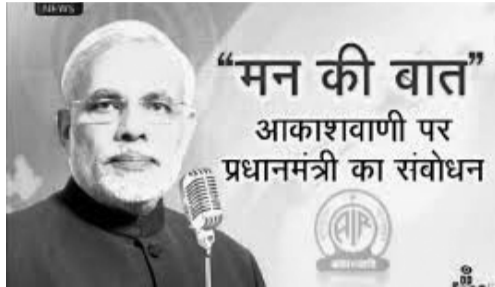

New Delhi, Sept 16

Inaugurating the National Biogas Convention in New Delhi yesterday, the Minister said there can be no two opinions about the fact that in order to provide energy to the last mile, decentralized power production across the country should be ensured. He

informed that India is already the world leader in small scale and low cost biogas purification technology. The Minister assured that he stands committed to the National Biogas and National Fertilizer Mission. He urged the participants to create a framework for facilitating scientific exploration in the country. Shri Goyal said biogas offers an important solution to the present energy crisis in rural area.

LPG distributors asked to ensure un-interrupted distribution of cylinders

Port Blair, Sept. 15
The Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs have issued instruction to the Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. and all LPG Distributor to take all necessary action to ensure un-interrupted distribution of LPG cylinders at the doorsteps of concerned consumers and strict compliance of the delivery date & time scheduled published in the newspaper by the distributors. The Enforcement Wing of the Directorate shall conduct surprise inspection in and around South Andaman to ascertain as to whether the LPG Distributors comply all the guidelines framed under the Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Regulation of Supply & Distribution) Order, 2000 and abide to the delivery schedule of LPG Distributors.

Director (CS&CA) has stated that any deviation in the delivery schedule without genuine reason shall be viewed seriously and legal action as deemed fit as prescribed under the Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Regulation of Supply & Distribution) Order, 2000 framed under the Consumer Protection Act, 1955 shall be imposed against the Distributor.

Swift action averts fire accident

No casualty/injury was reported due to the incident. Brave fire fight put up by the fire personnel saved the spread of the fire to adjacent rooms. Initial investigation revealed that short circuit was the cause of the accident.

An unfortunate fatal accident, due to electrocution, was reported at Tiranga Park, Aberdeen Bazaar, Port Blair on Sept. 15, 2015 wherein a 64 year old man namely K. Bhaskar Rao, S/o K. Machian Rao died of electric shock at Tiranga Park. It was reported that the man was a resident of Round Basti, Aberdeen Bazaar and his family is in West Godavari District of Andhra Pradesh.

The Lt. Governor, A & N Islands has expressed his deepest condolence and has directed the District Magistrate to conduct an enquiry done by an Executive

Magistrate. In compliance to the directions, the Additional District Magistrate, South Andaman has been ordered to conduct a magisterial enquiry on the electrocution occurred at Tiranga Park, Aberdeen Bazaar and submit a detailed report within seven days.

Meanwhile, the general public have been appealed to adhere to adequate safety measures to avoid such incidents in future, a communication from the District Magistrate, South Andaman District said.

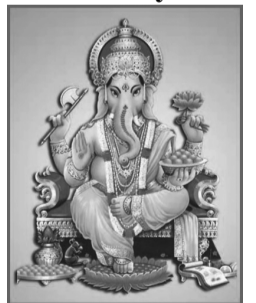

Sethi broke the news via micro-blogging site Twitter. He also confirmed that Darren Sami will also be part of the inaugural season of the T20 league, which is going to start from February

Meanwhile, a newly recruited sportsman will not be allowed to take part in the tournament, as he requires to have put in a minimum service of 6 months in the department/organization before the commencement of the tournament/competition, a communication said.

Much was expected of India's limited overs specialist Suresh Raina, who was coming into competitive match after a three-month rest, but he looked completely rusty during his 28-ball 16. It was Gurkeerat along with young Sanju Samson (73) and Rishi Dhawan (56), who steadied the innings as India were reduced to 125 for five at the halfway stage after opener Mayank Agarwal (56)'s steady innings. This was the 25-year-old Gurkeerat's second successive Man-of-the-Match performance after his unbeaten 87 won India A the tri-series final against Australia A.

Commonwealth Games champion Kashyap, however, could not cross the opening round hurdle after his battle ended with a narrow 21-17 16-21 18-21 loss against Wei Nan of Hong Kong in an hour-long match. It was also curtains for Pradnya Gadre and Sikki Reddy in the women's doubles competition as they suffered a 24-26 9-21 loss to the Japanese pair of Shizuka Matsuo and Mami Naito at the SK Handball stadium.

Pakistan opener Ahmad Shahzad also seems excited after the announcement as he considered it as a big news. If reports are to be believed then Kieron Pollard and Sunil Narine are other West Indians who gave their consent to play in the franchise-based T20 tournament in Doha. It is also reliably learnt that the event organisers are seeking at least 25 overseas players for the tournament.

In case candidates are unable to download the hall-ticket, they can contact the Regional Centre, Port Blair and obtain the information of Examination Centre allocated and report to the Examination Centre with a proof of submission of Entrance Test application form along with recent passport size photograph. In such case they have to submit an undertaking at the Examination Centre stating that in the event of information furnished by them found to be incorrect, their candidature will be cancelled. Candidates must report at the Examination Centre 45 minutes before commencement of the Entrance Test, a communication from Regional Director, IGNOU Regional Centre, Port Blair said.
