delhi, Mar 16
On Thursday March 15, Nepal became the latest Associate team to gain one-day international (ODI) status by the ICC. The moment of joy came after they beat Papua New Guinea by six wickets in Harare during the ICC World Cup Qualifiers. For a team that was given Associates status 12 years ago, it has been hailed as an "amazing" achievement by the veteran allrounder and Nepal captain Paras Khadka, while current spin bowling sensation Sandeep Lamichhane - who was purchased by IPL franchise Delhi Daredevils this year - termed it "a beautiful journey" which was the result of plenty of "hard work" and "patience".
Despite becoming an ODI team, however, Nepal will not participate in next year's 50-over World Cup in England, having not made it into the Super League of the ongoing Qualifiers in Zimbabwe. Nevertheless, it is a joyous occasion for the Himalayan country which has been widely celebrated.



On that note, here's a look at how Nepal moved up the cricket ladder to seal ODI status.
- In 1988, the Nepal Cricket Association was granted affiliate status by the ICC.
- In 1996, Nepal became an Associates member.
- In 2002, Nepal finished second in the ACC Trophy.
- In 2004, they played their maiden first-class match.
- In 2006, they won the ACC Premier League.

Phoenix (USA), Mar 16
Aditi Ashok shot a highly creditable 2-under 70 in demanding conditions at the Wildfire Golf Club in the opening round of the Bank of Hope Founders Cup.
This has only been her second start on the LPGA this season, after missing the cut in her season-opener in Australian Women's Open.
She is placed Tied-17th and is three shots behind co-leaders, Frenchwoman Karine Icher and Chella Choi, who carded 67 each. Korea's Inbee Park and Thai Ariya Jutanugam shot 68 each to be Tied-3rd with four others.

Sanjivani Jadhav bags bronze in Asian Cross Country

New Delhi, Mar 16
Nashik has produced several runners of substance, most of them women, including the likes of Kavita Raut and Monika Attare. The most recent to emerge from the region is 20-year-old Sanjivani Jadhav, who won bronze at the Asian Cross Country Championship on Thursday in Guiyang, China. Her 28m 19sec in the women's 8km event helped her grab the bronze behind China's Li Dan (28:03s) and Abe Yukari (28:06) of Japan. Sanjivani was way ahead of her compatriots, which included Rio Olympian and steeplechase national record holder Lalita Babbar, who finished 15th with a disappointing (32:53s) on the clock. Swati Ghadave (30:18s), who finished 11th, was the second best Indian, as the team earned an overall bronze medal as well. Sanjivani, like most of the athletes from the Nashik region, was spotted and trained by SAI coach Vijender Singh, who scouts talent

it is lost, the identity of the community vanishes; hence it needs to be preserved. There is nothing wrong in learning other languages but one's own mother tongue should be sustained, he said.

In his presidential address, the Vice Chancellor, National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, Prof. (Dr.) R Venkat Rao highlighted the objectives of the seminar and invited all the participants to put their heads together and raise issues pertaining to the tribal community and try to find solution to those issues. "We need to cultivate justice for a secure and peaceful environment to protect the rights of the tribal and to allow them live in dignity", he said.

The Former Vice Chancellor, TNDALU & Senior Professor of Law, National Law School of India University, Bengaluru, Prof. (Dr.) V Vijayakumar stressed the need to understand the culture of a particular tribal community and formulate peaceful and good governance for the protection of the Islands' tribes. He also suggested for deliberation on tribal identity as a group, right to development, self determination, equality and protection, during this seminar, which according to him will lead to proper planning for the welfare and development of the aboriginal tribes of the Islands.

Prof. (Dr.) T Subramaniam Naidu, Director (Retd.), Center for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy, Pondicherry University, said that each tribe is unique and their character need to be studied so as to address the issues pertaining to their fundamental rights, while Prof. (Dr.) Anvita Abbi, (Padma Shree), Professor, Department of Linguistics, Simon Fraser University, Canada suggested for inclusion of the Nicobarese language in the Indian Language Schedule. She also lauded the peaceful and friendly behavior of the Nicobarese tribe.

Prof. (Dr.) Vishvajith Pandya of the Dhirubhai Ambani Institute of Information and Communication, Gujarat, Dr. S A Awaradi, Director ANTRI and Dr. N Francis Xavier, Principal JNRM were among others, who addressed the inaugural function.

In his welcome address, the Principal, Andaman Law College, Dr. Saundarya Pandey briefed about the Law College's initiative in organizing the seminar and called it the first such seminar of national significance by the College. He expressed hoped that the students of the College will draw benefit from it.

The seminar, which will continue tomorrow, will conclude with a valedictory function to be held tomorrow afternoon.



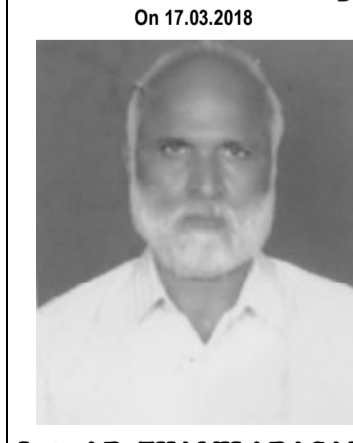

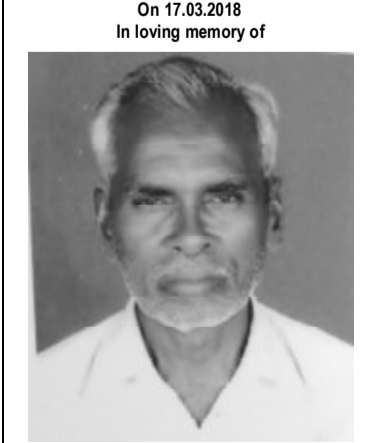
