## Prime Minister Modi embarks on three-nation Europe visit

New Delhi, Apr 16 Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has embarked on a five-day visit to Sweden and the UK with an aim to boost bilateral cooperation in key areas, including trade and investment. On the first leg of his visit, the Prime Minister will visit Sweden where he will attend the first ever India-Nordic Summit at Stockholm. The Prime Minister will also hold bilateral discussions with his Swedish counterpart. Business and trade is high on agenda when Indian Prime Minister Shri



Narendra Modi will meet to discuss "innovation, sustainable development and how Swedish-Indian relations can be further strengthened", in Stockholm during the two-day visit of the Prime Minister Shri Modi.

Sweden has supported India's key "Make-in-India" manufacturing summit with Mr. Löfven leading a delegation of Swedish industry leaders to the launch of Make India in Mumbai in 2016. India is also a market of growing significance for Sweden; more than 160 Swedish companies are now established in India. Prime Minister Shri Modi will meet King Carl XVI Gustaf at the Royal Palace in the morning of April 17th, followed by bilateral talks with Mr. Löfven and roundtable discussions (Contd. on last page)

**Sports Minister lauds Indian athletes' performance at Commonwealth Games**



New Delhi, Apr 16 Sports Minister Col Rajyavardhan Rathore today lauded the Indian athletes' performance at the Commonwealth Games and promised to build on the success in Gold Coast keeping the 2024 and 2028 Olympics in mind.

India finished third in the medals tally, courtesy 66 medals including 26 gold, 20 silver and as many bronze. "The intensity and passion shown by the athletes has made the entire nation proud," said Col Rathore in a video message.

"While we won a lot of medals in disciplines which have been our traditional stronghold, it was even more heartening to find our athletes doing well in sports, where we have not won too many medals," the 2004 Olympics silver medalist said.

Col Rathore also congratulated the medallists, who emerged from government's pet project Khelo India School Games (KISG). Teenagers Manu Bhaker and Anish Bhanwala, who won shooting gold medals in the

Gold Coast Games, competed in the KISG.

"We are planning to put a professional system in place. There is a lot of potential in our youth and I see India winning a bagful of medals at the 2024 and 2028 Olympics," he added.

India, a powerhouse at the Commonwealth level, has a lot of catching up to do at the Olympic level. The country won just two medals at the 2016 Rio Olympics and till date shooter Abhinav Bindra is India's sole individual gold medallist at the Summer Games.

**Yuki Bhambri back in ATP top-100 after more than 2 years**

New Delhi, Apr 16

Yuki Bhambri on Tuesday broke back into the top-100 for the first time since February 2016 following his title-winning performance at the Taipei Challenger as he leaptfrogged 22 places to a career-best rank of 83. This is the best rank an Indian has achieved in ATP singles chart since Somdev Devvarman touched a career-high 62 in July 2011. Yuki had first broken into top-100 late in 2015 but injuries did not allow him to climb further. However, the resilient 25-year-old has worked his way back to top-100 which, if maintained, will allow him direct entry into the Grand Slams and the ATP 1000 series Masters event. "It's only the beginning, I have to move up a lot more and I am looking forward to the challenge," Yuki told PTI. Asked if top-50 was a realistic target for him, Yuki said, "Not at the moment. Too far." Yuki has always maintained that he has



the game to challenge the best players and has proved with his recent big wins over world number 12 Lucas Pillee (Indian Wells, March 2018) and world number 22 Gael Monfils (Washington, August 2017). His Davis Cup teammate Ramkumar Ramanathan too rose to a career-best 116 as he jumped 17 places after ending runner-up to Yuki in Taipei.

Sumit Nagal, though, lost two places to be 215 and was followed by Prajnesh Gunneswaran (266) and Arjun Kadhe (394). In the doubles, Divij Sharan

further improved his career-best rank by moving up to 41, a gain of one place. Leander Paes, who became the most successful doubles player in Davis Cup, lost four places to be in 49th position.

Rohan Bopanna is leading the doubles chart for India at number 19. Meanwhile, Ankita Raina too improved on her career-best rank as she jumped three places to 194 while Karman Kaur Thandi dropped a place to 268. In the doubles, out-of-action Sania Mirza was unchanged at number 24

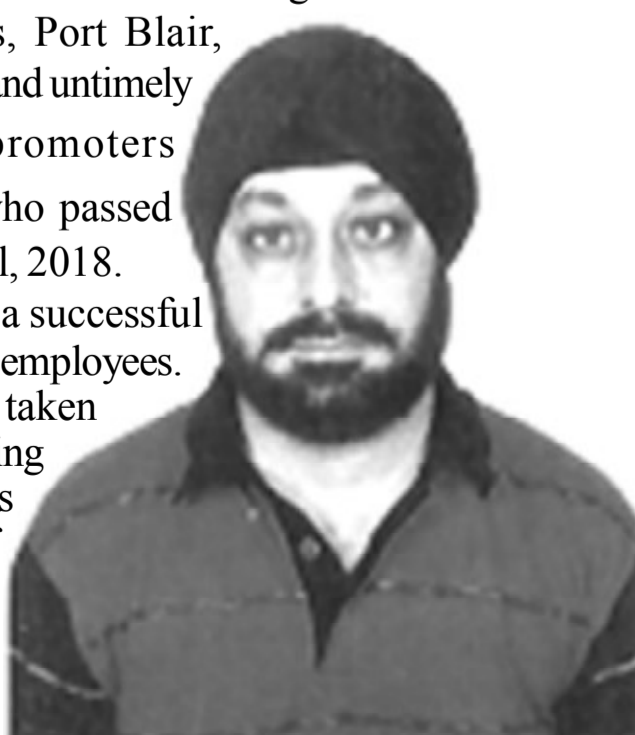
