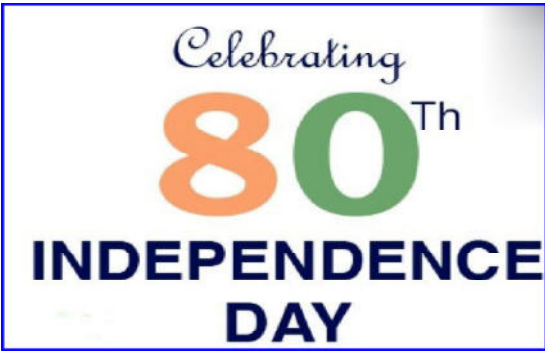

80th Independence Day to be celebrated in Isles today

Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands to hoist National Tricolour at historic Netaji Stadium

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 14

The 80th Independence Day will be celebrated in a befitting manner in these Islands too together with the rest of the country tomorrow (August 15). The main function for the 80th Independence Day will be held at the historic Netaji Stadium wherein the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) will hoist the National Tricolour at 9.19 AM. Thereafter, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor will inspect the Guard of Honour and present Medals, Gallantry Awards and distribute Commendation Certificates. This will be followed by the address of Hon'ble Lt. Governor. The main function at Netaji Stadium will conclude with singing of National Song by school children followed by National Anthem. Before arrival at the Netaji Stadium for the main function, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor will visit National Memorial Cellular Jail and place wreath at the 'Martyr's Column'. He will also hoist the National Flag in the Cellular Jail.

Meanwhile, elaborate traffic arrangements and traffic diversions have been put in place for the smooth conduct of the main function of the 80th Independence Day celebration.

9. Any other article prohibited from the security point of view.

As part of the 'Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026', 'Partition Horror Remembrance Day', was observed by the Directorate of Art & Culture today. The state level function was organized in the auditorium of Tagore Govt. College of Education to solemnly recall the immense upheaval and pain endured by countless individuals during this tragic chapter in India's history.

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Ms. Chanchal Yadav graced the occasion as the chief guest. She also witnessed the exhibition organized at the venue, which showcased a collection of archival photographs, historical documents and personal narratives depicting the events surrounding the Partition of India in 1947.

Speaking on the occasion, the Director, Art & Culture, Ms. Priyanka Kumari, highlighted the significance of observing Partition Horror Remembrance Day. 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Mandatory compliance and registration notice for Lead Acid Battery (LAB) Recyclers under Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022

The Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC), Department of Science and Technology has initiated action for effective implementation of the Battery Waste Management (BWM) Rules, 2022 in compliance with the directions issued by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) regarding EPR credit generation.

Pursuant to decisions made during the 4th Implementation Meeting under the Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022, it has been observed that Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) credit generation is currently permitted for recyclers producing both Re-Melted Lead (RML) and Re-refined Lead (RRL). However, RML is an intermediate product, which requires further refining to obtain RRL which is the battery-grade

BSNL launches special offers, digital initiatives and major connectivity milestones in A&N Islands to mark 80th Independence Day

Sri Vijaya Puram, Aug. 14 Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) is celebrating the 80th Independence Day with a range of customer-centric initiatives and major milestones in digital connectivity across the Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Reaffirming its commitment to the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat and Digital India, BSNL is strengthening telecommunication infrastructure to provide reliable and high-speed connectivity even in remote and geographically challenging areas.

As part of its nationwide Independence Day initiatives, BSNL has introduced the Re. 1 Freedom 2.0 Offer for new mobile subscribers, offering 1 GB data per day, 100 SMS per day, unlimited voice calls and 24 days validity for just Re. 1. BSNL has also introduced the Fiber Freedom Plan at Rs. 1,111 per month, offering speeds of up to 200 Mbps, 5,000 GB monthly data and complimentary access to

more than 25 premium OTT platforms. In addition, BSNL Entertainment TV, powered by Tango, enables mobile subscribers to access live TV channels and on-demand content free of cost through the BSNL Selfcare App.

To strengthen communication in remote and sensitive areas where conventional mobile networks are unavailable, BSNL is also providing Global Satellite Phone Services (GSPS). In the Andaman & Nicobar Islands, BSNL has achieved significant progress in expanding high-speed fibre connectivity under the Amended BharatNet Programme (ABP). The programme currently covers 70 Gram Panchayats and is planned to be extended to seven Tribal Councils. More than 10,000 Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) connections have already been commissioned under the scheme.

BSNL has also adopted a demand-driven approach for extending fibre connectivity to non-

GP and remote villages. Connectivity will be extended to such areas upon receiving a minimum requirement of five connections.

Under the Prime Minister's initiative for expansion of 4G services, BSNL has installed 85 new 4G towers and upgraded 70 existing sites to 4G, benefiting more than one lakh rural subscribers across the Islands.

A major milestone has also been achieved in wireless backhaul connectivity with the commissioning of a 48+ km over-sea Unlicensed Band Radio (UBR) link connecting Teressa Island from Kamorta. The link overcomes complex oceanic backhaul challenges and serves as the main hub for mobile connectivity in the area.

The UBR link has enabled radiation of the mobile site at Bengali village, while two additional remote sites at Bambooka and Kanhaionot are scheduled to be connected shortly, a press release from PIB, Sri Vijaya Puram said.

label "P" (both Green & Pink) shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-Vikas Bhawan (ANIIDCO Office)-Fire Brigade-APWD Crossing to their destinations. 5. The holders of 'P-1'(Yellow) parking labels will arrive at the Netaji Stadium by 0800 hrs. via Model School-Clock Tower-Gymkhana Crossing. Thereafter, the vehicles shall proceed to the parking on the western side of main gate of Netaji Stadium and near Swimming Pool. 6. After the departure of all vehicles parked inside the stadium and near Andaman Club having "P" parking label the vehicles with "P-1" parking label will be allowed to come to the main entrance of Netaji Stadium to pick up the guests and shall leave via Scout Hut Junction-Girls School Crossing-RK Mission and RGT Road. 7. All other vehicles without any parking label including two and four wheelers will be parked near Water Sports Complex and Girls School parking. 8. The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing - Bengali Club - Goalghar- Secretariat Junction - Police Line and Nayagaon. 9. No heavy vehicles, private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed towards Cellular Jail from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs and shall be diverted to other routes from Bengali Club Junction. 10. The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV-Secretariat Junction and Goalghar. 11. Heavy vehicles shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglighat from Bengali Club from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs. 12. No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards the place of function from Y-Narayan Junction, RK Mission, Fire Brigade Junction and Water Sports Junction after 0830 hrs. 13. No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed towards Aberdeen Bazar after the start of the function from any direction till the dispersal of the crowd. 14.
